



# 2013-14 Year End Report

## HIGHLIGHTS:

- In 2013-14, the number of Oklahoma’s Promise award recipients in college continued to decline, dropping by 700 from the previous year. From a peak of 20,084 in 2010-11, the number of recipients has decline by nearly 1,200 or 6%. The number of recipients is projected to decline further to 18,300 in 2014-15 and to 17,550 in 2015-16.
- Enrollment of 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grade students in the program is also declining. From a high of 10,634 in graduating class of 2012, student enrollment dropped to 9,649 in the class of 2014. The decline in both initial enrollments and award recipients is due to several factors—lack of an inflation adjustment to the \$50,000 family income limit at the time of initial enrollment (which has not been adjusted since 2000); legislative changes requiring a second family income check at the time the student enters college; the application of federal satisfactory academic progress standards in college; and new statutory college GPA requirements.

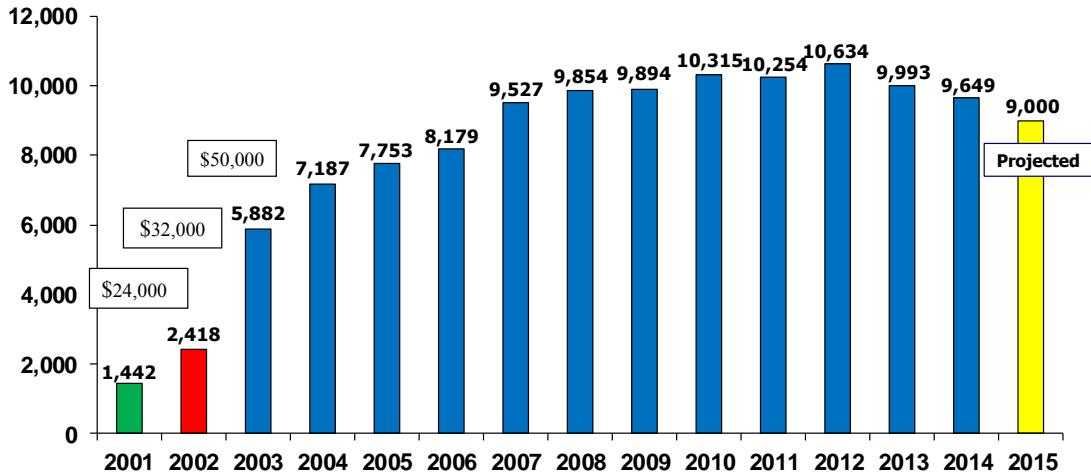

(By High School Graduation Year)

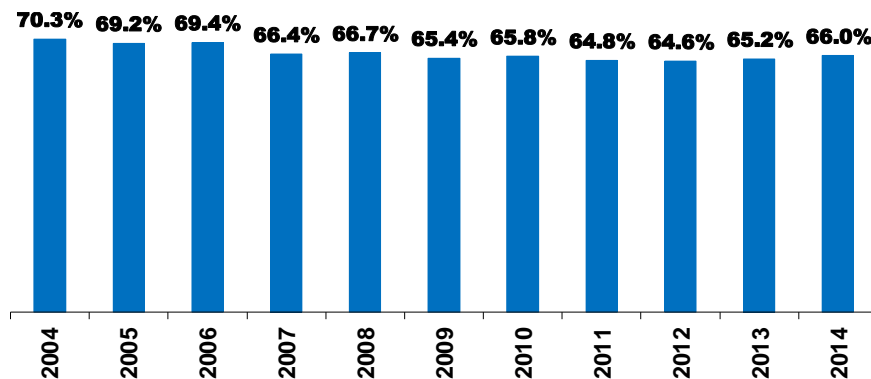

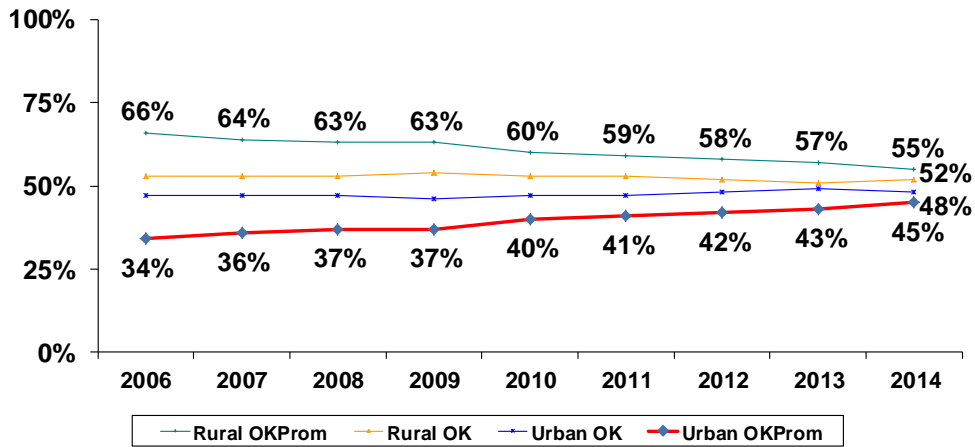
### Completion Rates

(by grad year)



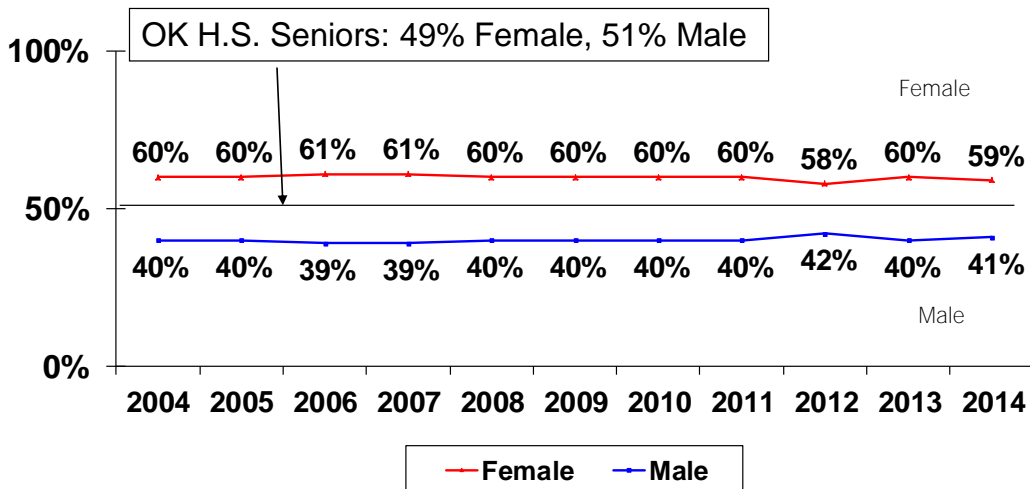

## Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2006-2014

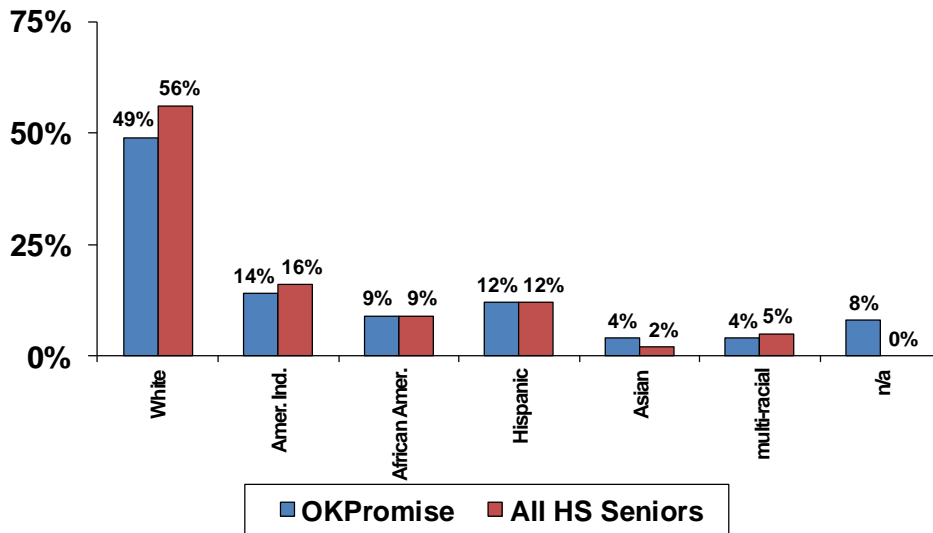

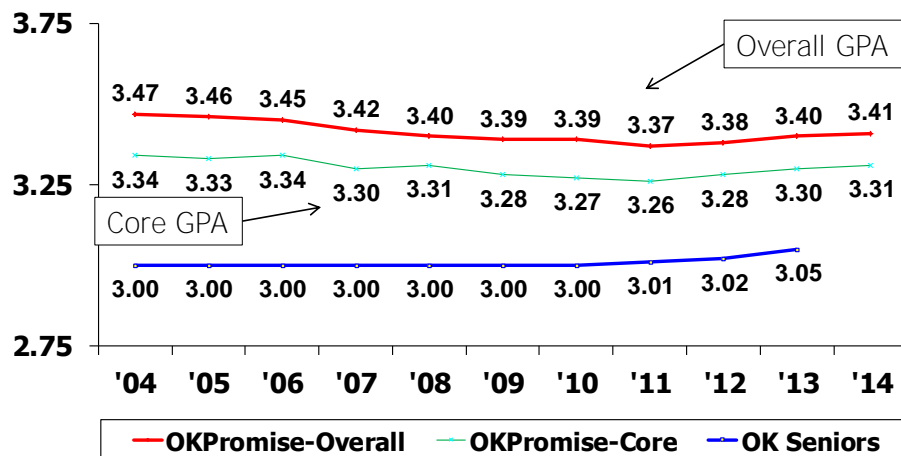
## Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2004-2014



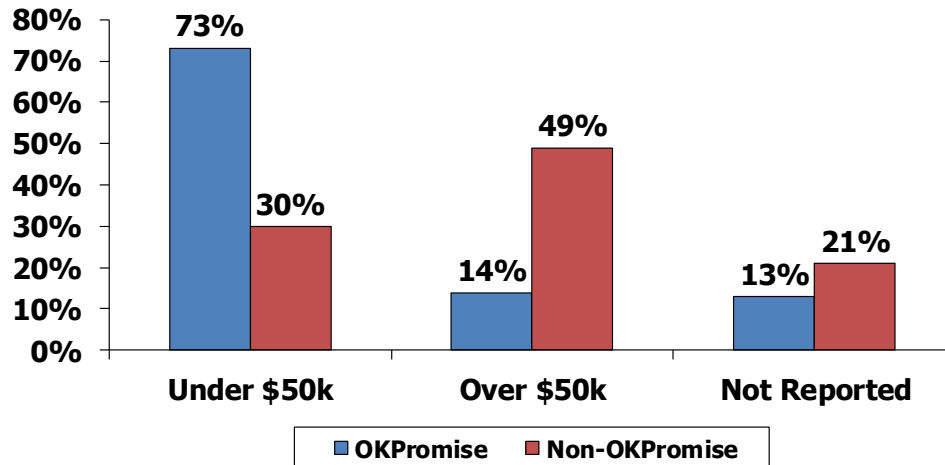
## Ethnicity – 2014 HS Completers

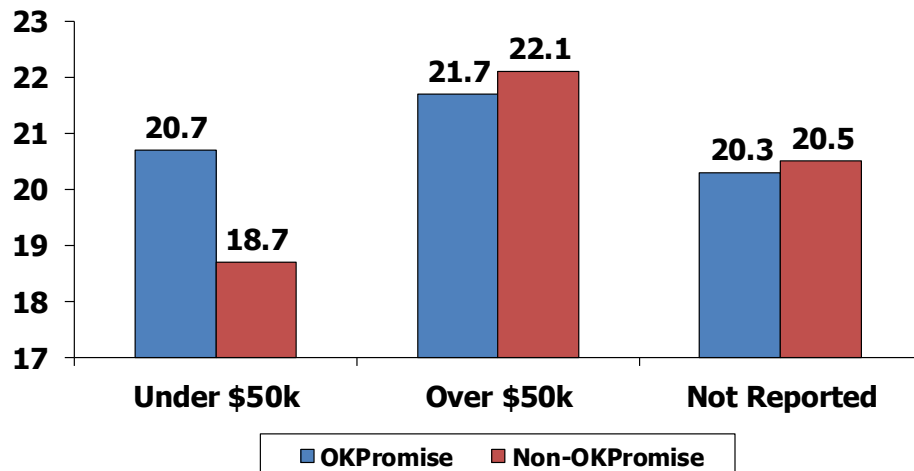


## 2014 ACT Testers By Income\*



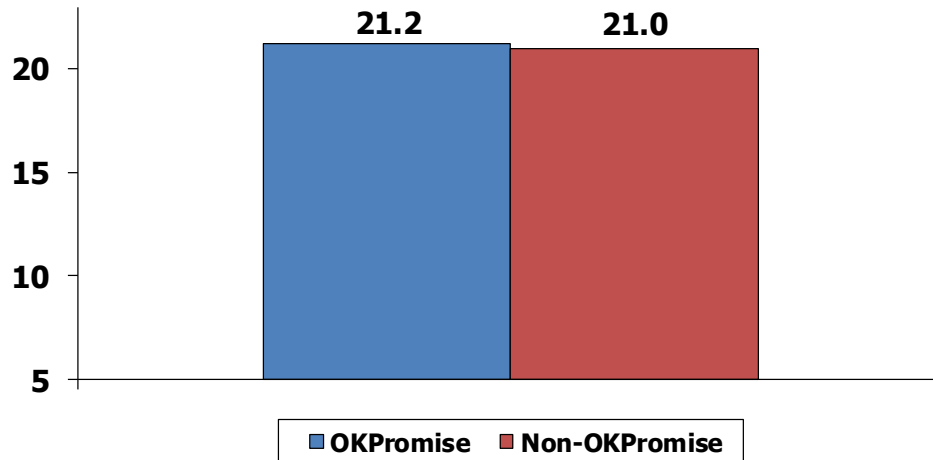

## 2014 Average ACT Scores By Income\*

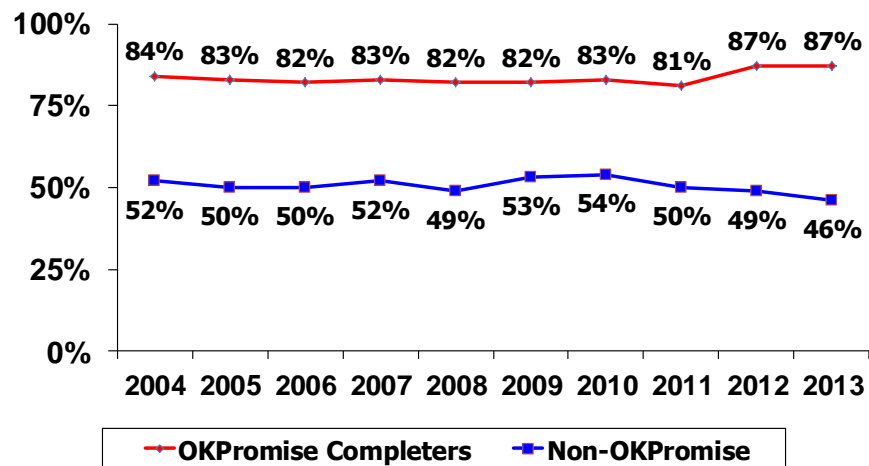

## 2014 ACT Composite Scores

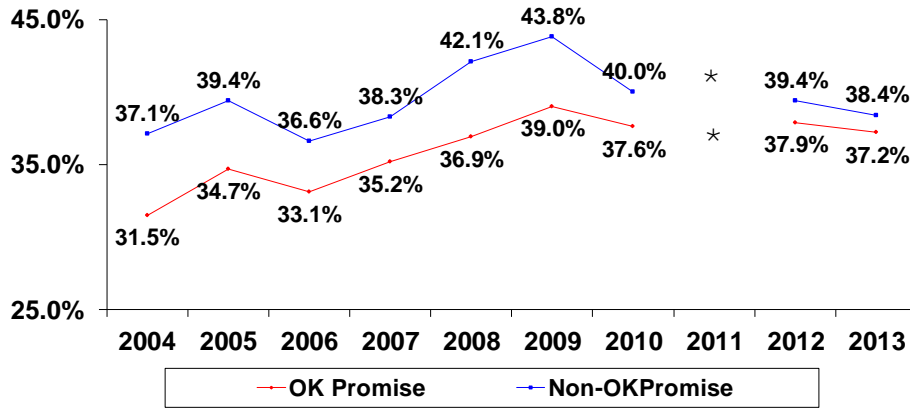


## College-Going Rates



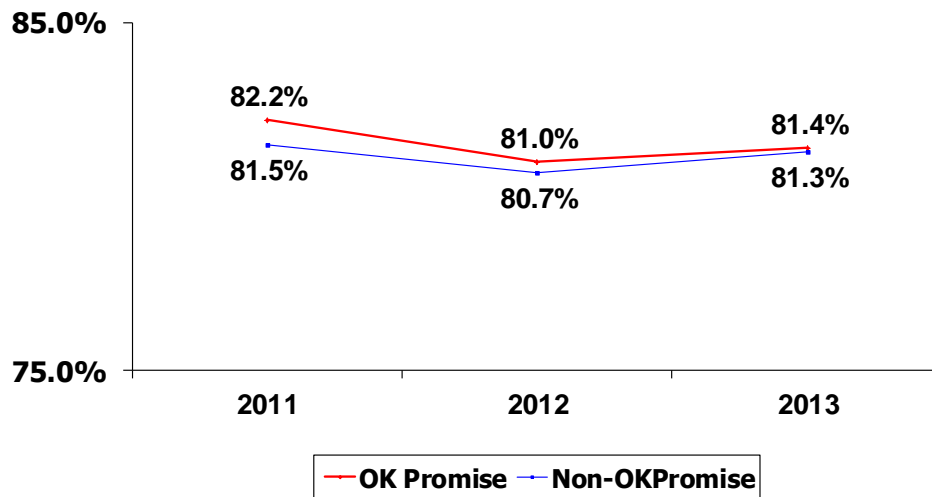


# College Remediation Rates



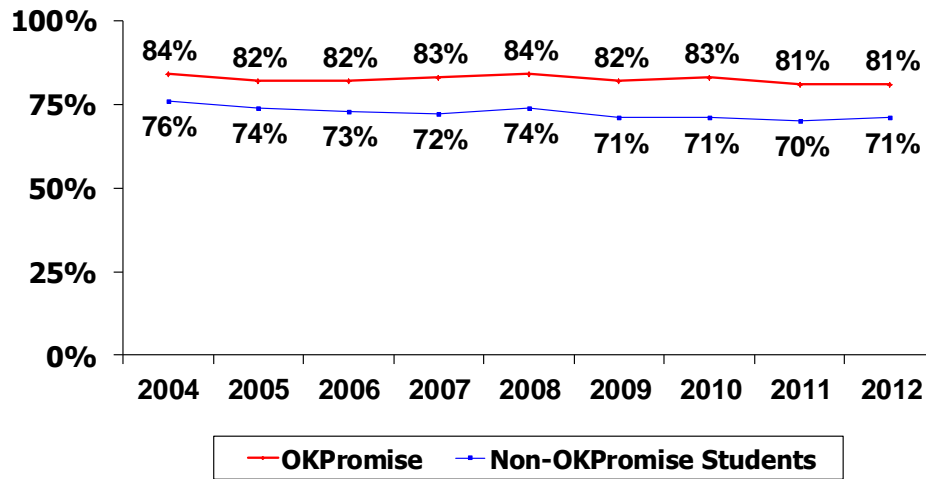

# College Freshman – GPA of at least 2.0

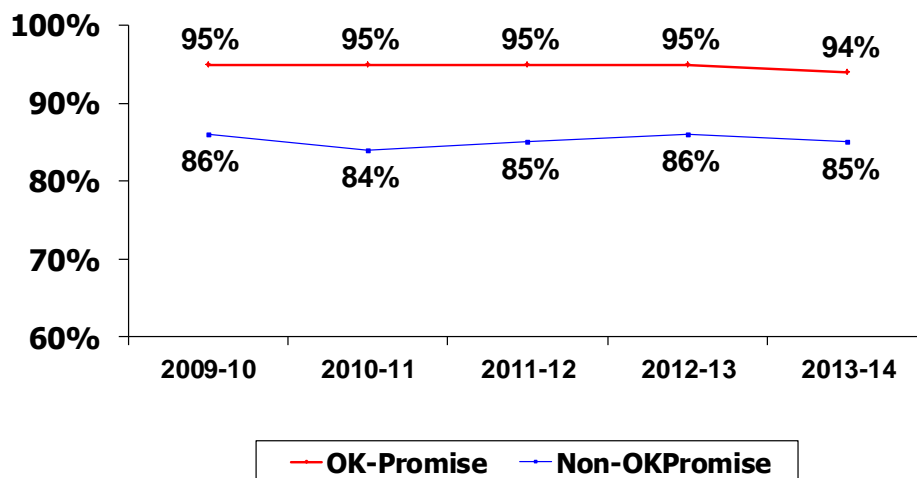

## College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



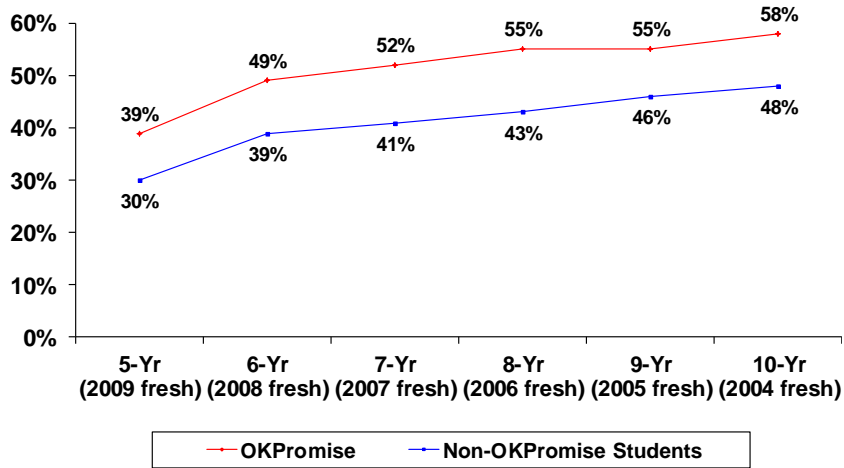
## Full-Time College Enrollment



First-time entering students enrolled full-time in fall or spring semester

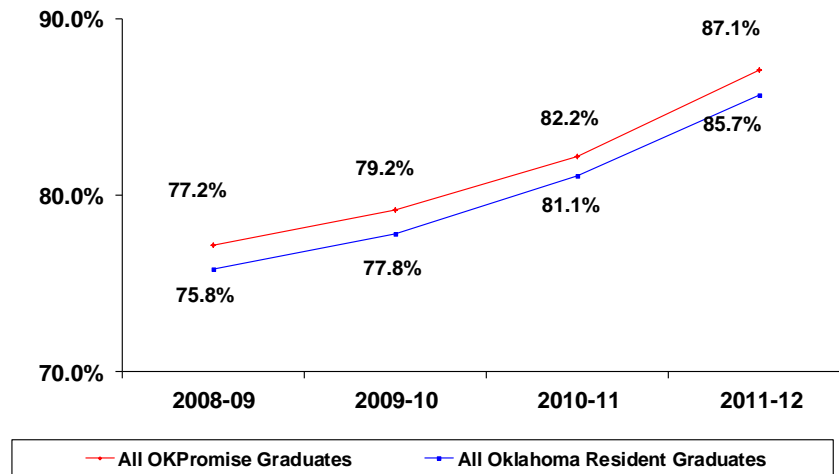
## Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2013-14)

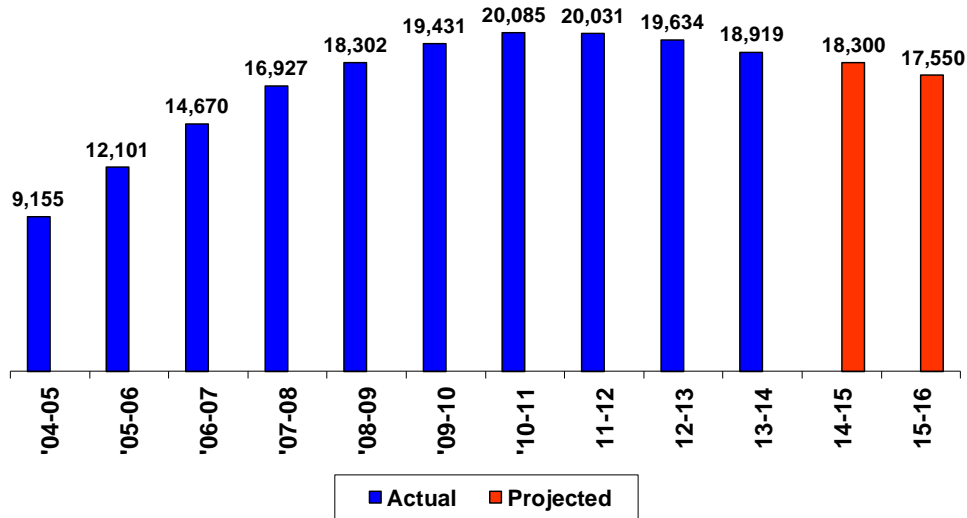


## OKPromise Graduates Employment

(Employed in Oklahoma between April 2012 and June 2013)



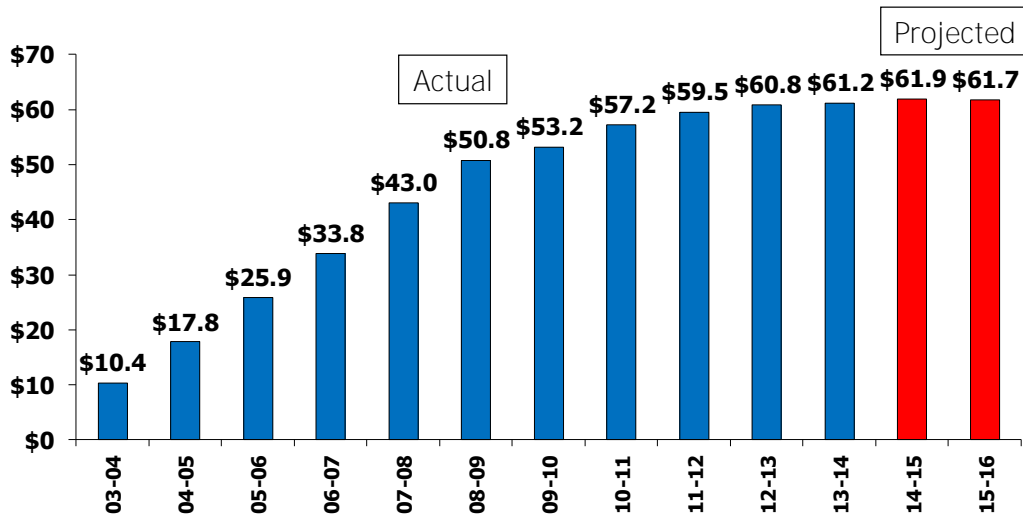
# Scholarship Recipients

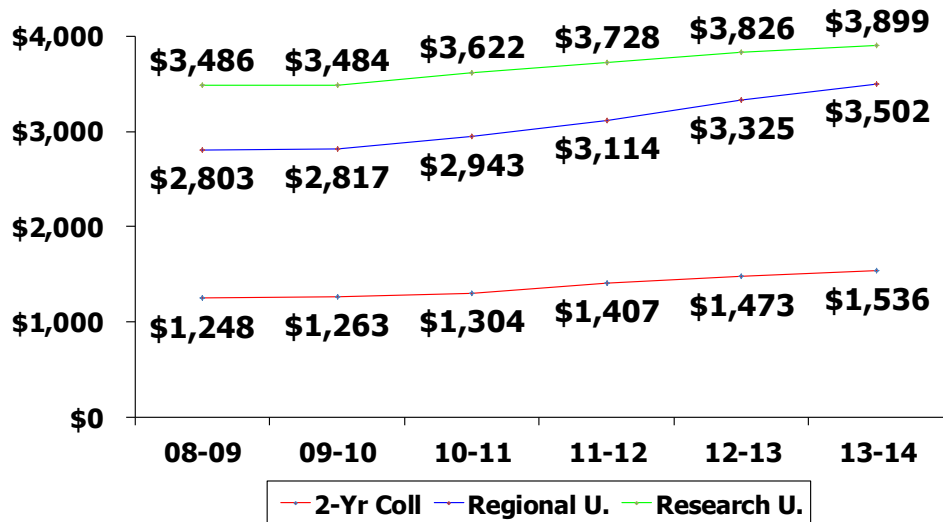
# Scholarship Expenditures
