

## 2008-09 Year-End Report

### HIGHLIGHTS:

**2009 Legislative Changes:** The 2009 Oklahoma Legislature approved two changes to the program:

- The Legislature delayed implementation of a new second income limit until from 2010-11 to 2012-13. For first time award recipients in 2012-13, the income of the student’s parents may not exceed \$100,000 at the time the student goes to college. This second income limit is in addition to the \$50,000 limit applied at the time the student enrolls in the program in the 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, or 10<sup>th</sup> grade. The two-year delay ensures that the new second income limit does not apply to any students for whom it was not a requirement at the time the student enrolled in the program.
- The Legislature also clarified that the amount of the Oklahoma’s Promise award that a student will receive at a four-year state college or university will be based on the “nonguaranteed” tuition rate. In fall 2008, four-year state colleges and universities began offering “guaranteed” tuition rates that remain unchanged for four years if the student meets certain conditions. However, the price of the “guaranteed” tuition rate for a freshman is up to 15 percent higher than the “nonguaranteed” tuition rate. Oklahoma’s Promise students may choose to participate in the “guaranteed” tuition rate but are responsible for paying the difference in cost out of their own pocket.

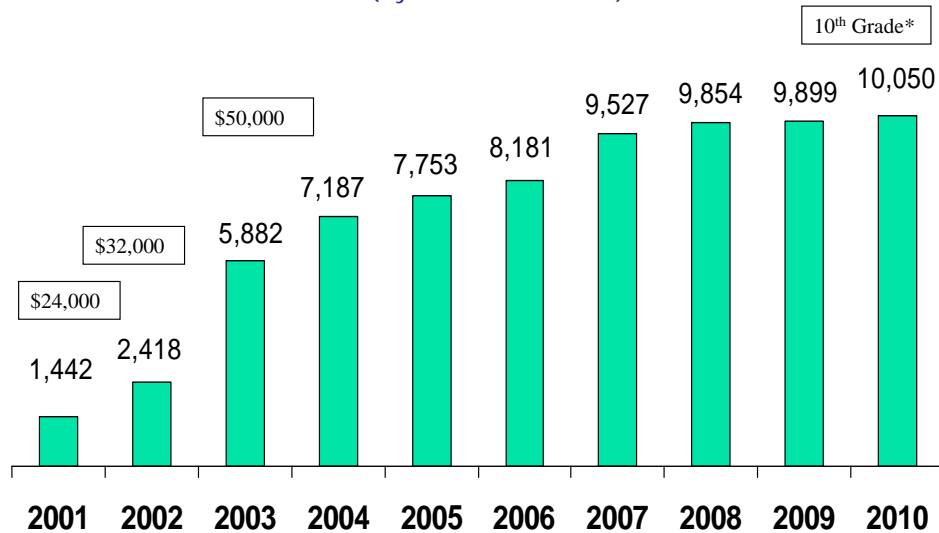

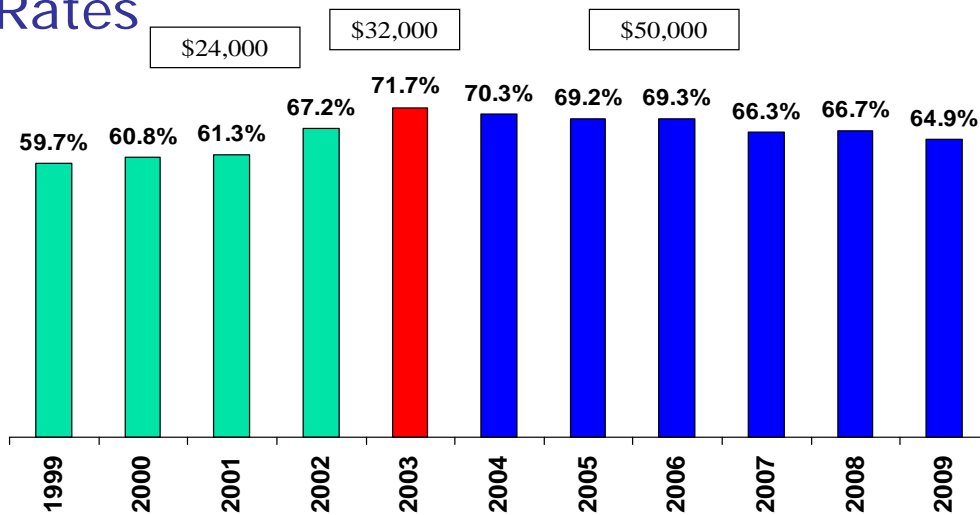

## OKPromise High School Enrollment (By Graduation Year)

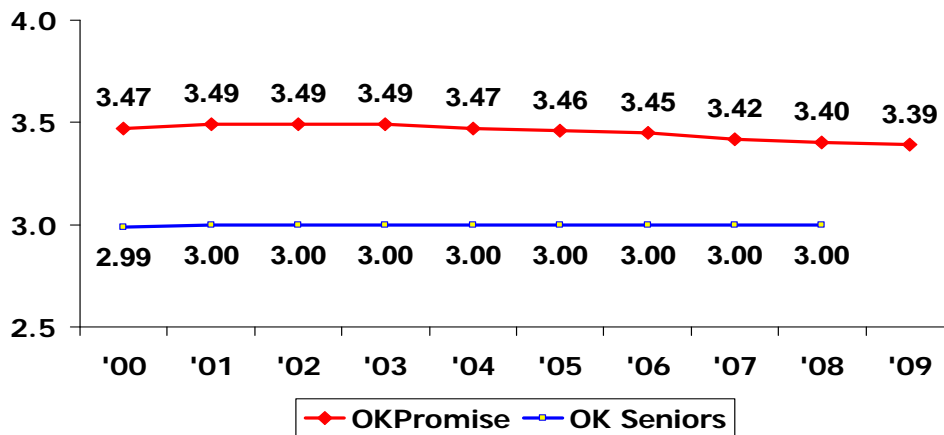

## High School Requirement Completion Rates

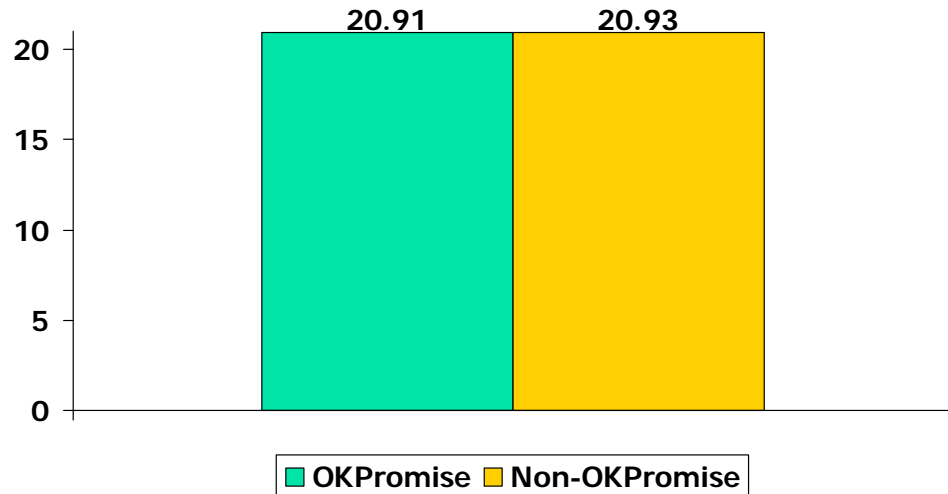


## High School GPA's for All Courses



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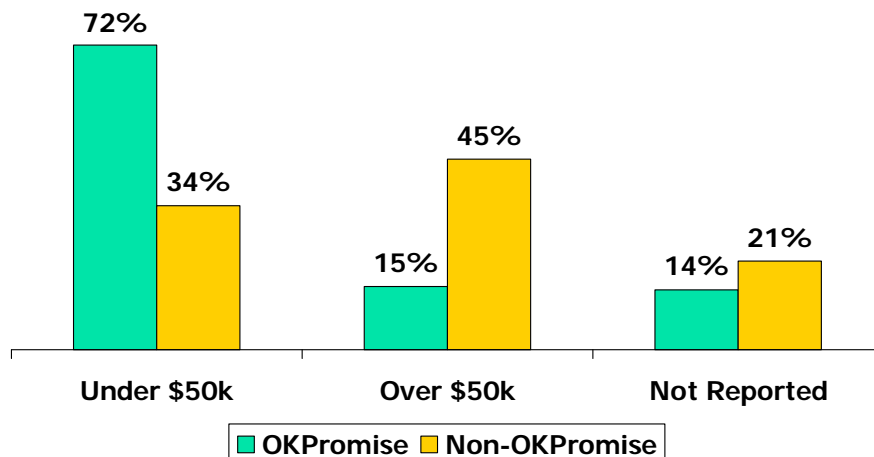
## 2009 ACT Composite Scores

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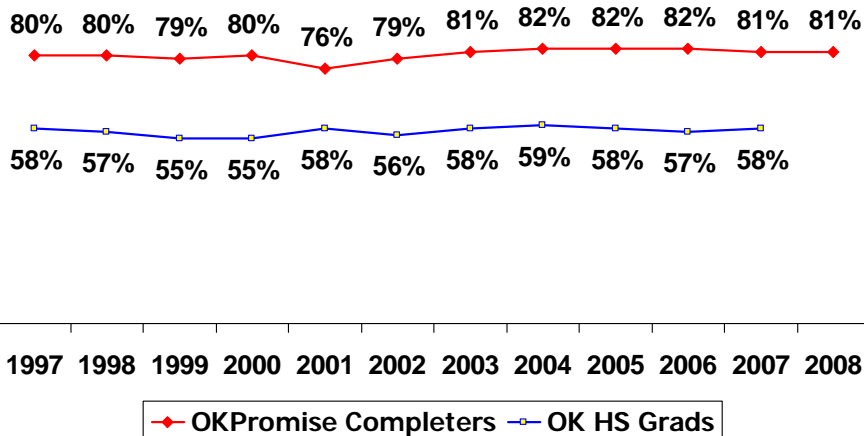
## 2009 ACT Testers By Income

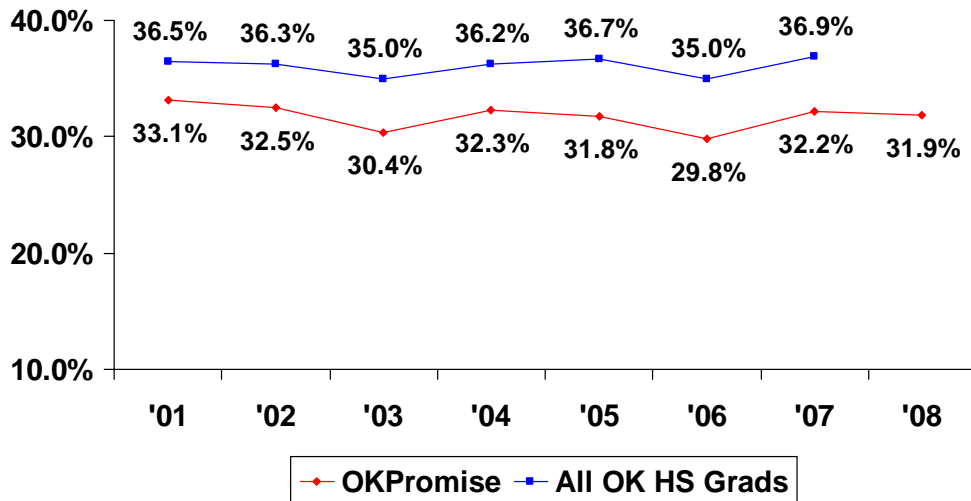

## College-Going Rates Compared to All Oklahoma HS Graduates



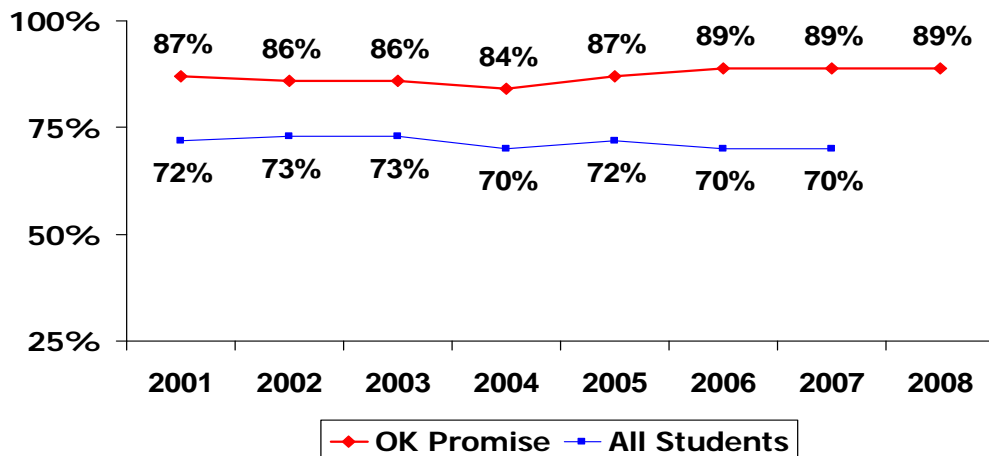

## College Remediation Rates

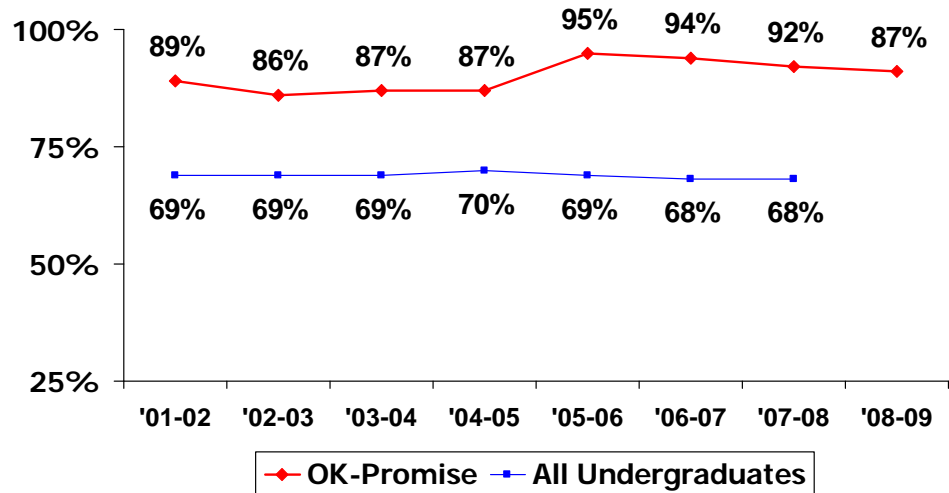

## College Freshman – GPA of at least 2.0



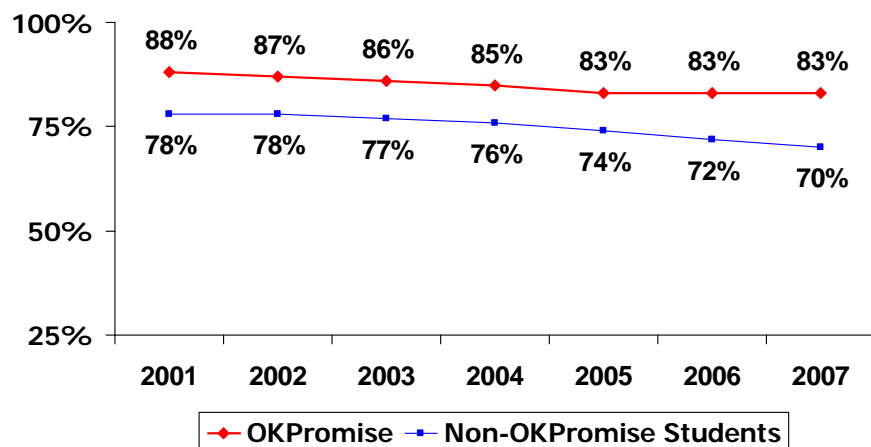
## Full-Time College Enrollment\*

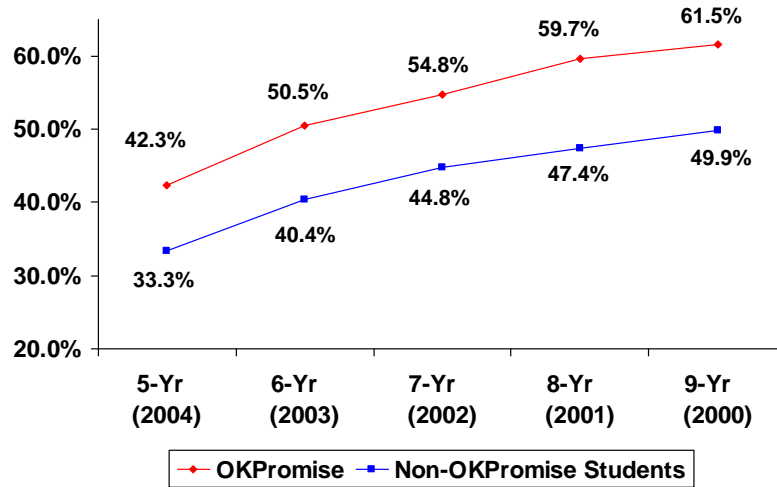
## College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



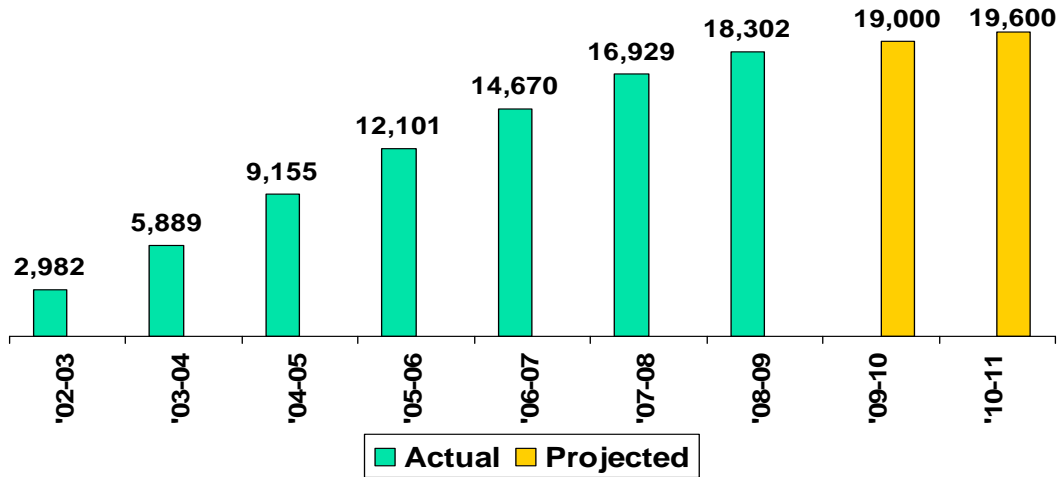


## Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2008-09)

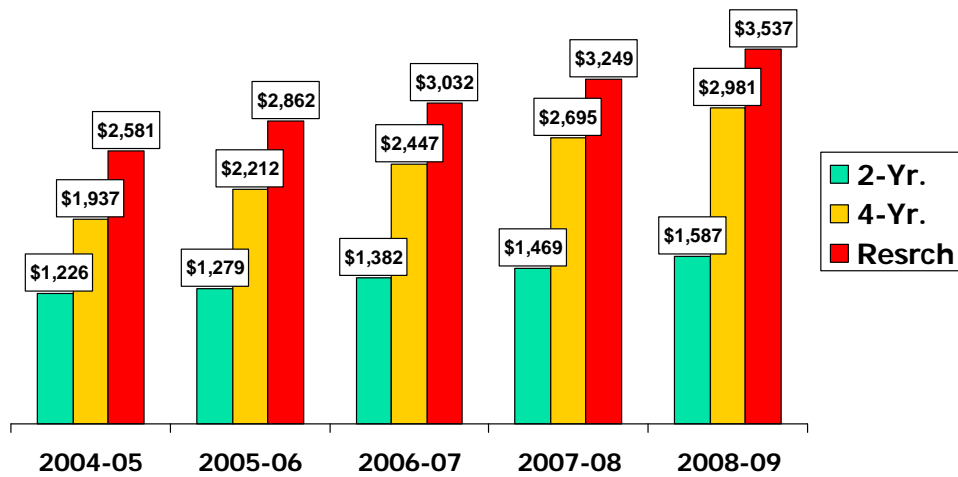


## Scholarship Recipients



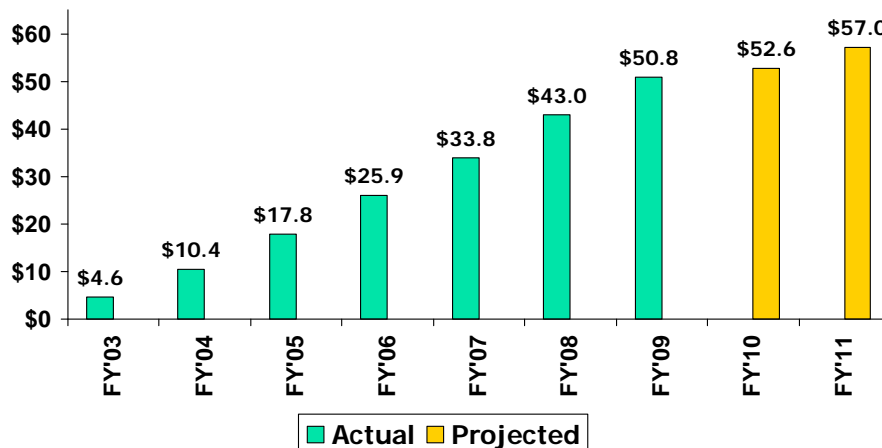

## Average Scholarship Amount by Type of Institution



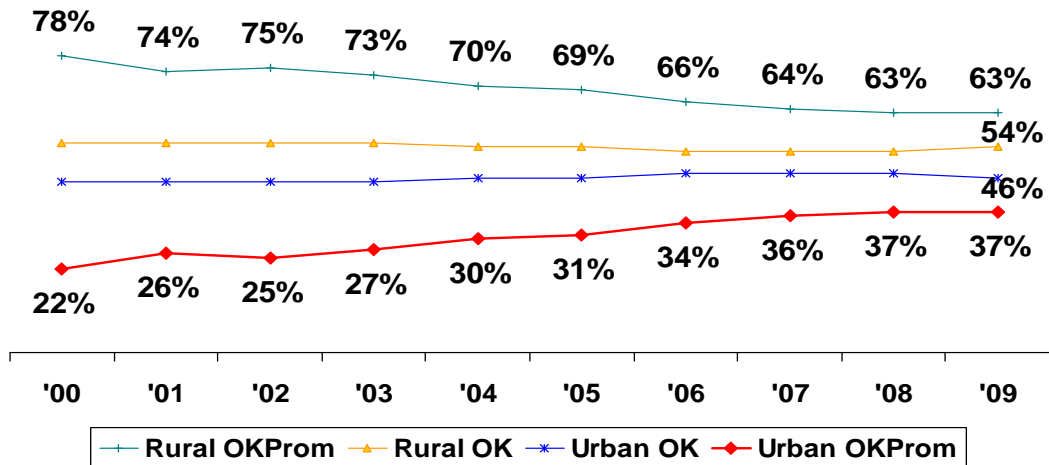
## Scholarships Paid

(In \$ millions, by fiscal year, varying tuition rates)



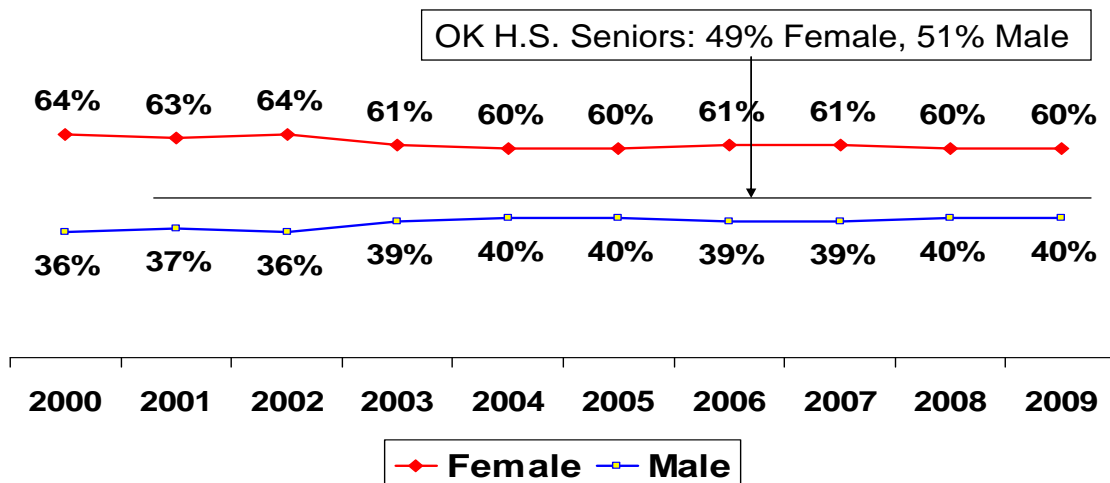

## Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2000-2009

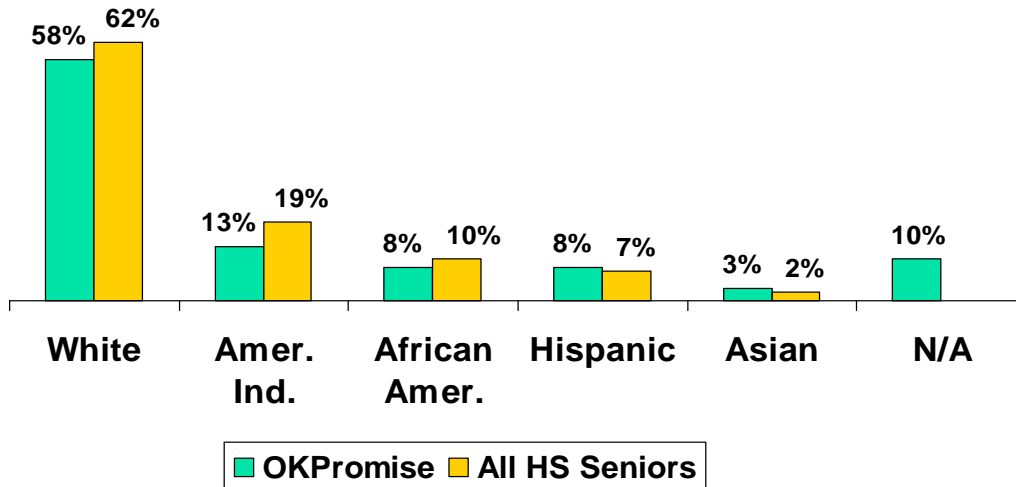

## Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2000-2009

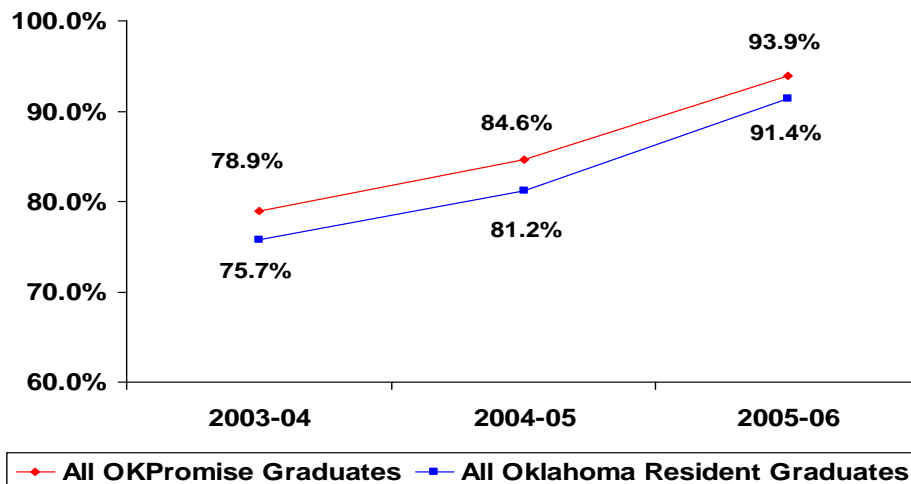


## Ethnicity – 2009 HS Completers
