



2020-21 Year End Report

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Since 2017-18, annual scholarship expenditures have decreased a total of \$8 million or 11%. Factors contributing to the cost reductions include legislative reforms passed in 2017 that eliminated award payments for non-credit remedial courses and require checking of the \$100,000 second income limit each year the student is in college. In addition, an increasing number of colleges have not raised tuition rates in recent years; in 2020-21 nearly 70% of state public colleges did not increase tuition.
- Since 2017-18, the number of scholarship recipients has also declined by about 2,500 or 14%. However due to legislative action to increase the application income limit from \$50,000 to \$55,000 (effective for 2020 high school graduates) and to \$60,000 (effective for 2023 high school graduates), the number of scholarship recipients is expected to stabilize and begin gradually increasing in future years. In addition, in 2021 the Oklahoma Legislature acted to extend the scholarship application period to include the 11th grade, beginning in 2021-22. Students may now apply anytime during grades 8-11.

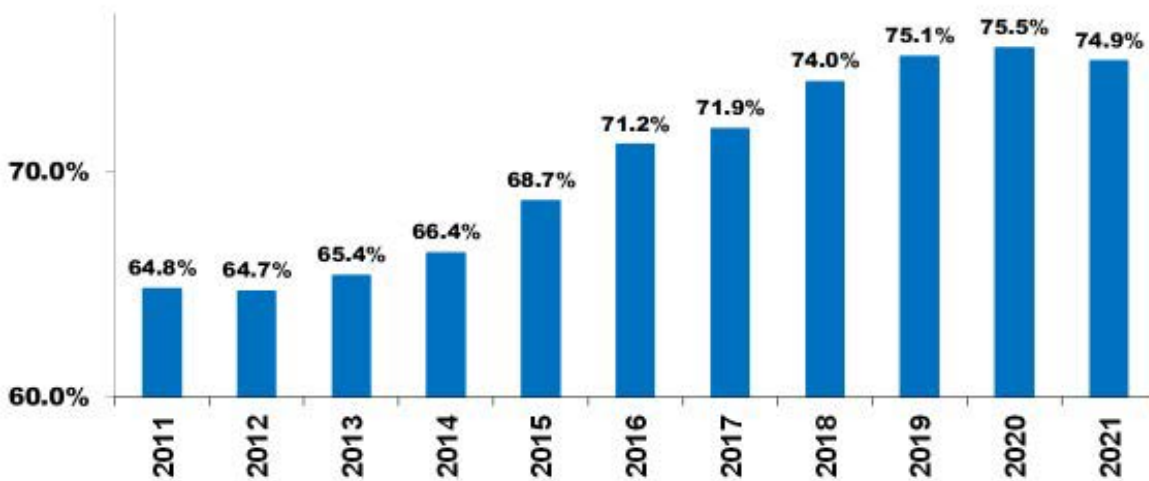

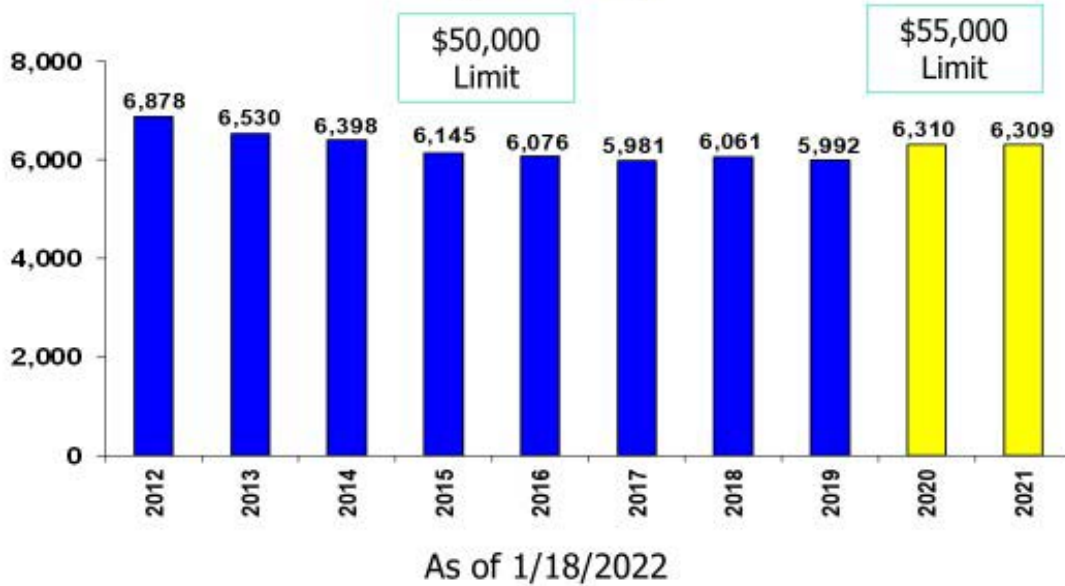
High School Requirement Completion Rates (by grad year)



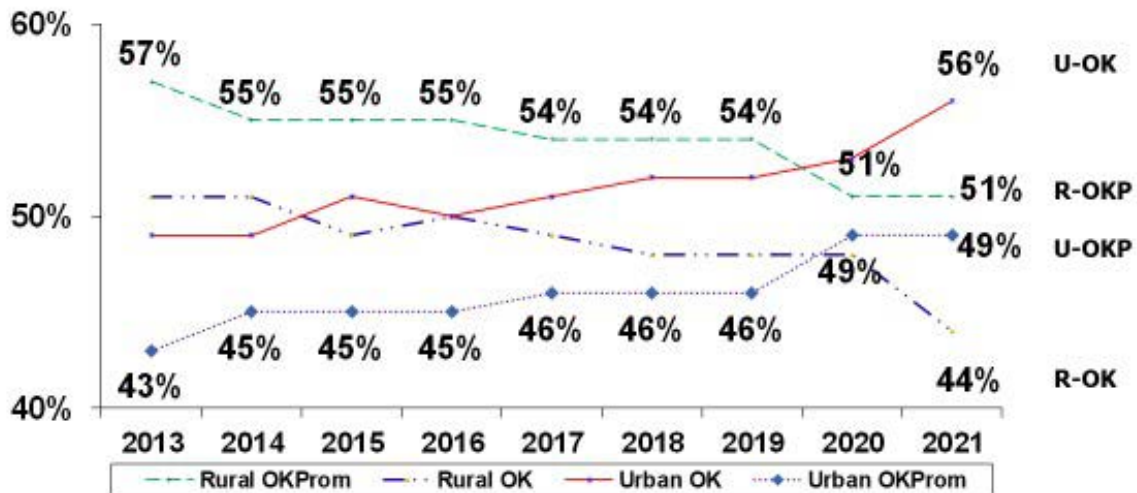

(by Grad Year)

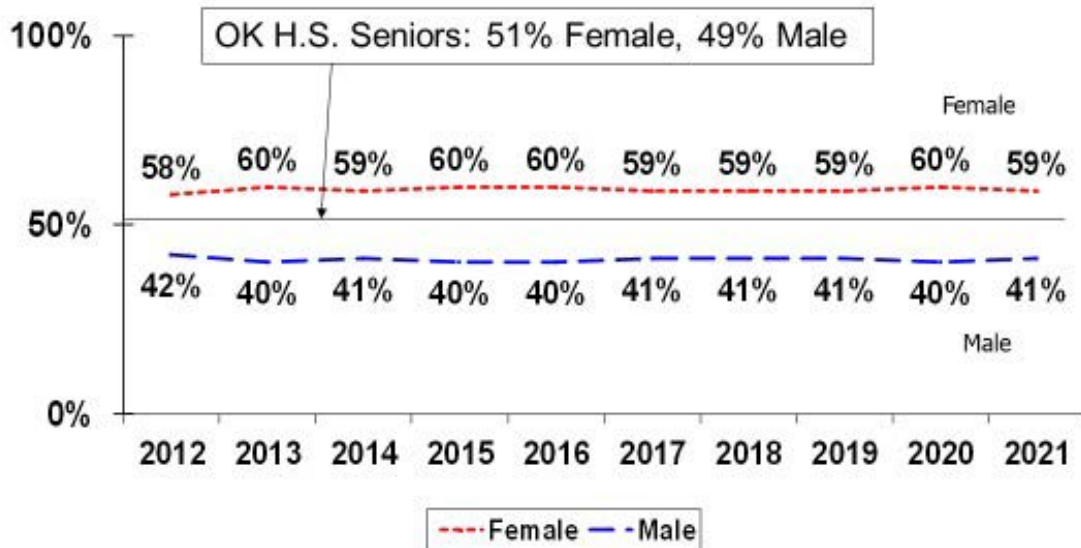


Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2013-2021

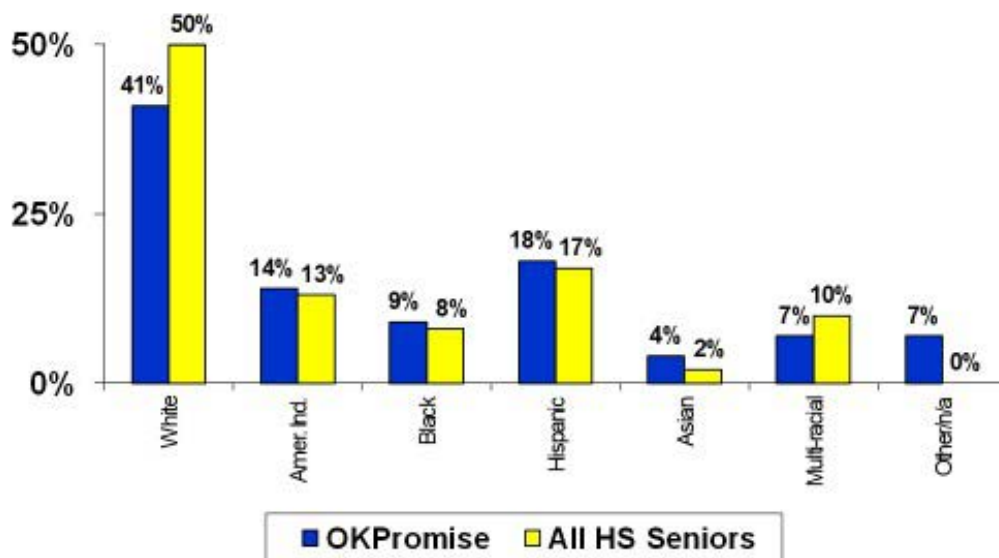

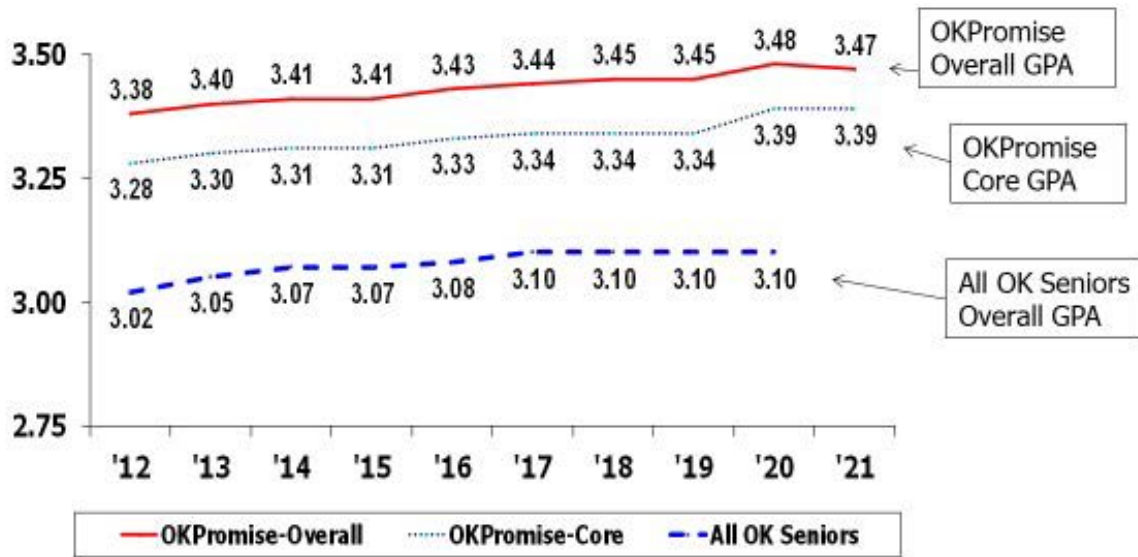
Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2012-2021



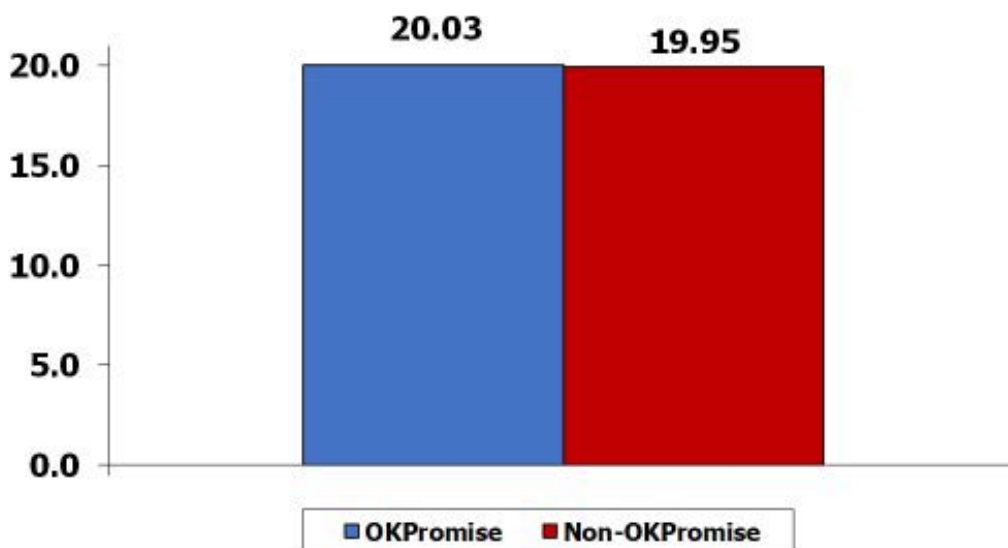
Ethnicity – 2021 HS Completers



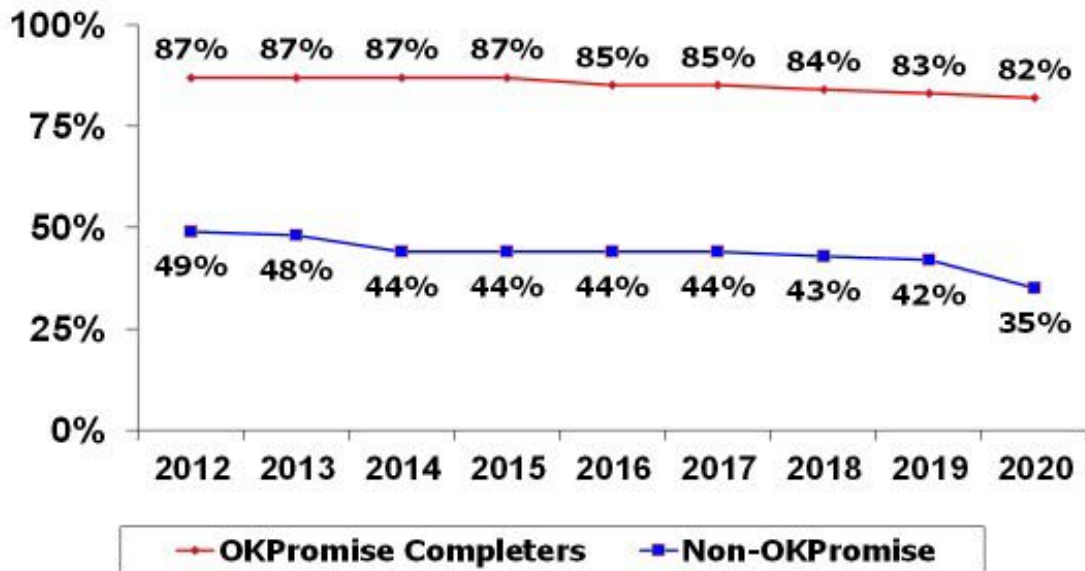
High School GPA



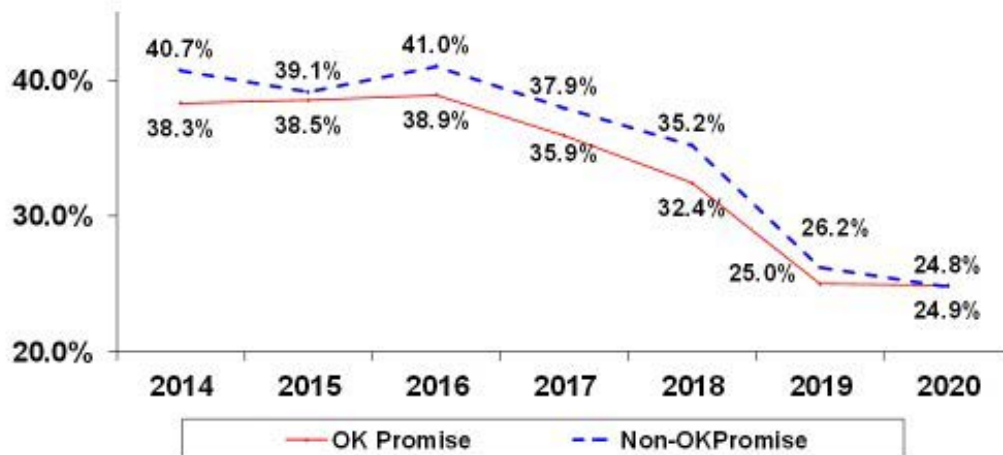
2021 ACT Composite Scores



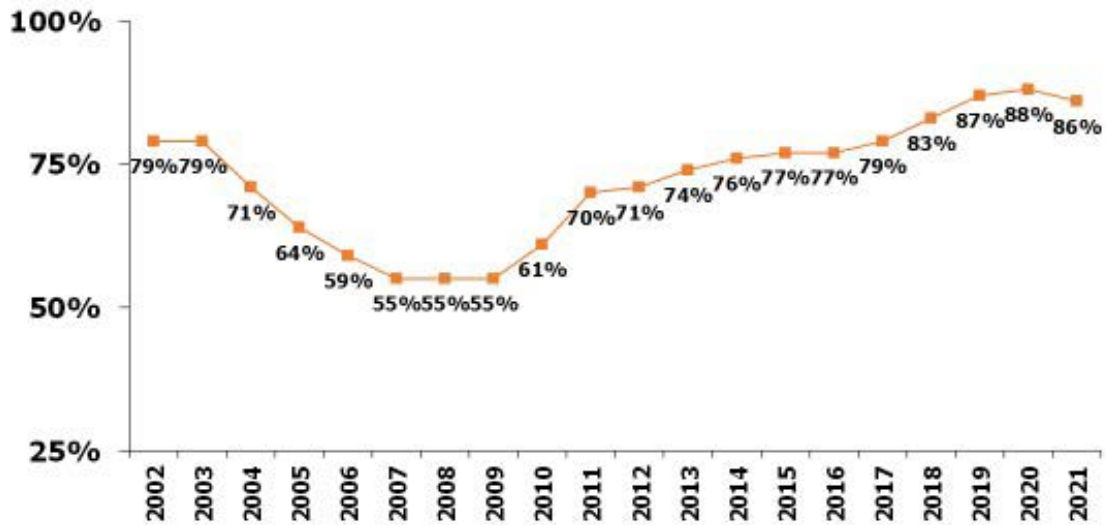
College-Going Rates



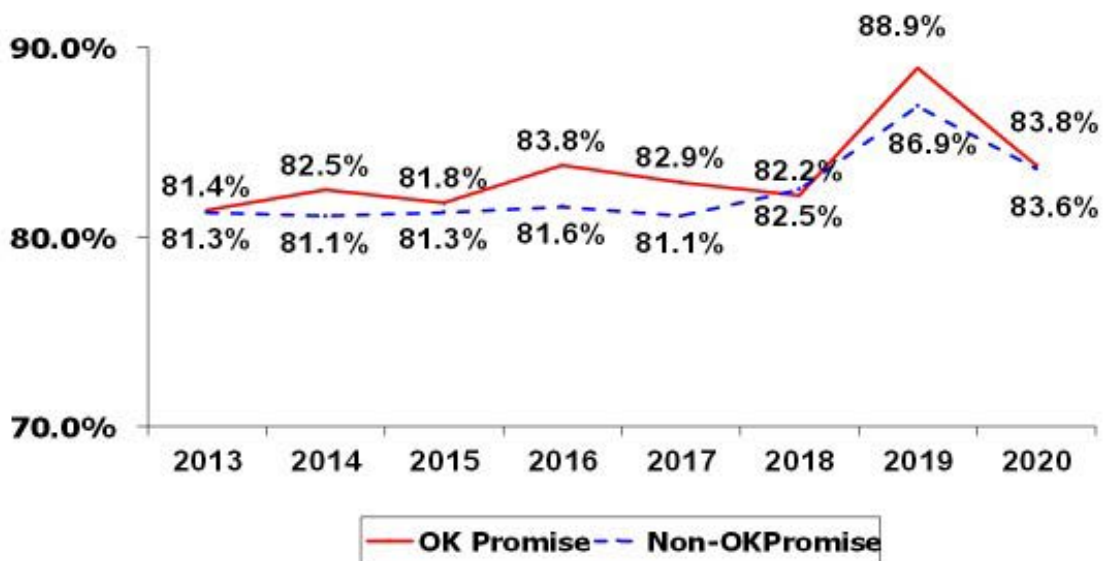
College Remediation Rates



Percent of OKPromise Recipients Eligible for Federal Pell Grants

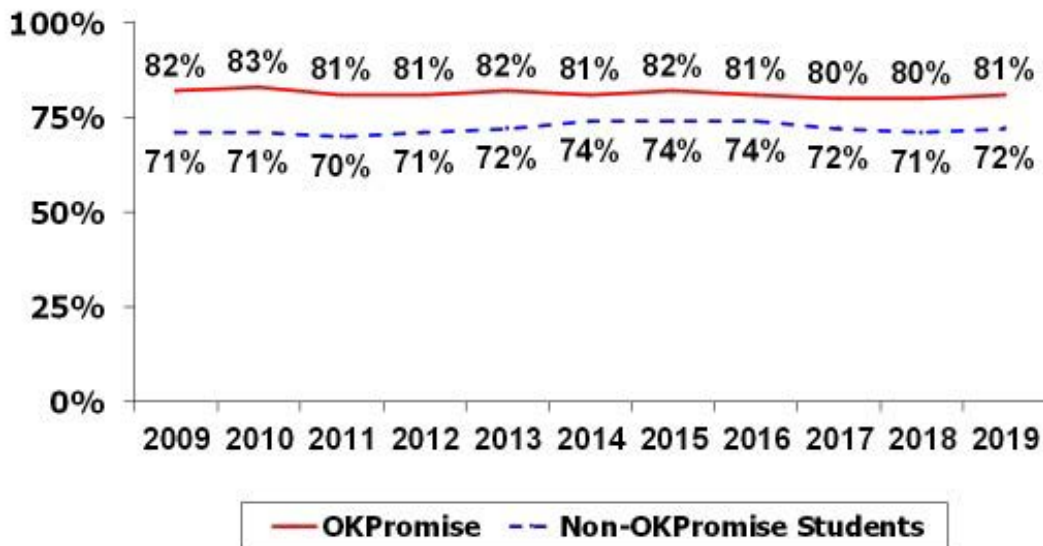


College Freshmen – GPA of at least 2.0

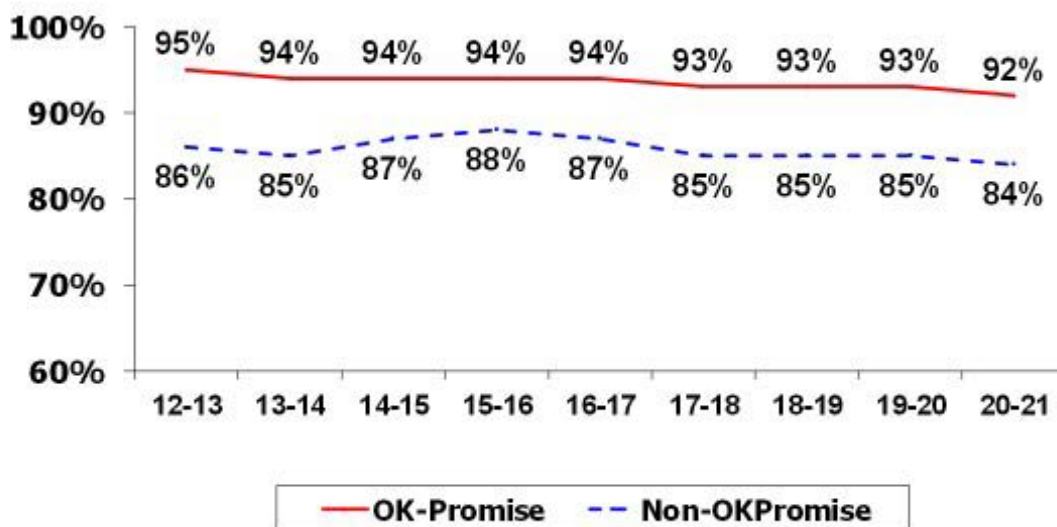

College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



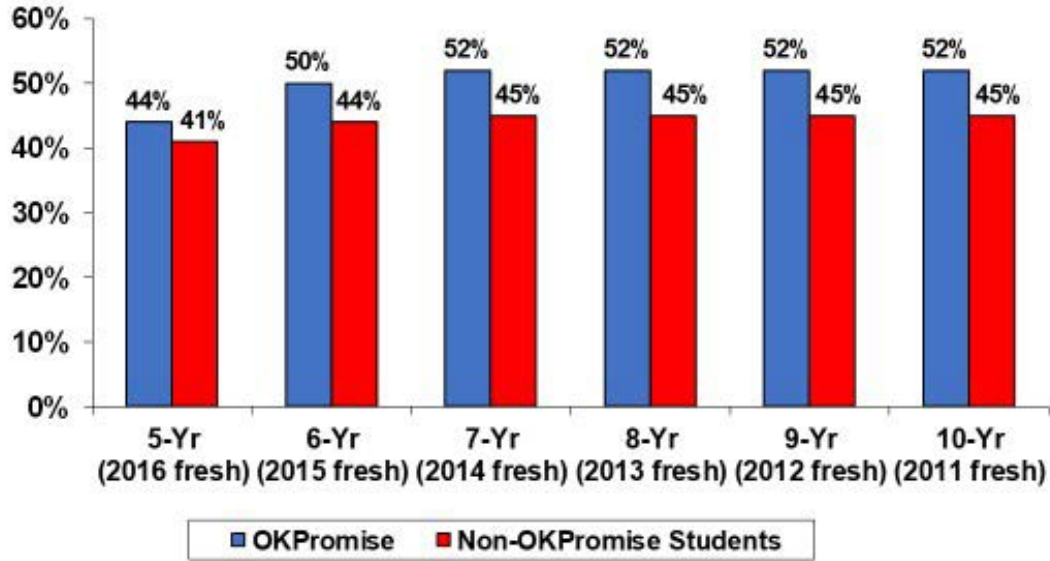
Full-Time College Enrollment



First-time entering students enrolled full-time in fall or spring semester

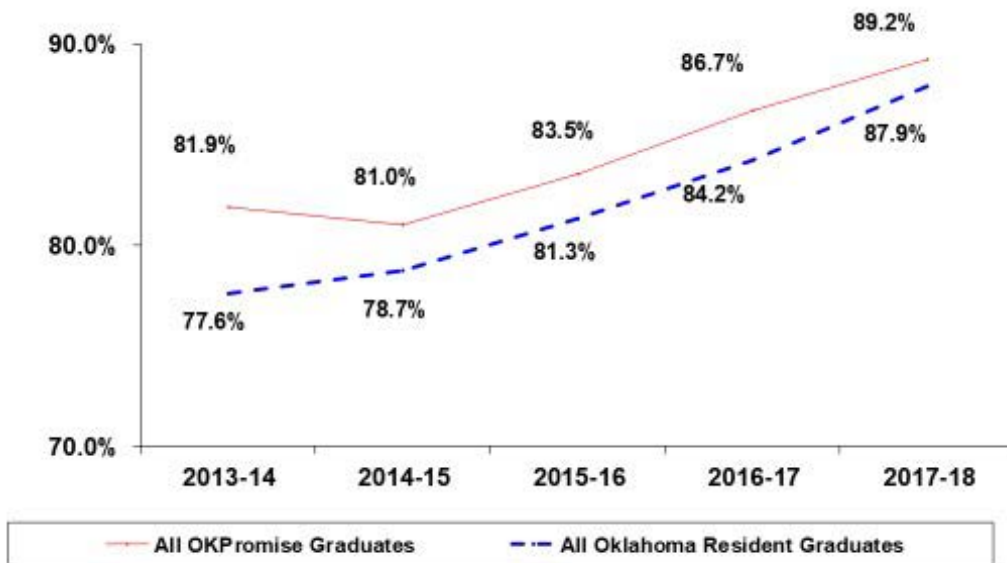
Degree Completion Rates

(First Associate or Bachelor Degree earned through 2020-21)

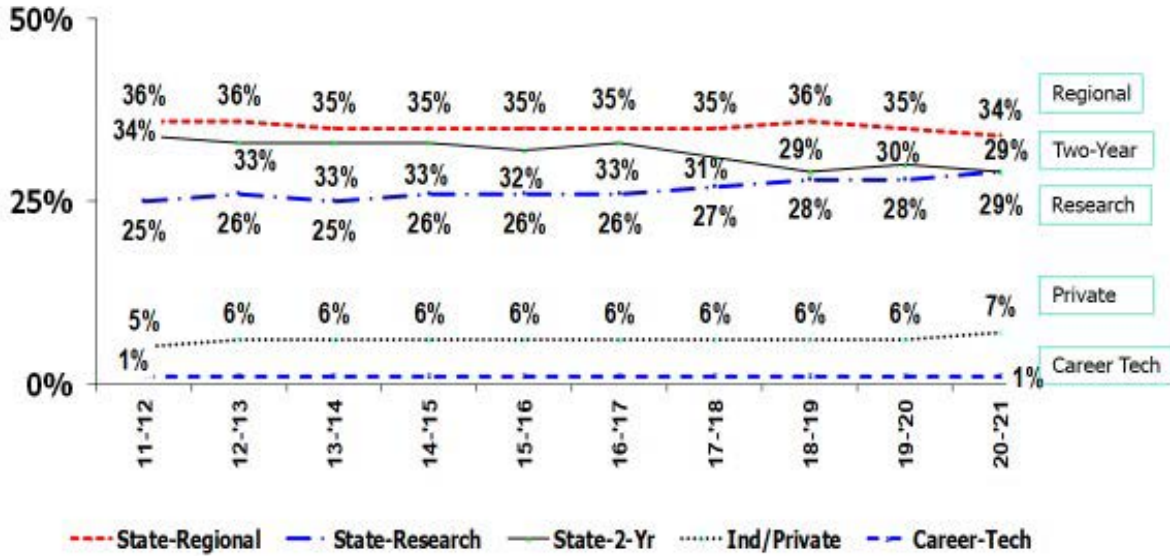


Employment of OKPromise Graduates

(Employed in Oklahoma between April 2018 and June 2019)



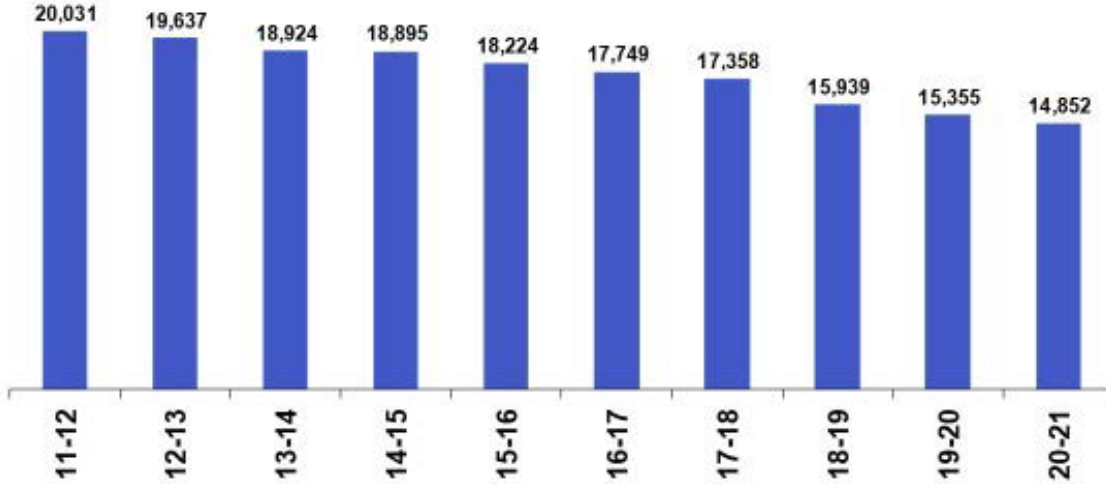
Where Do Oklahoma's Promise Students Attend College?
