



2006-07 Year-End Report

HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Program Passes \$100 Million Milestone:** At the end of the 2006-07 school year, the Oklahoma’s Promise scholarship program passed the \$100 million mark for the total amount of scholarships paid to students since the first awards were made in 1996. In the eleven years between 1996 and 2007, nearly 22,000 students received \$102 million.

- **Legislature Makes Significant Changes:** During the 2007 legislative session, the Oklahoma Legislature made several important changes to the program that will be implemented over the coming years. The changes include:
 - A dedicated source of funding beginning in 2008-09.
 - A second family income requirement that will be applied to students that begin college in 2009-10 and thereafter.
 - A new unique minimum college GPA requirement that will also be applied to students beginning college in 2009-10 and thereafter.
 - A new college conduct requirement that becomes effective January 1, 2008.
 - A new requirement that students be U.S. citizens or lawfully present in the United States to receive the scholarship in college. Students enrolling in the program in 2007-08 and thereafter will be subject to this new requirement.
 - Eligibility for homeschool students to participate in the program.

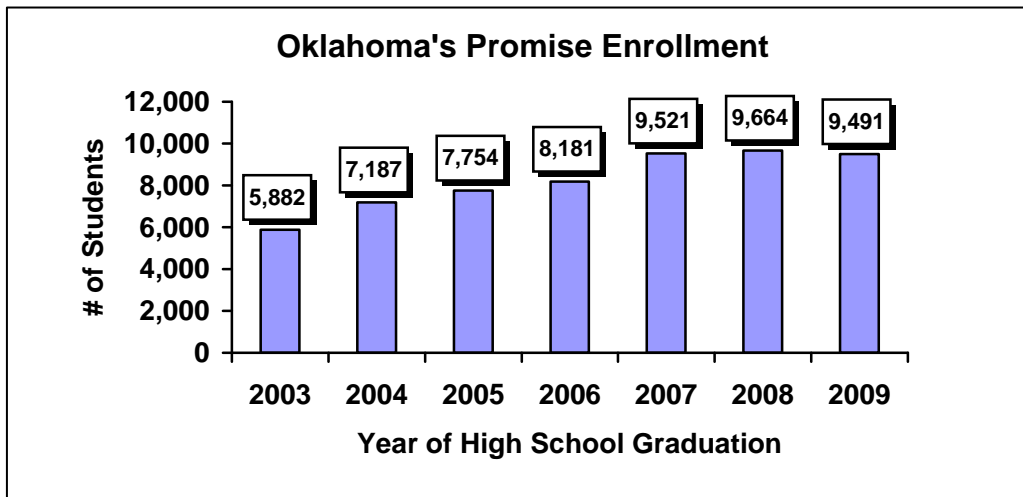

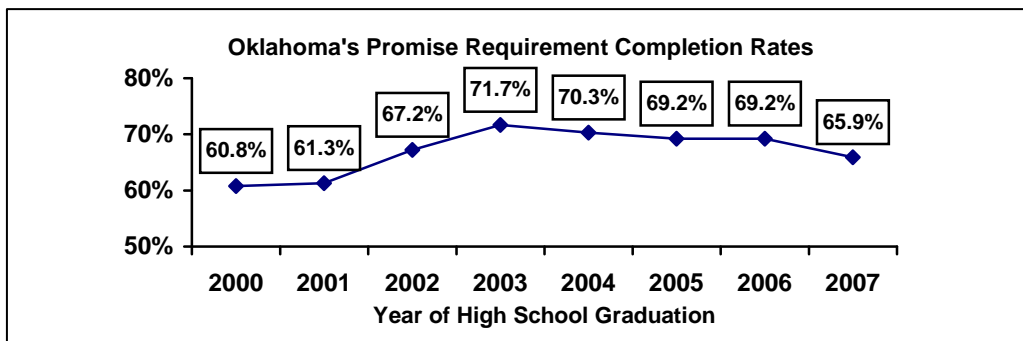

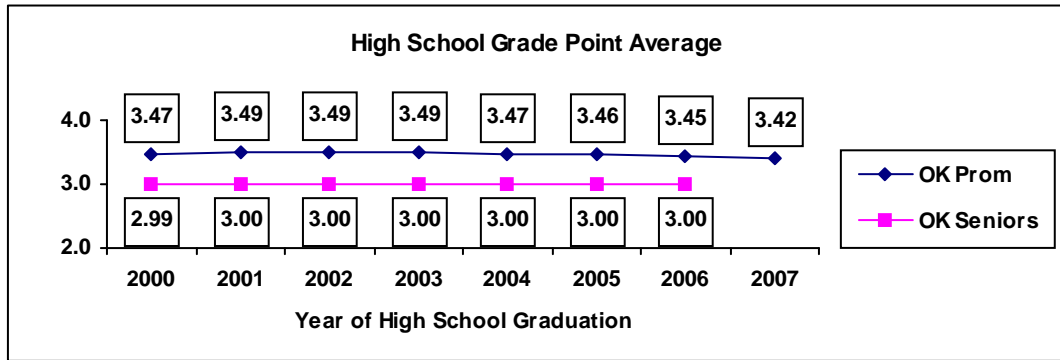

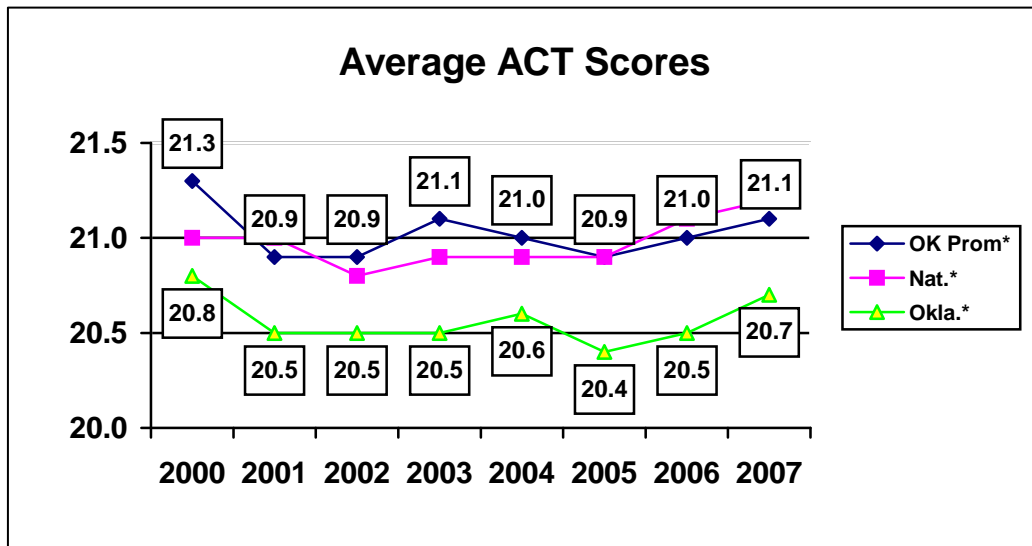
II. **Program Requirement Completion Rates:**



III. **High School Grade Point Average (GPA):**

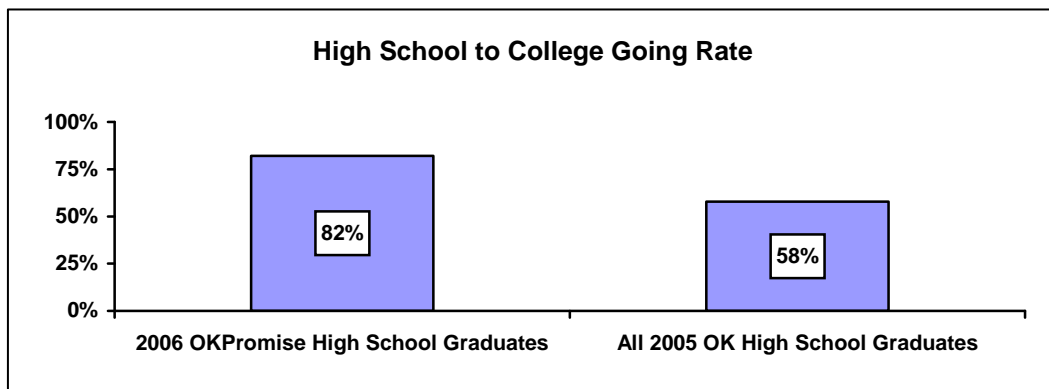

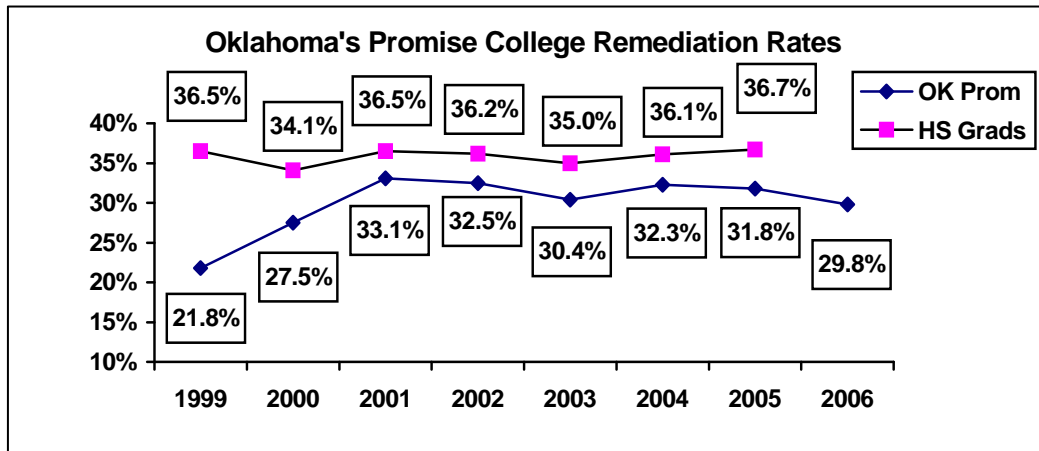

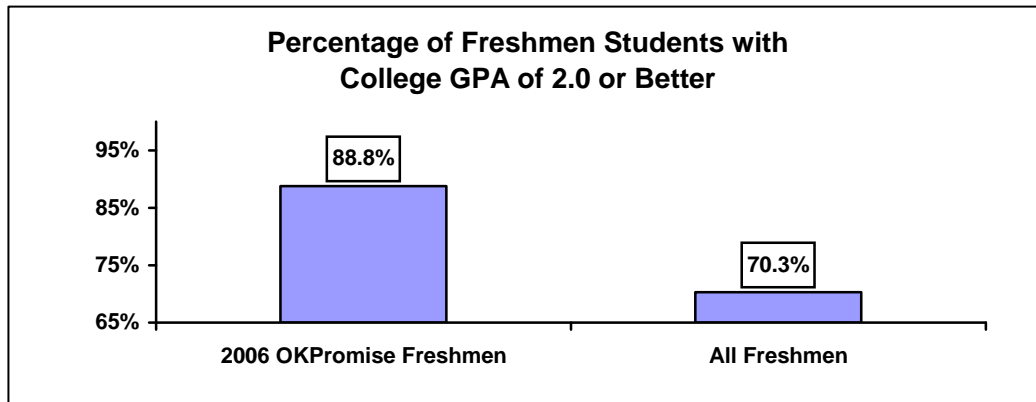
V. **High School to College-Going Rate:** (Oklahoma's Promise high school graduates enrolling in college the year immediately following high school graduation)



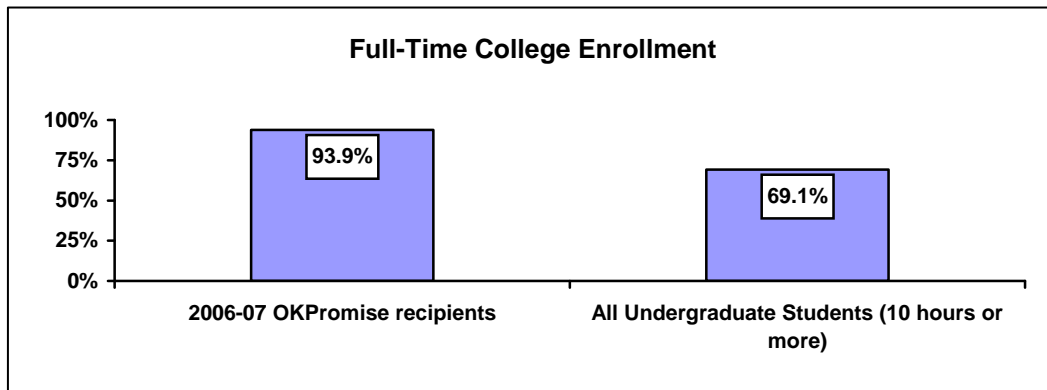

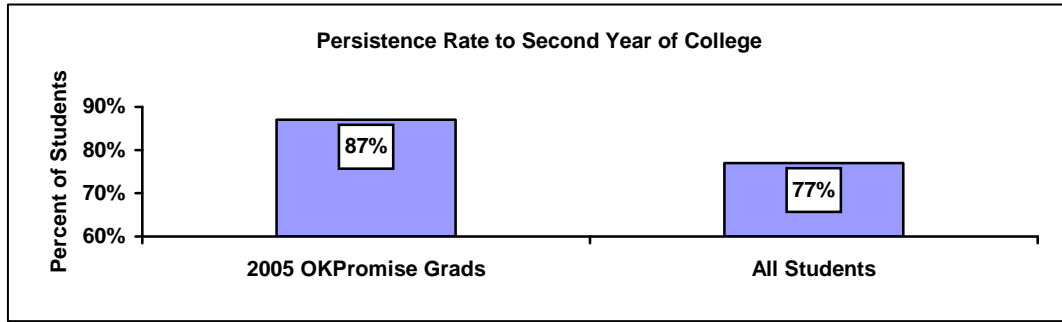

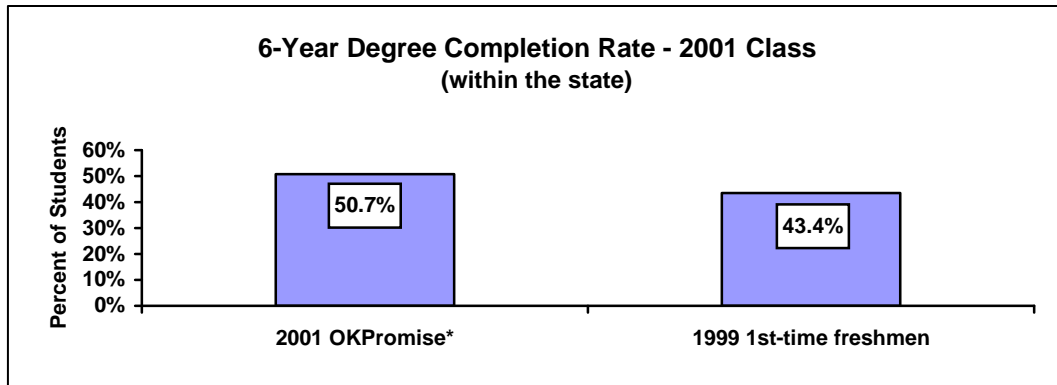

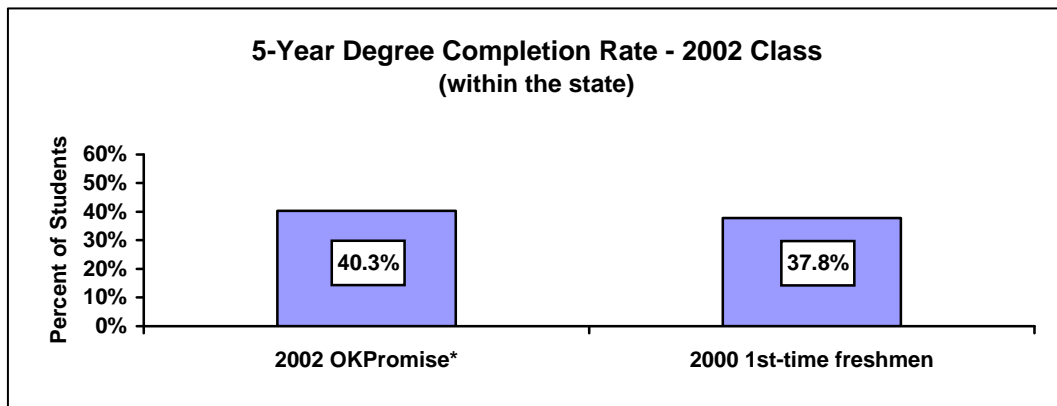

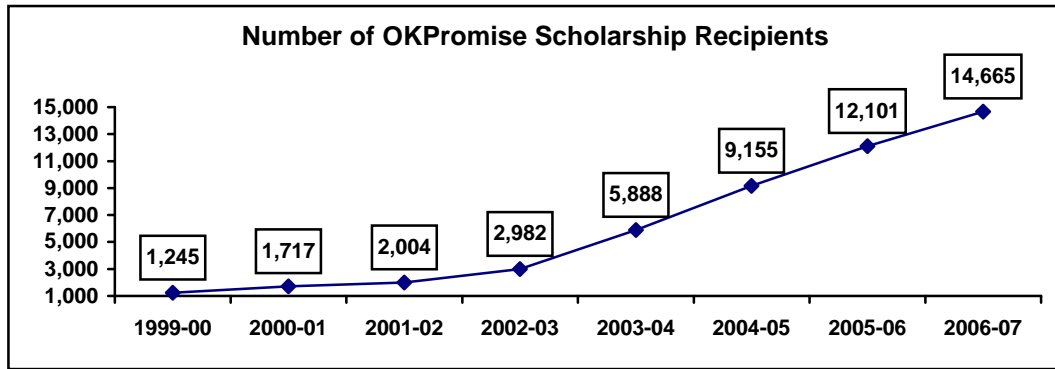

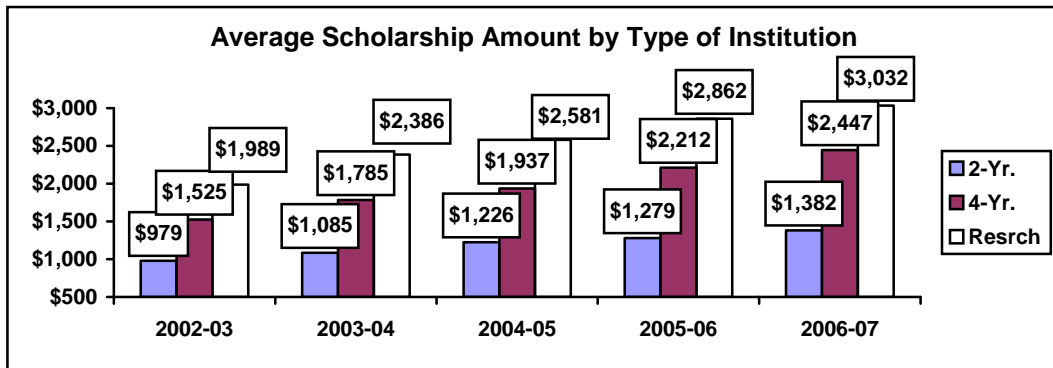

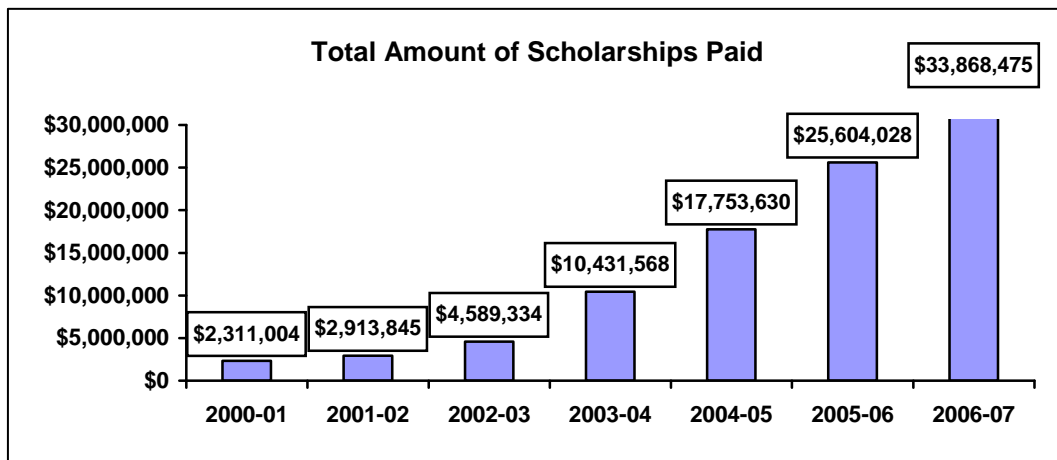
XI. Number of Scholarship Recipients:

“OHLAP-Plus” Scholarships

In August 1999, the Oklahoma State Regents were awarded a five-year \$20.5 million federal grant through a new program named GEAR UP (Gaining Early Awareness for Undergraduate Programs). A sixth year of funding was awarded for 2004-05, and funds were available from interest earned in the Gear Up trust fund for 2005-06. The goal of the program is to increase the number of low-income students who complete college degrees. A significant portion of the grant funding was designated for direct scholarship expenses. To build upon the existing success of Oklahoma’s Promise, the scholarships were targeted at Oklahoma’s Promise students with the greatest financial need.

OHLAP-Plus awards were made in the Fall 2006 and Spring 2007 semesters. The funds were depleted by the end of the Spring 2007 semester, and OHLAP-Plus will be discontinued for future years if additional funding is not made available. Only OKPromise participants graduating high school in 2002 and prior years were eligible for the OHLAP-Plus scholarship. The remaining funds available for the award in 2006-07 were sufficient to continue paying the award to those OKPromise college students who had previously received the award.

Amount of the Scholarship: In 2006-07, the GEAR UP funds allowed an eligible OKPromise student to receive an additional award that doubled the amount of their regular OKPromise scholarship (hence the name OHLAP-Plus). For example, an OKPromise student who received a \$1,500 regular OKPromise scholarship could receive another \$1,500 OHLAP-Plus scholarship from the GEAR UP grant for a total of \$3,000.

2006-07 Student Eligibility Requirements: The OHLAP-Plus eligibility criteria were modified in 2002-03 due to the dramatic increase in the number of OKPromise students. An additional limitation requiring students to have an EFC (Expected Family Contribution) of \$1,000 or less was implemented to ensure that available funds would be focused on students with the greatest financial need. This was carried over to the 2003-04 and 2004-05 years. In 2005-06 the qualifying EFC was increased to \$3,850 and this was continued into 2006-07. To receive the OHLAP-Plus award in 2006-07, the student had to meet the following criteria:

- Graduated high school in 2002 or earlier
- Received a regular OKPromise award
- Received a federal Pell grant award (which is need-based) with an EFC of \$3,850 or less
- Had remaining unmet need within their defined “cost of attendance”. For example, the OHLAP-Plus awards could substitute for student loans.

Highlights:

- Around 2% of the OKPromise college students received an OHLAP-Plus award in 2006-07 — nearly \$543,355 was distributed to just over 300 students.
- Approximately 88% of OHLAP-Plus students attended the public research and regional universities; about 8% attended public two-year colleges; and about 4% attended private universities.
