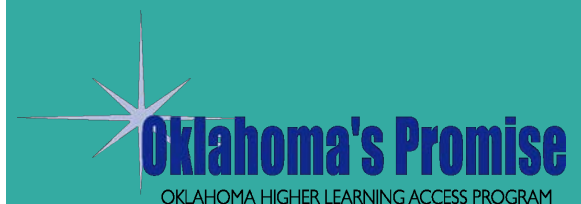


# Oklahoma's Promise 2021-22 Year-End Report

# Highlights

- In 2021-22, current and former Oklahoma’s Promise scholarship recipients earned a total of 4,500 certificates and degrees ranging from undergraduate certificates to doctoral and professional degrees. About half were bachelor degrees (52%) and a third (32%) were associate degrees. Another 10% were master’s degrees.
- During the 2022 session, the Oklahoma Legislature approved a significant change to the Oklahoma’s Promise family income application limit to allow higher incomes for families with more children. The new limits, which became effective for the 2022-23 school year, provide program eligibility at \$60,000 for families with 1-2 dependent children, \$70,000 for families with 3-4 dependent children, and \$80,000 for families with 5 or more dependent children.

@ During the 2017-2018 school year when the seniors of 2020 were 10<sup>th</sup> graders, the income limit was increased from \$50,000 to \$55,000 AGI.

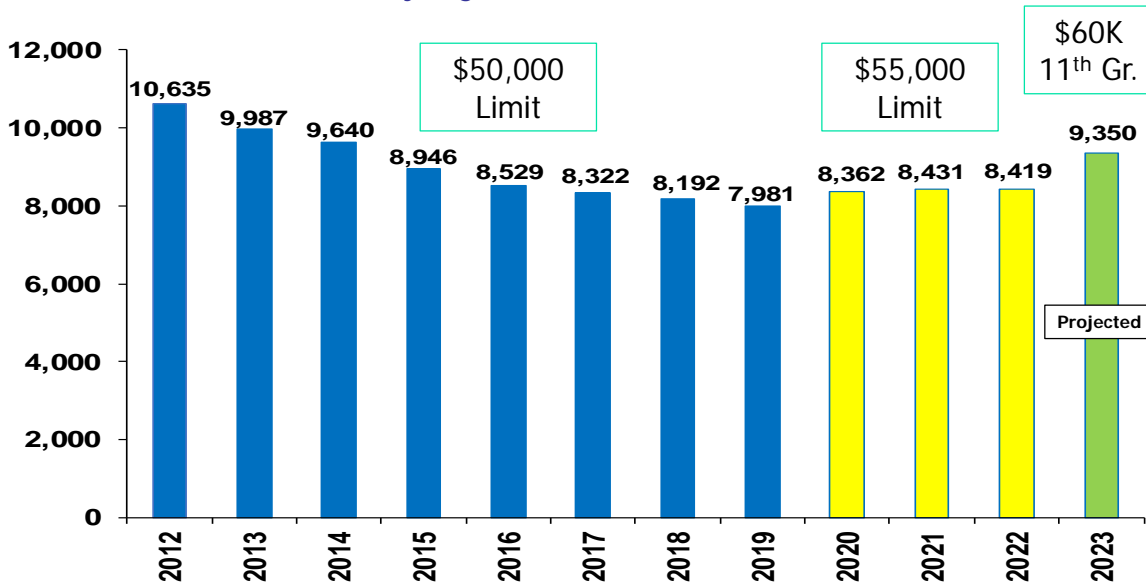
> During the 2021-2022 school year when the seniors of 2023 were 11<sup>th</sup> graders, the income limit was increased from \$55,000 to \$60,000 AGI and 11<sup>th</sup> graders were added to the list of eligible enrollees.

# The enrollment for 2023 may increase as some pending incomplete applications are processed.

\* The class of 2024 (11<sup>th</sup> grade), 2025 (10<sup>th</sup> grade), 2026 (9<sup>th</sup> grade) and 2027 (8<sup>th</sup> grade) are still open to enrollment in the 2022-2023 school year.



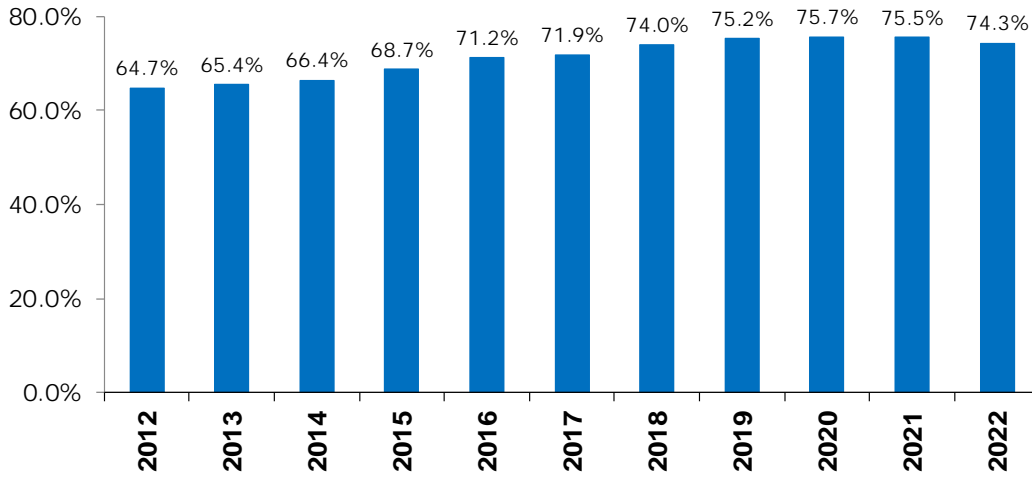
## OKPromise High School Enrollment (By High School Graduation Year)



As of 1/13/2023



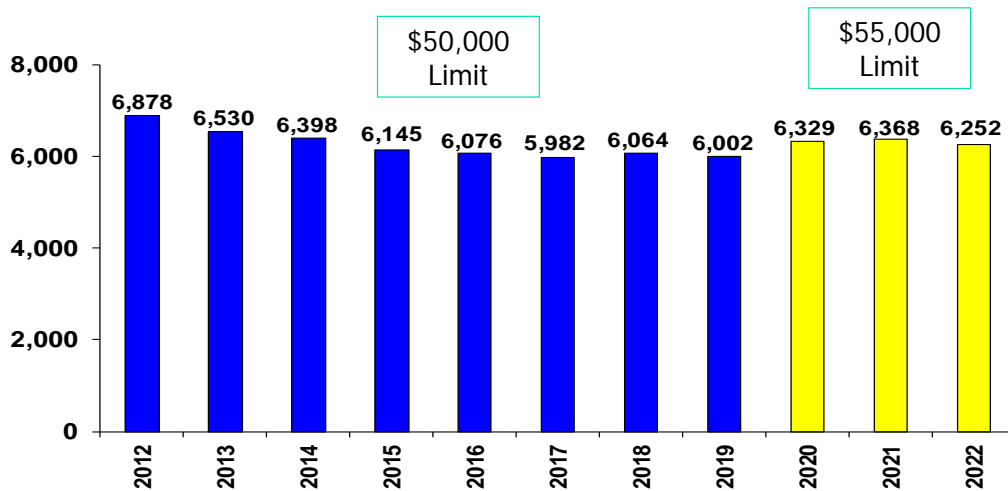
## High School Requirement Completion Rates (by grad year)



As of 1/13/2023

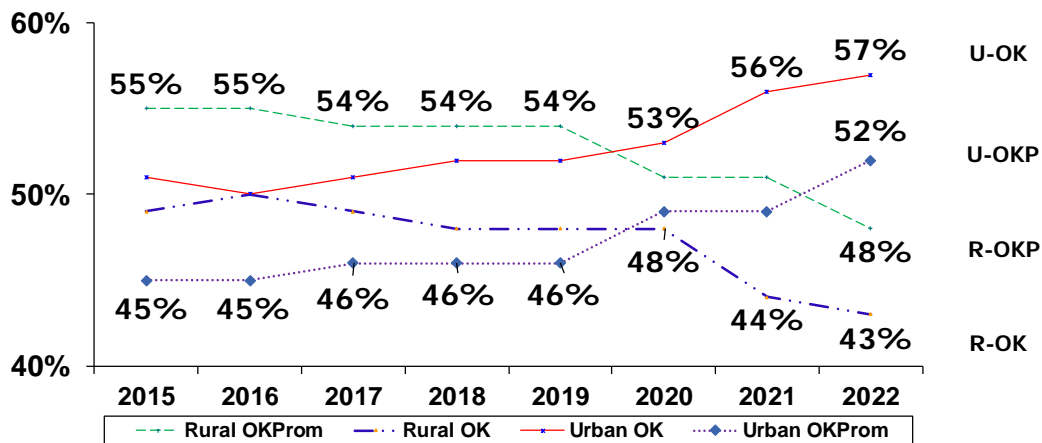


## High School Students Completing OKPromise Requirements (by Grad Year)



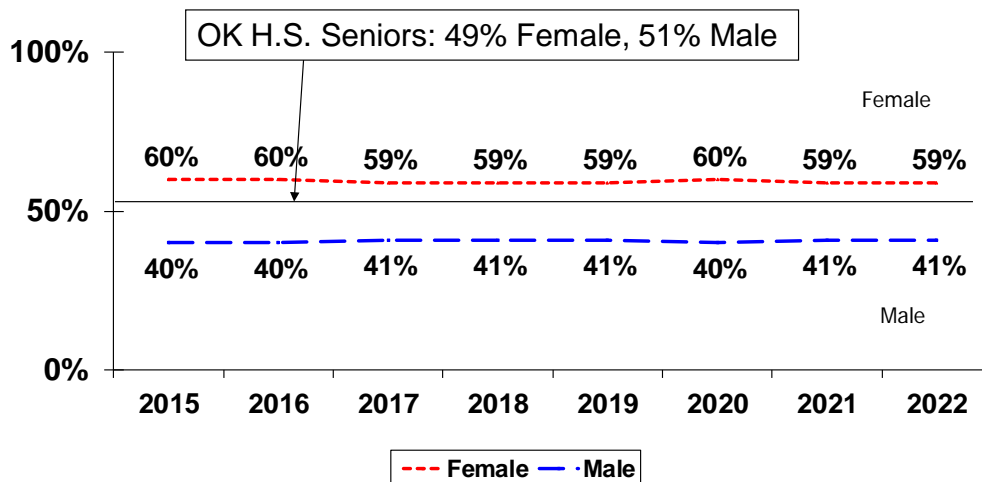

## Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2015-2022

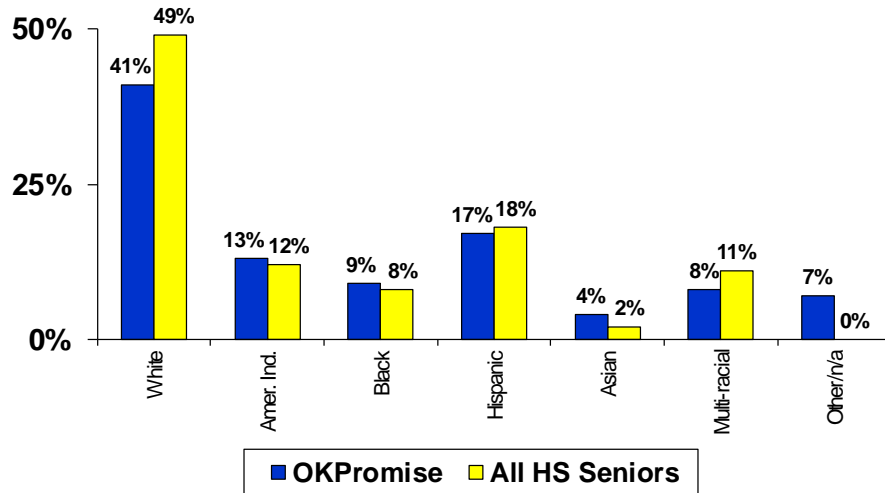

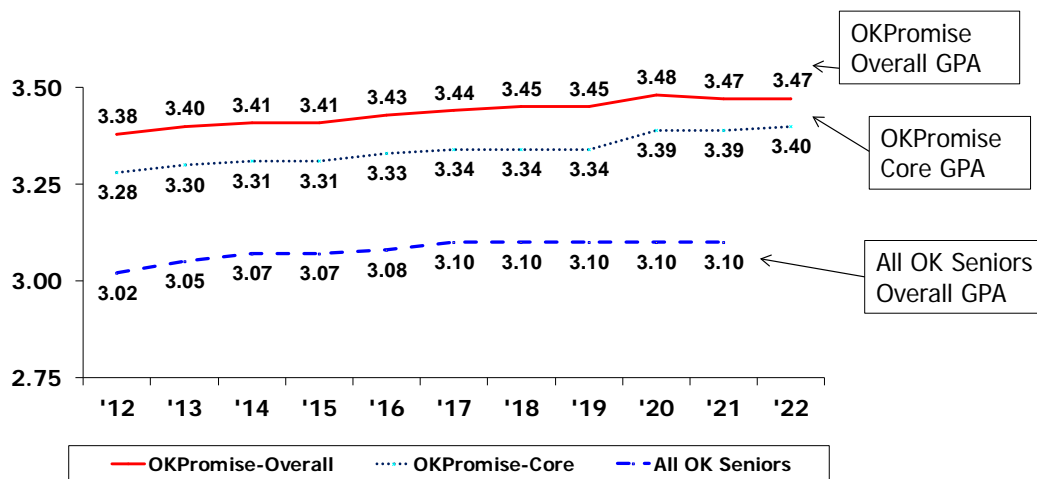
## Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2015-2022



## Ethnicity – 2022 HS Completers

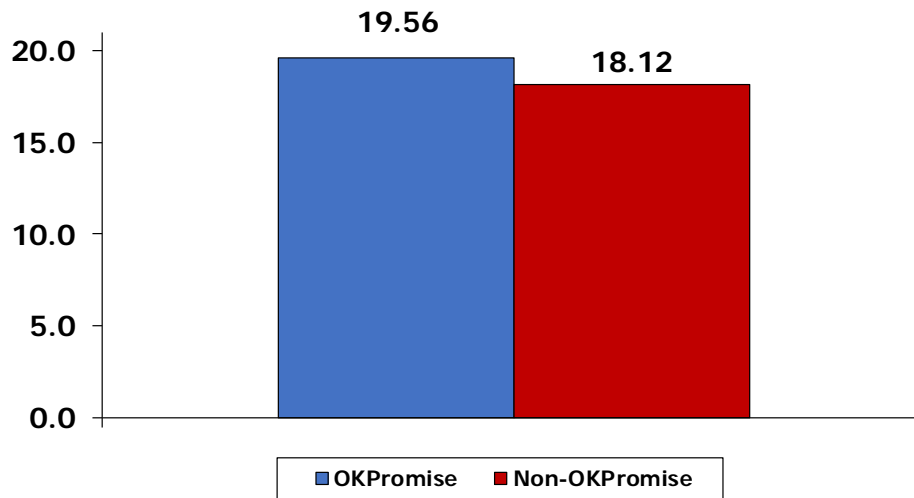


## High School GPA



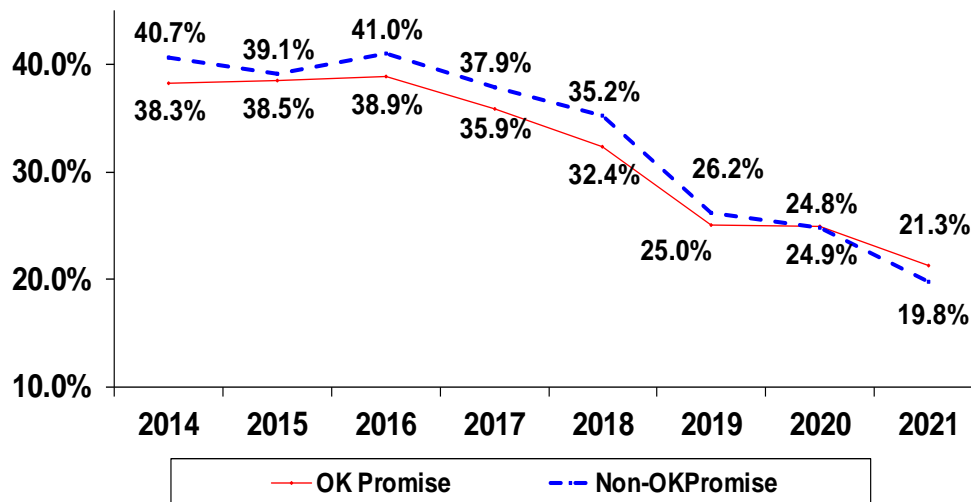


## 2022 ACT Composite Scores

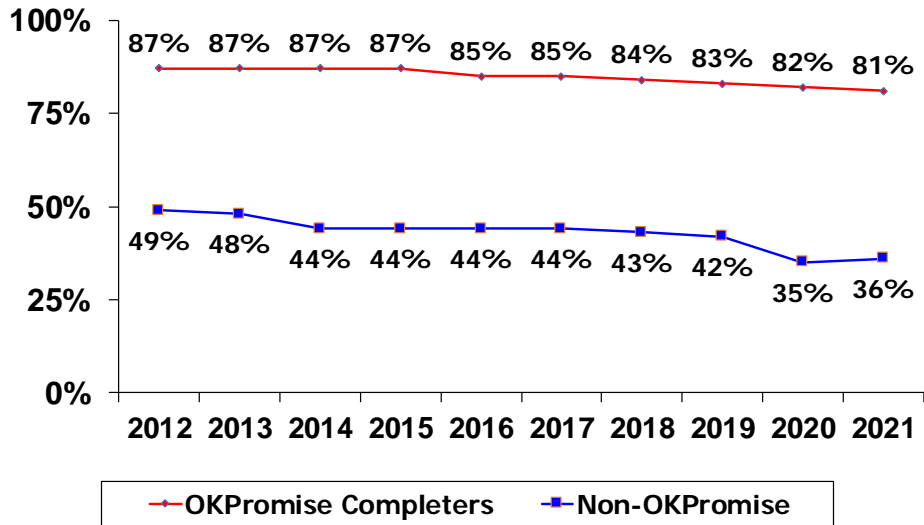


## College Remediation Rates

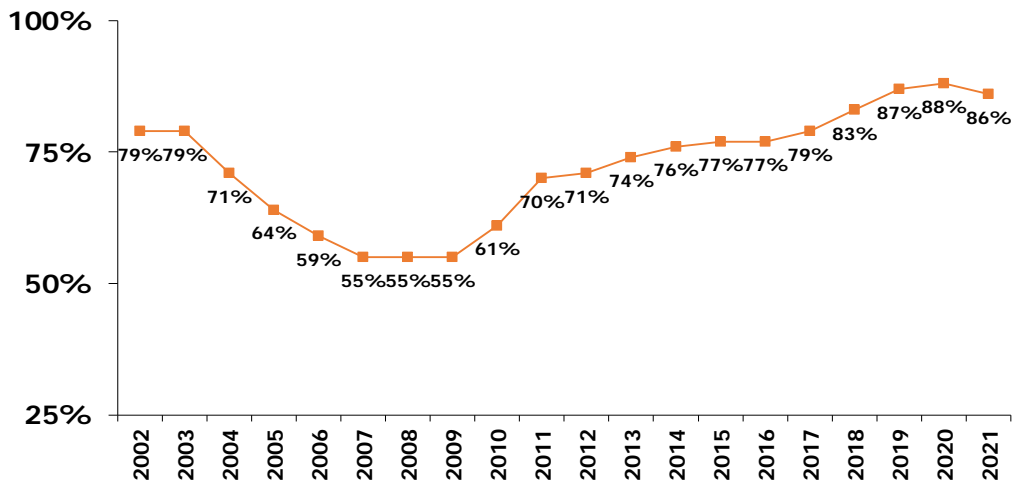

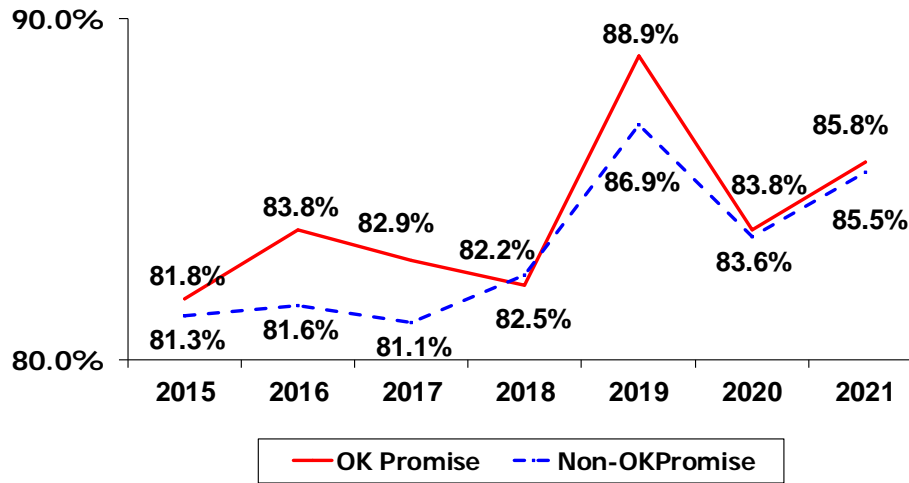


## Percent of OKPromise Recipients Eligible for Federal Pell Grants





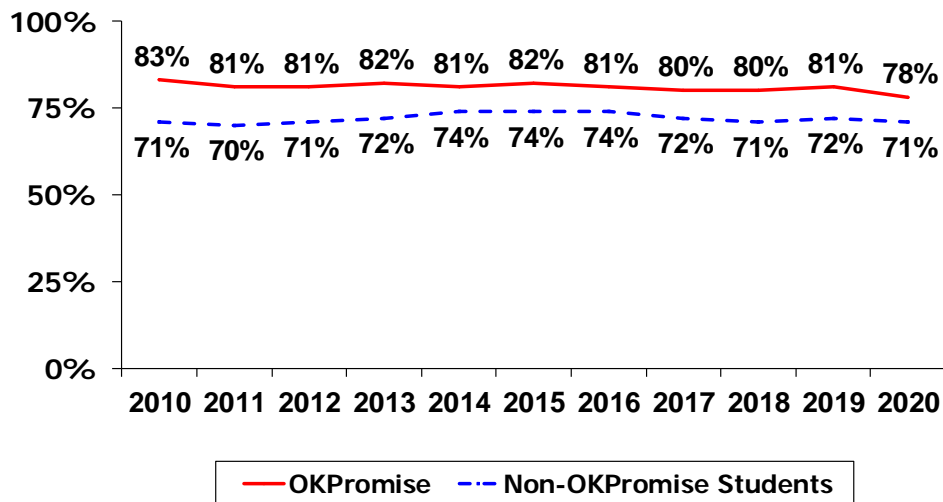
## College Freshmen – GPA of at least 2.0



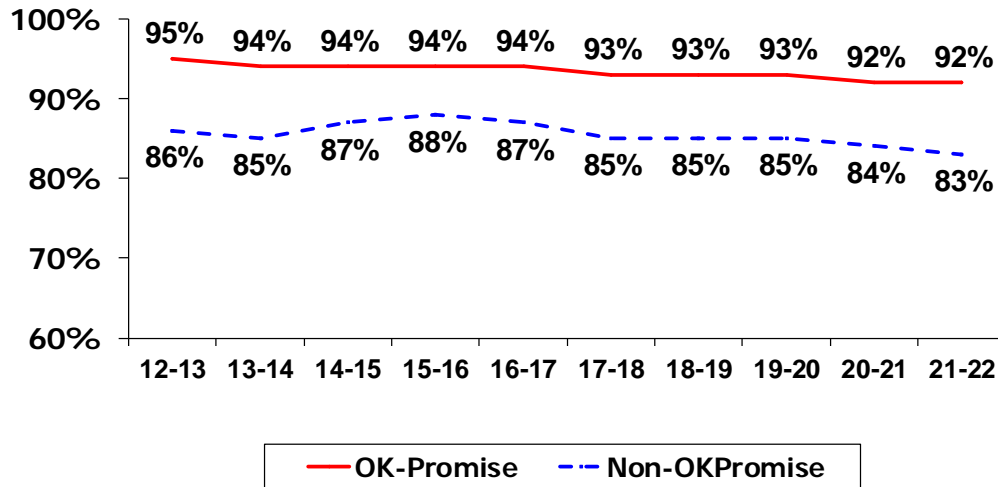

## College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



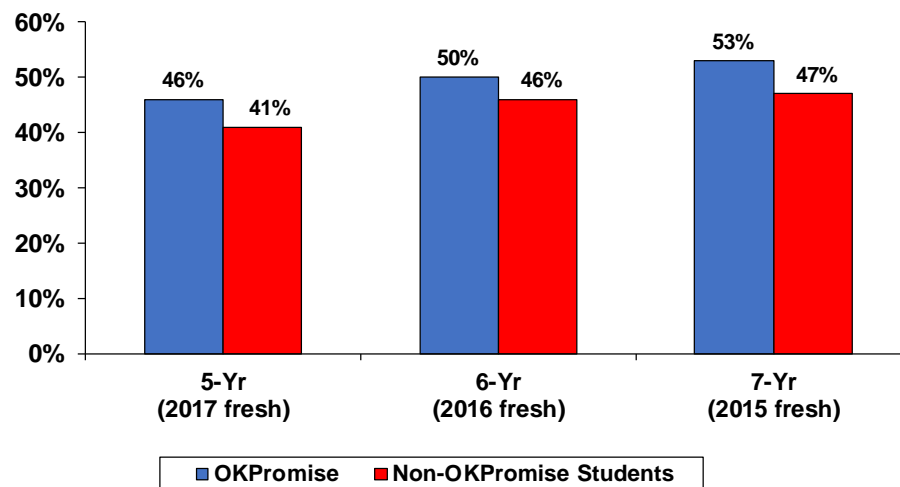
## Full-Time College Enrollment

(First Certificate, Associate Degree or Bachelor Degree earned through 2021-22)

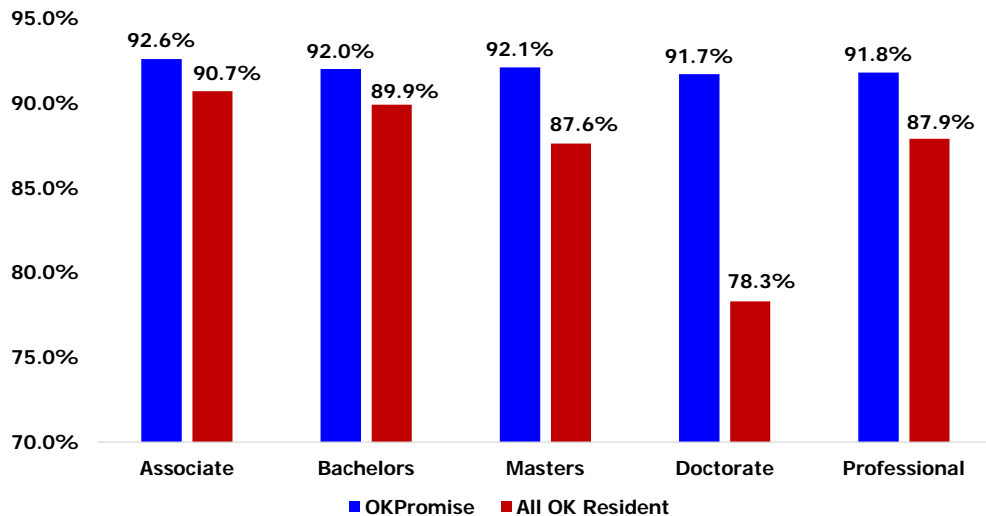

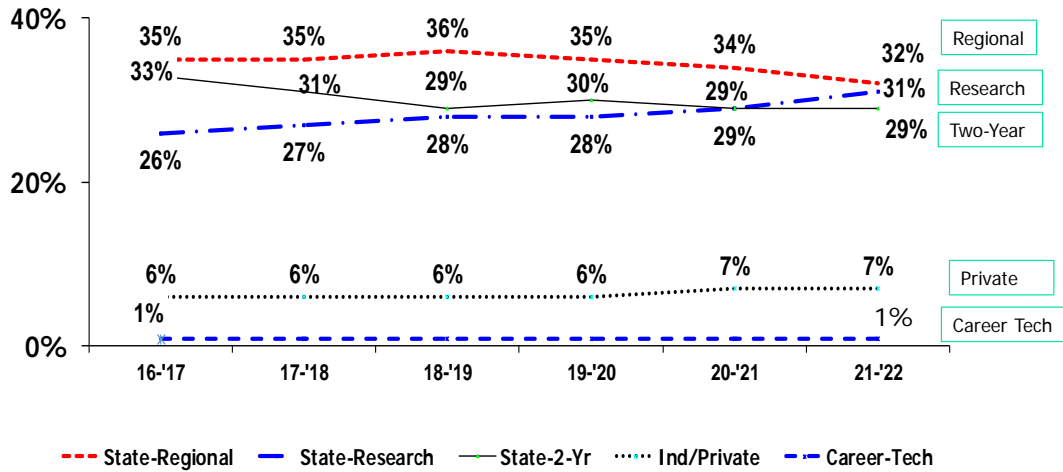

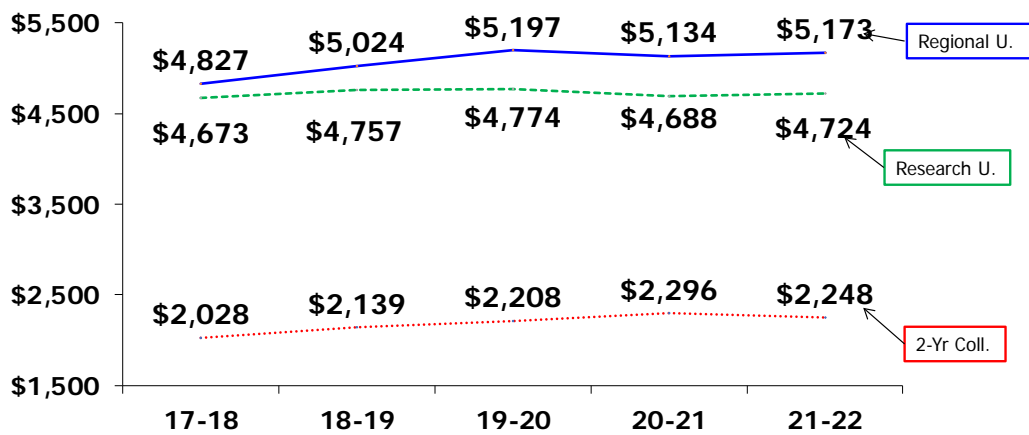
## Employment of Graduates in Oklahoma One Year after Graduation



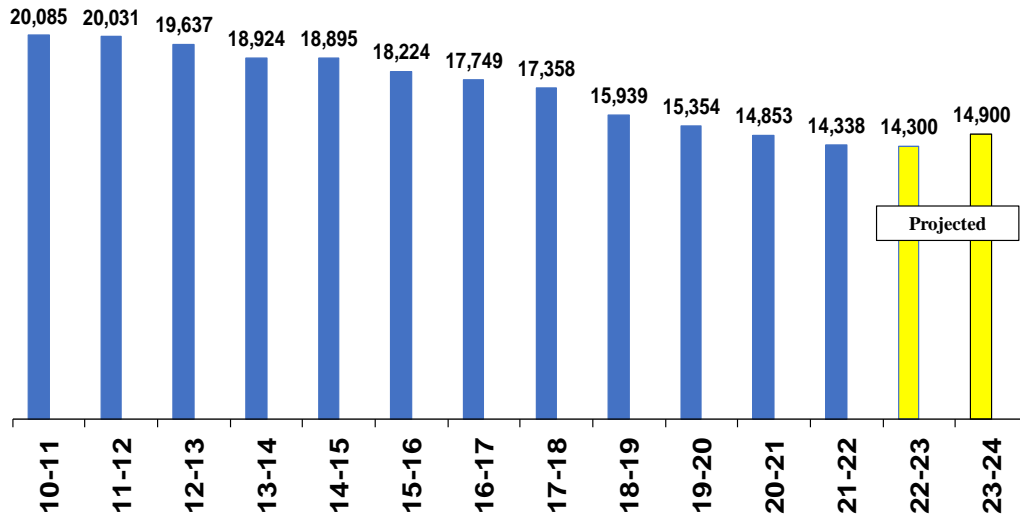
## Where Do Oklahoma's Promise Students Attend College?



## Average Annual Scholarship by Tier



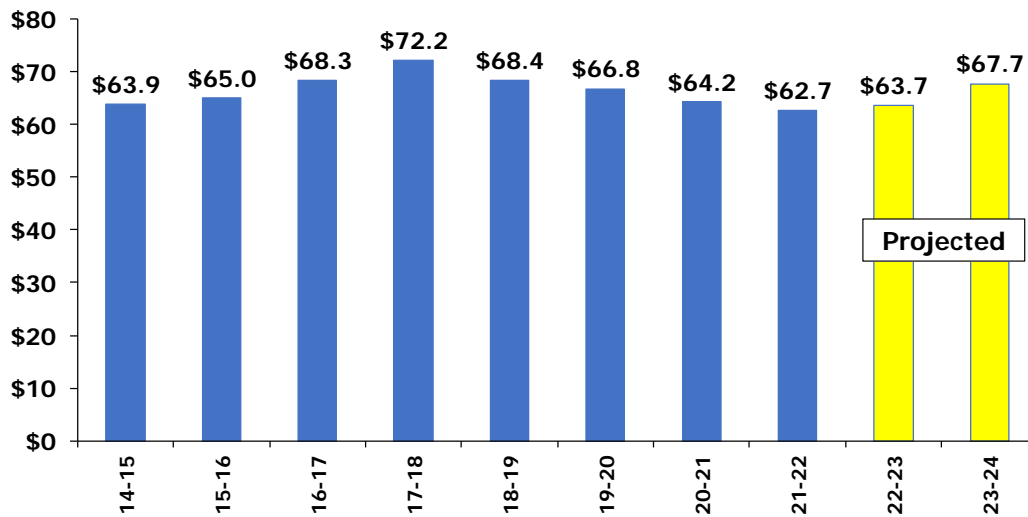
