



2017-18 Year End Report

HIGHLIGHTS:

- The percentage of Oklahoma’s Promise students in the 2018 graduating class completing the program’s high school requirements increased to 73.6%, the highest level in the history of the program!
- Beginning with the 2017-2018 academic year, the family income limit at the time of application was increased from \$50,000 to \$55,000. The first high school graduates at the higher income limit will be the class of 2020. The increase in the income limit is projected to increase participation in the program by up to 10%. Another increase in the income limit to \$60,000 is scheduled to begin with applicants in 2021-2022.
- Beginning with 2018 Oklahoma’s Promise high school graduates, the number of college semester credit hours for which the award will pay will be limited to 129 semester credit hours, with exceptions for degrees requiring more than 129 credit hours.

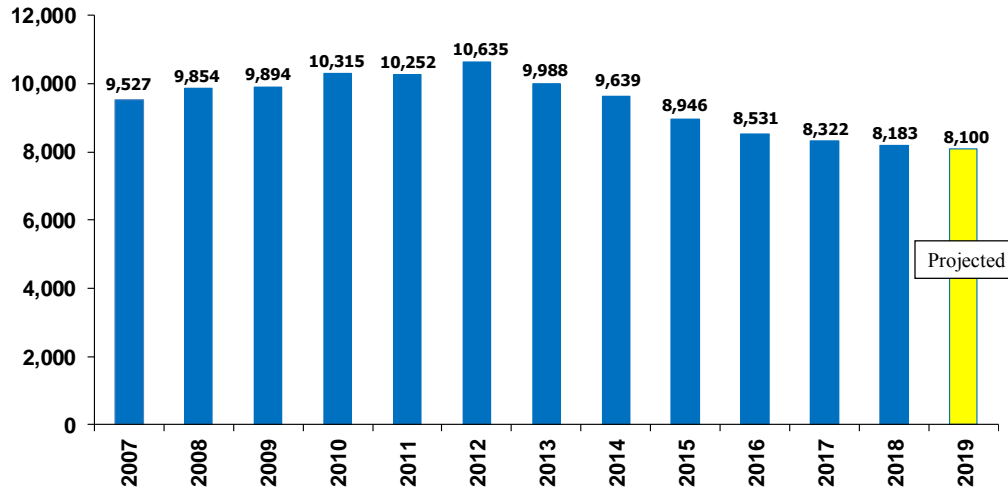

OKPromise High School Enrollment

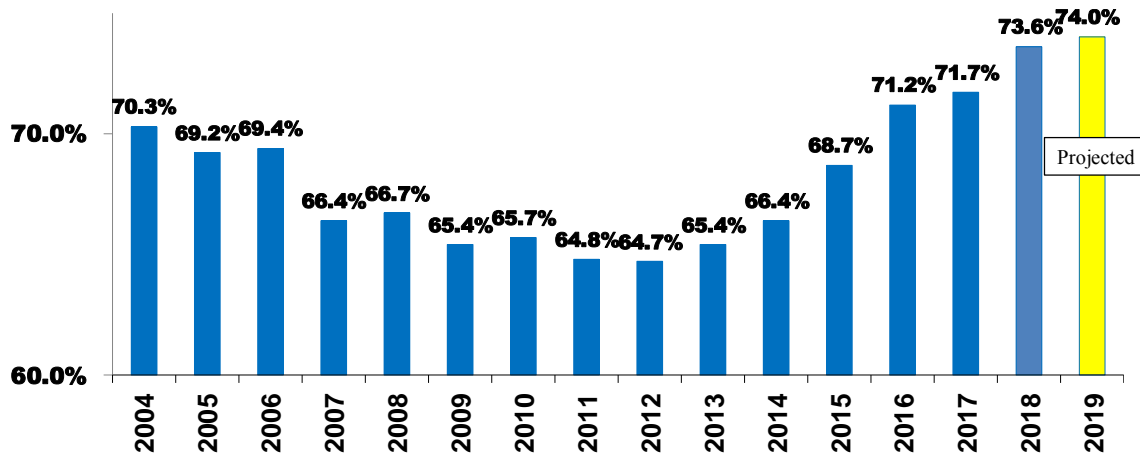
(By High School Graduation Year)

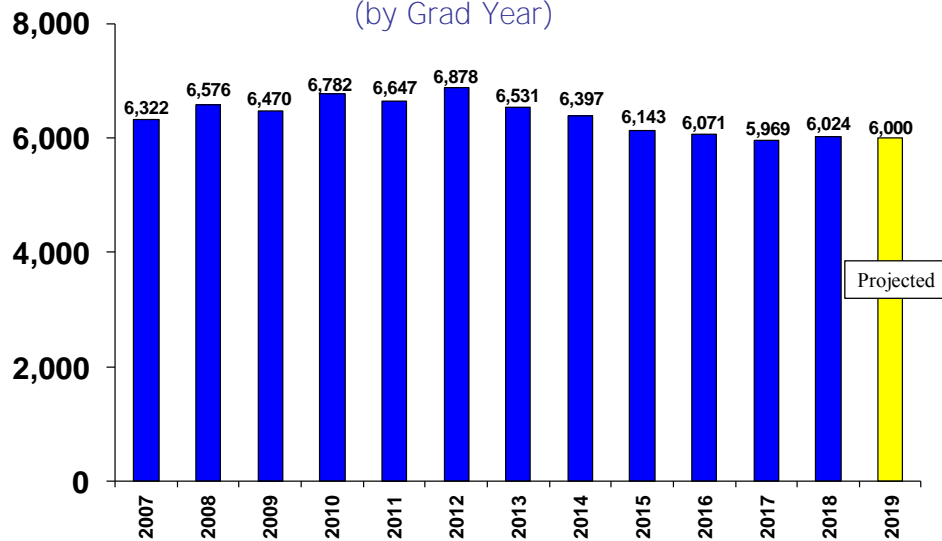
High School Requirement Completion Rates

(by grad year)



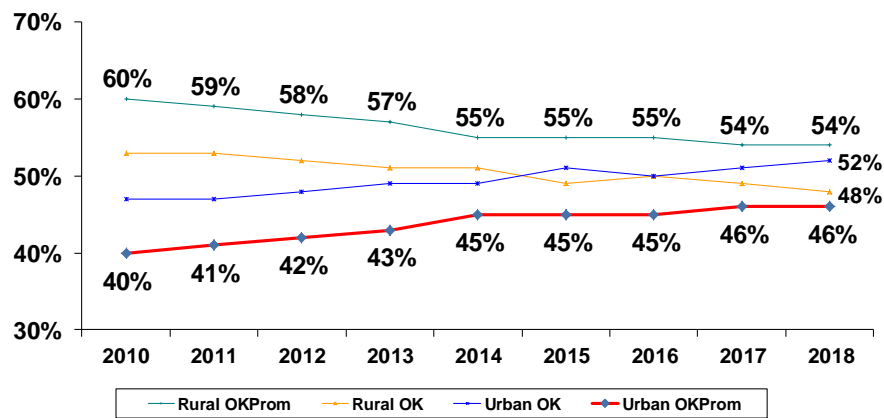

High School Students Completing OKPromise Requirements



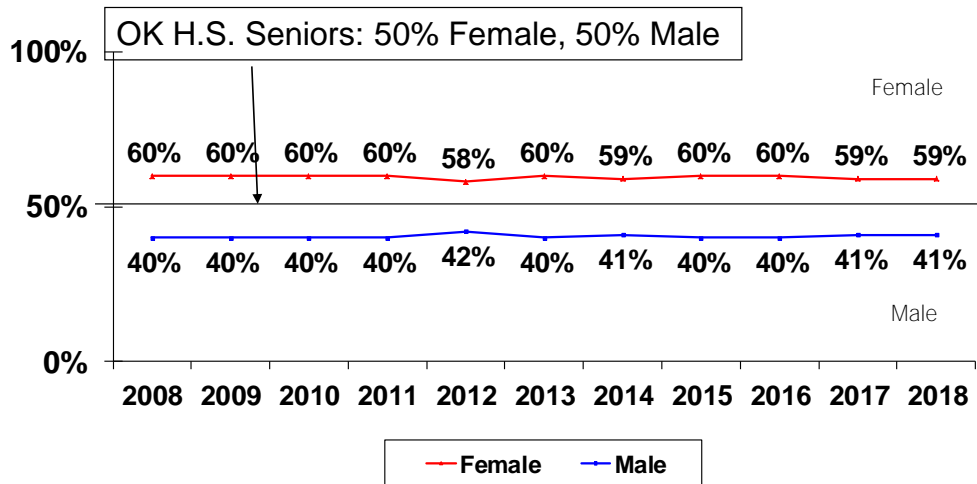

Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2010-2018

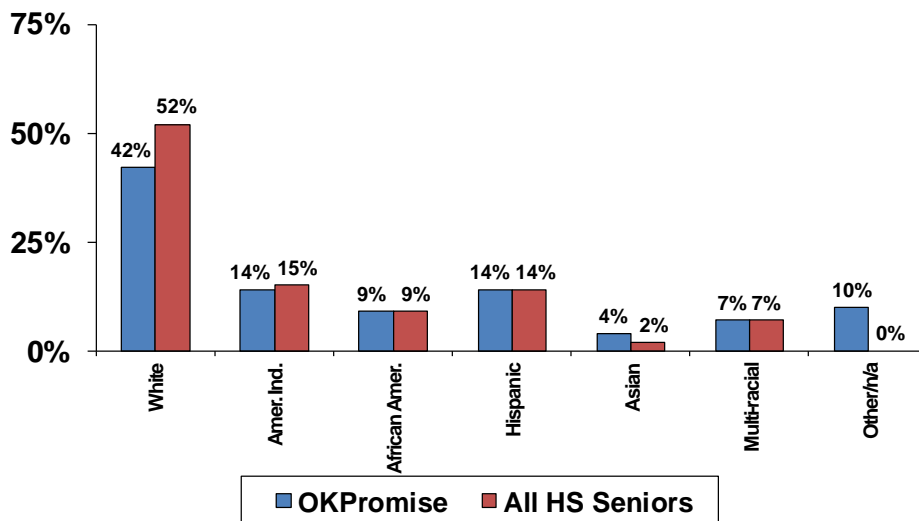

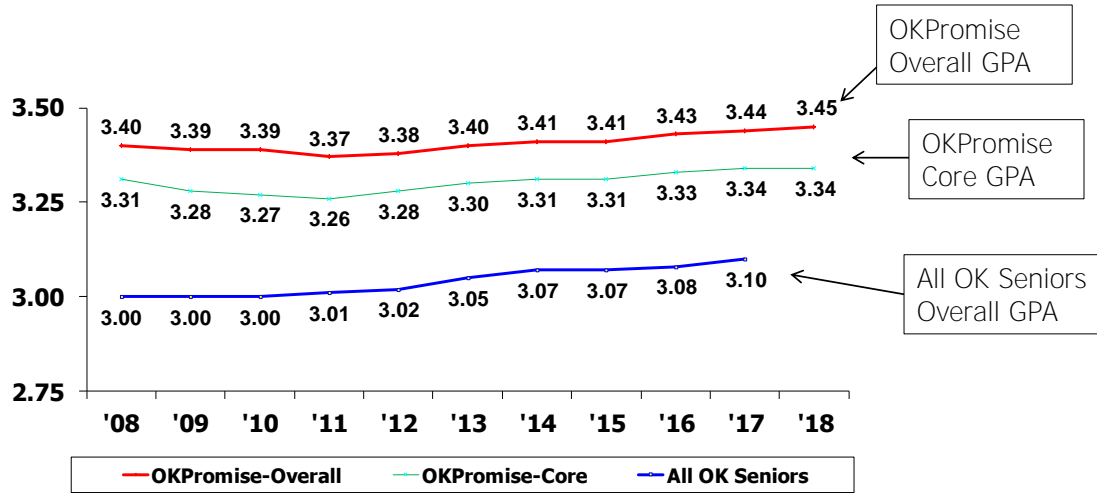
Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2008-2018



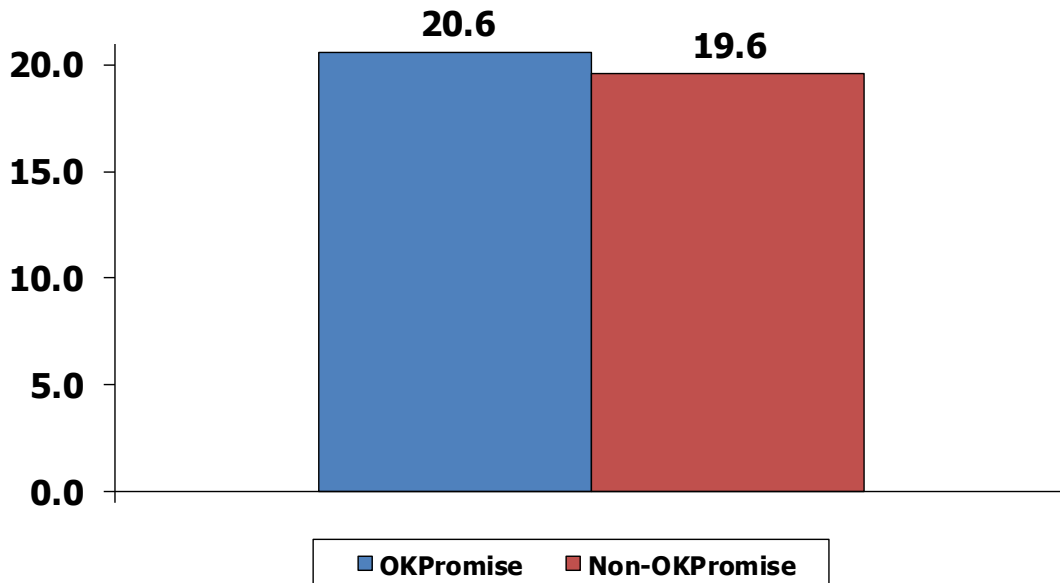
Ethnicity – 2018 HS Completers



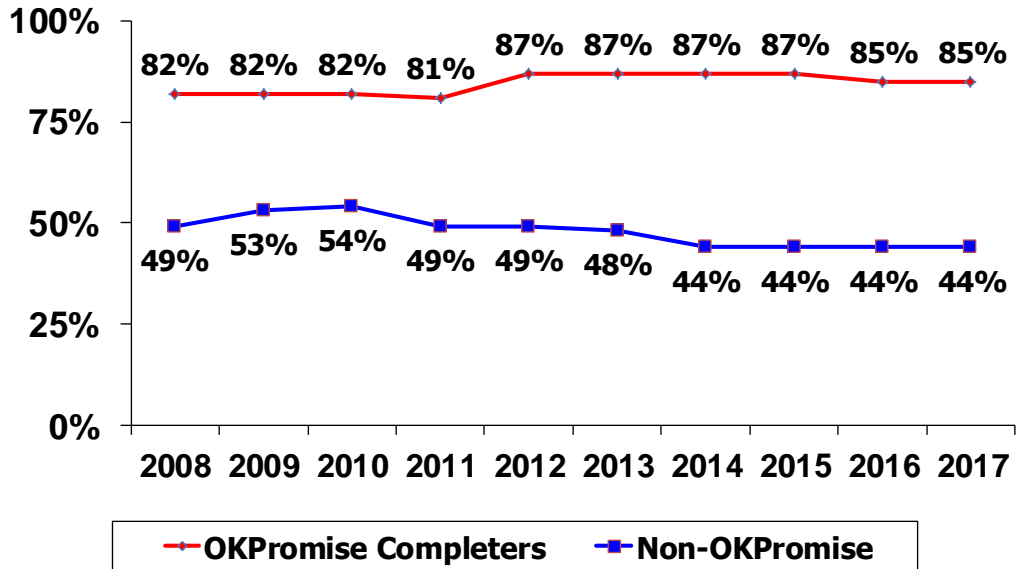
High School GPA's



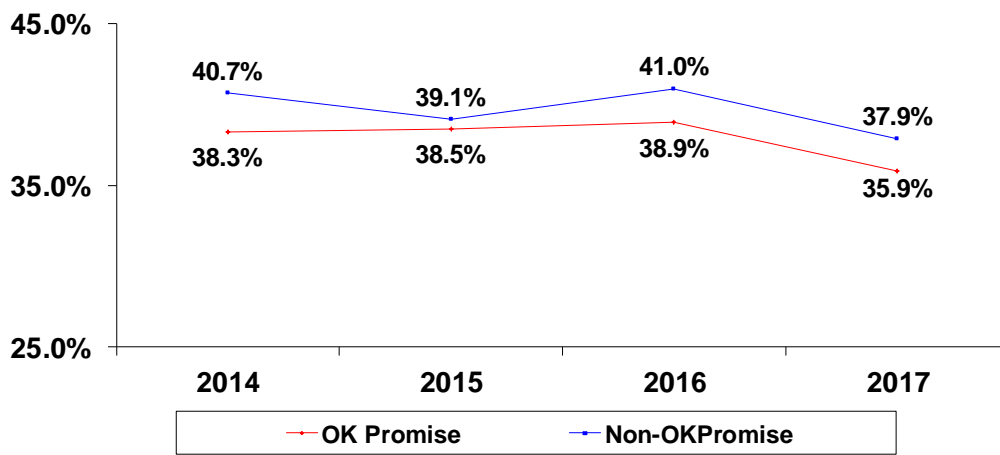
2018 ACT Composite Scores



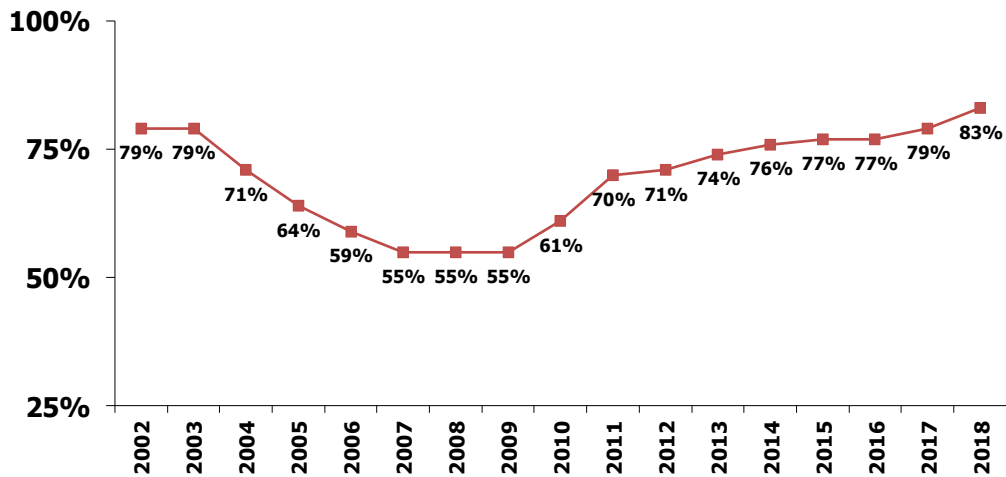
College-Going Rates



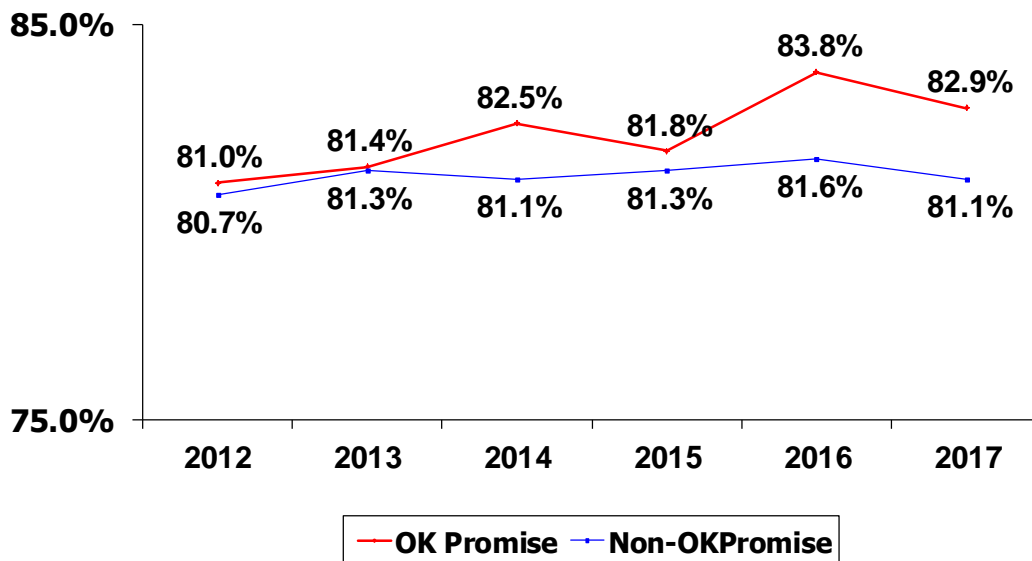
College Remediation Rates



% of OKPromise Recipients Eligible for Federal Pell Grants

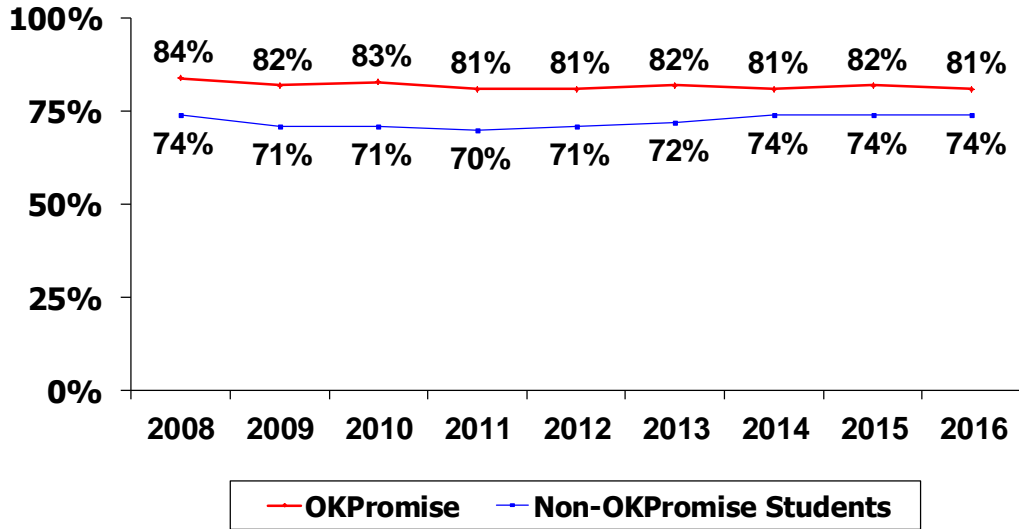

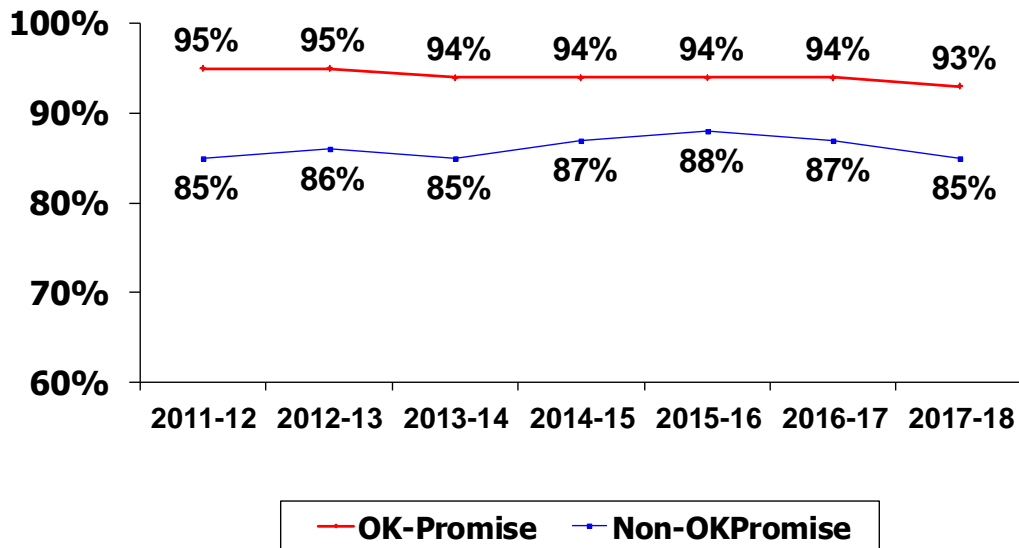

College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



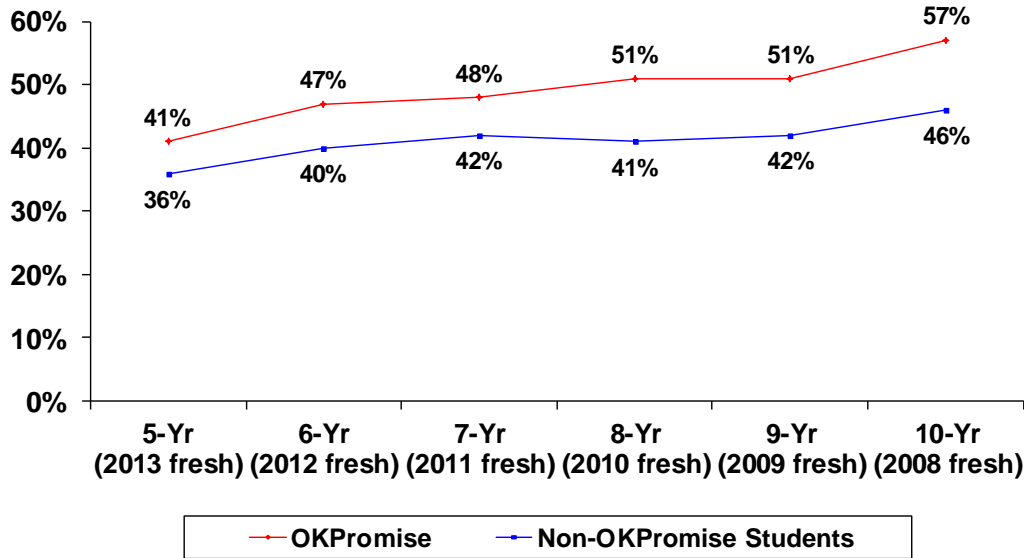
Full-Time College Enrollment



First-time entering students enrolled full-time in fall or spring semester

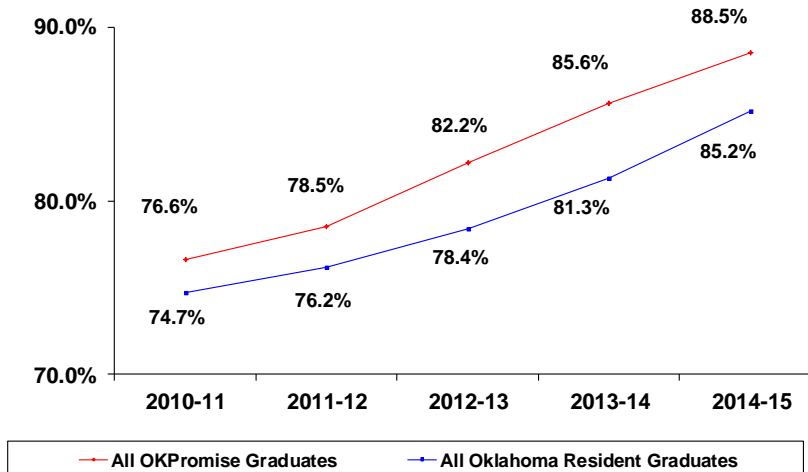
Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2017-18)

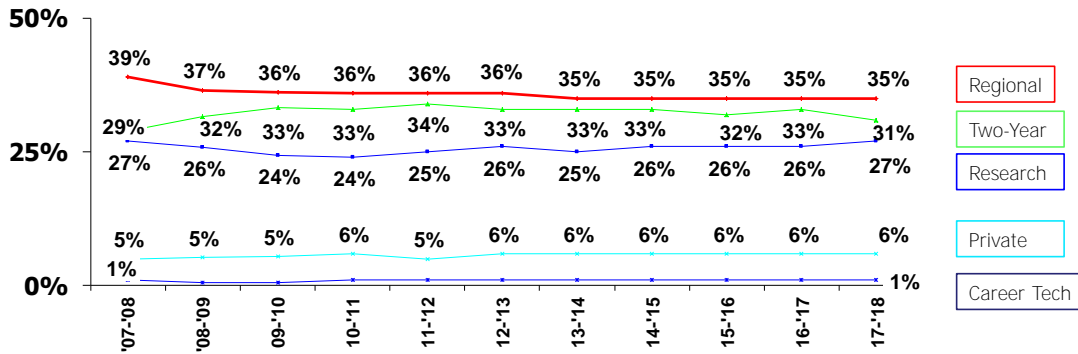


Employment of OKPromise Graduates

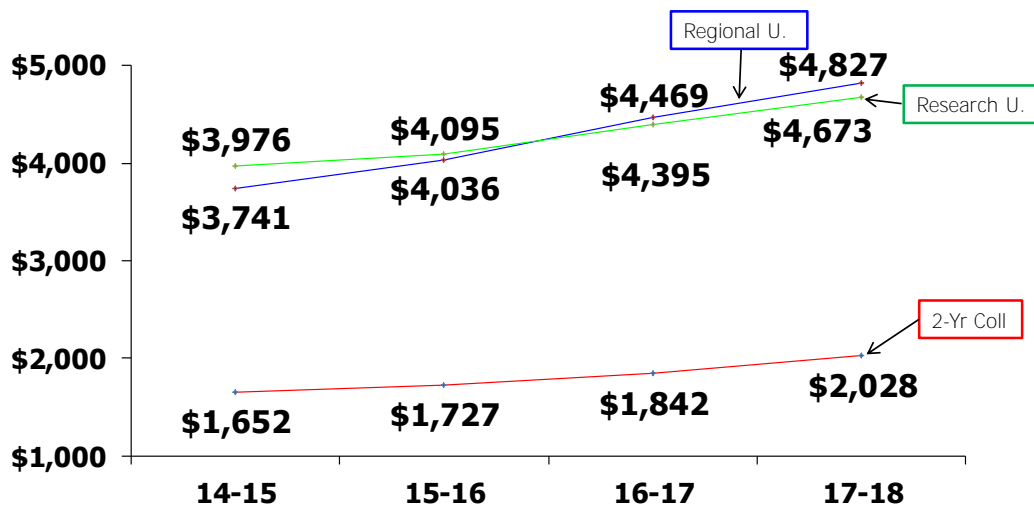

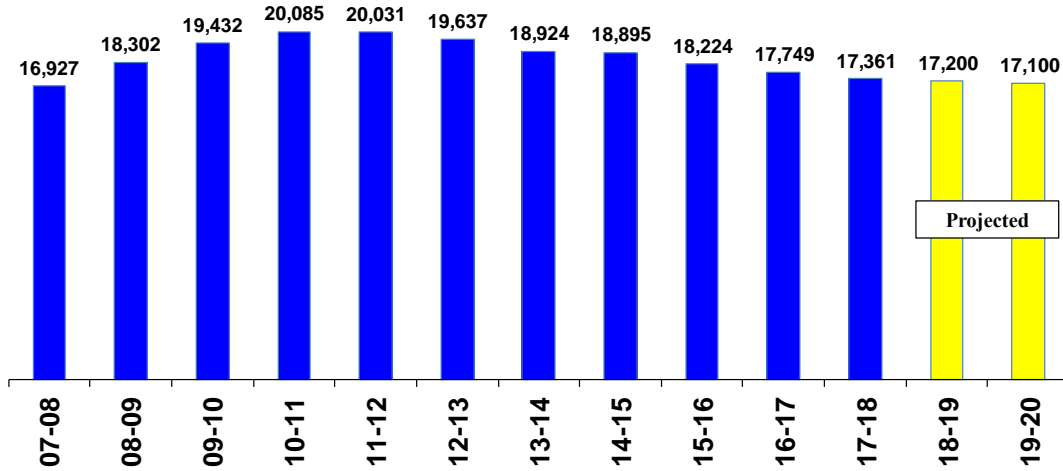
Where Do Oklahoma's Promise Students Attend College?



Average Annual Scholarship by Tier



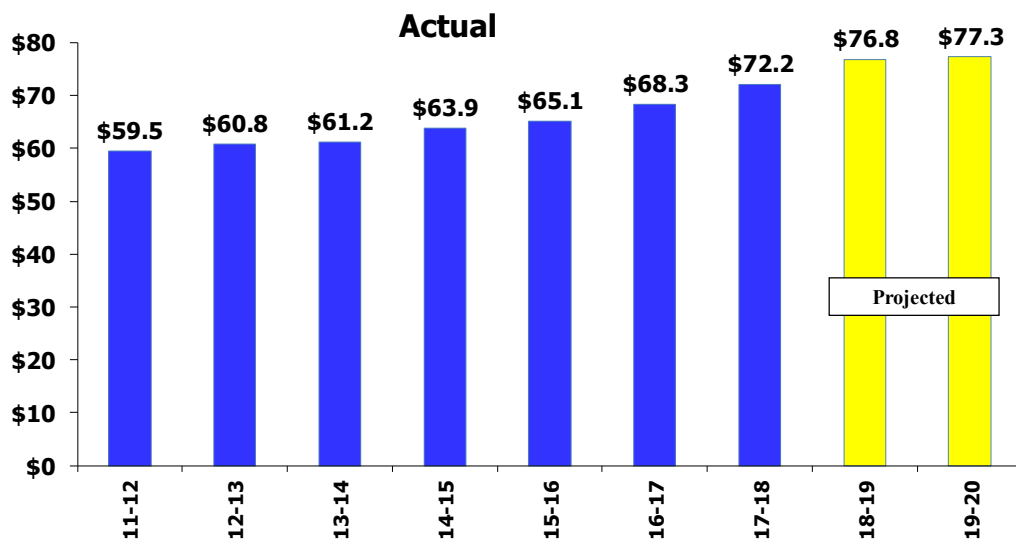
