



2009-10 Year-End Report

HIGHLIGHTS:

- In 2009-10, over 19,000 college students received Oklahoma’s Promise awards at a cost of \$53.1 million. Since the program’s inception in 1992, nearly 39,000 students have received awards totaling \$247 million.
- Students completing the program’s high school requirements continue to be successful academically according to several measures: high school GPA’s that exceed the state average; ACT scores that exceed those of their comparable middle- and lower-income peers; college-going rates exceeding the state average; and above-average full-time college enrollment, persistence rates and degree-completion rates.

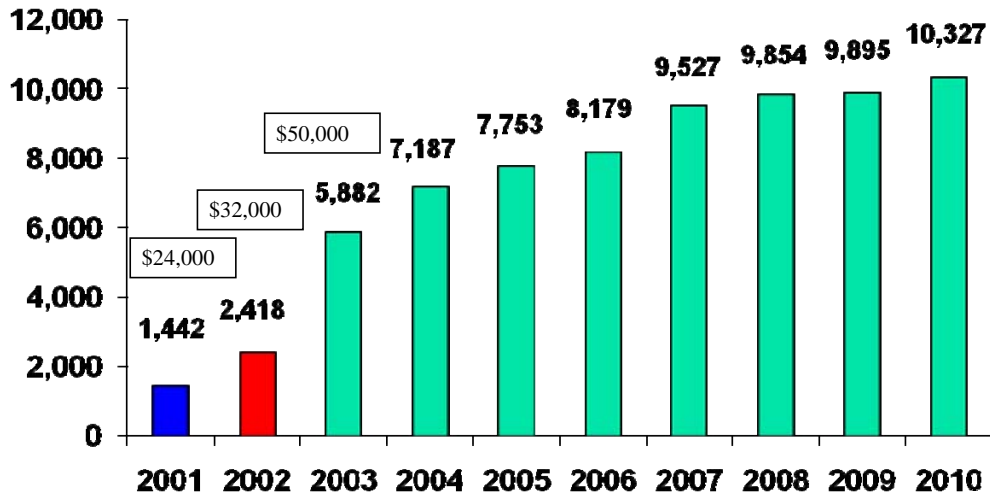

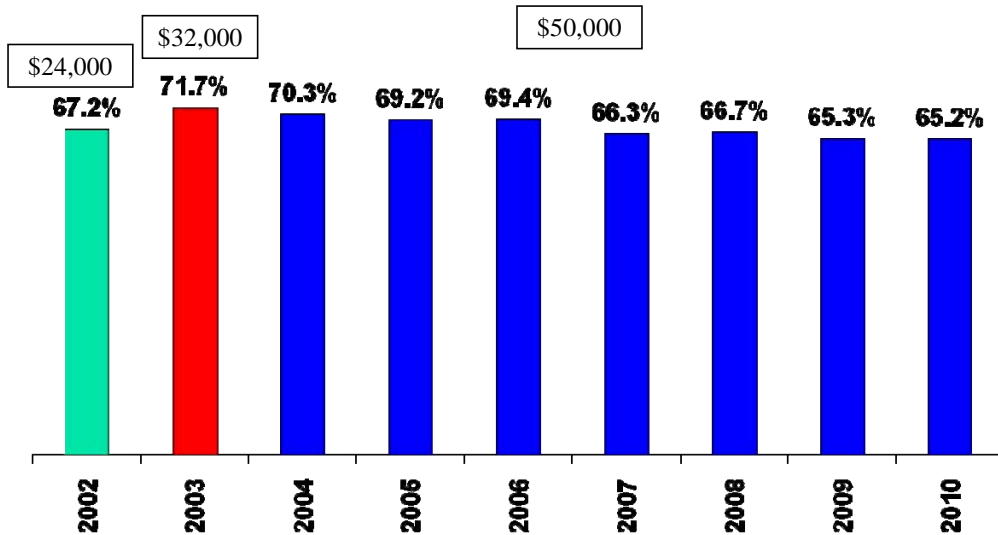

OKPromise High School Enrollment (By Graduation Year)



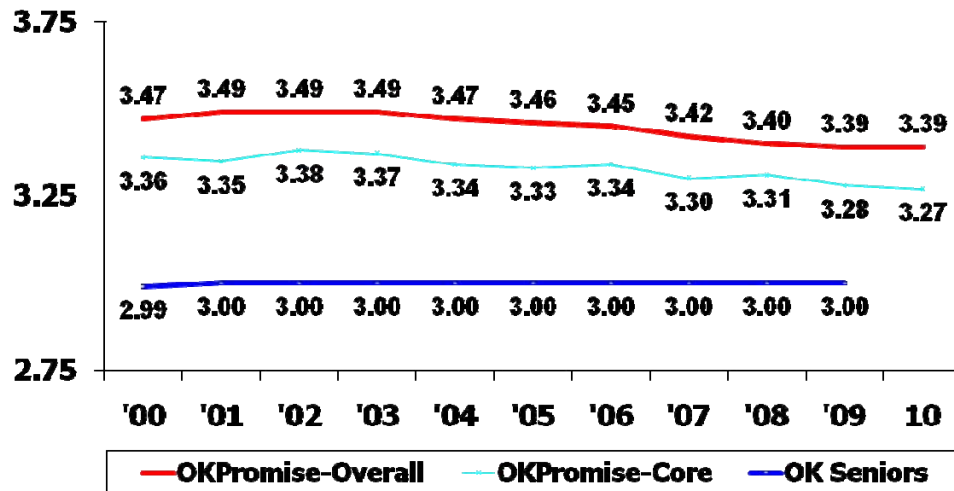

High School Requirement Completion Rates

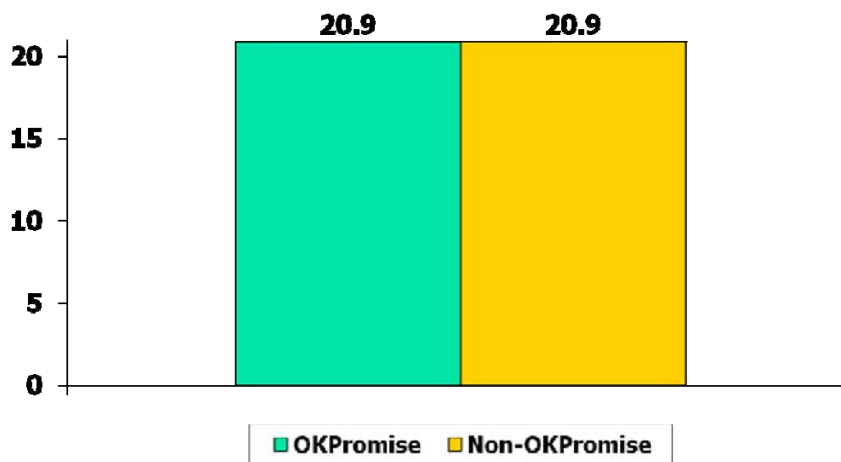

High School GPA's

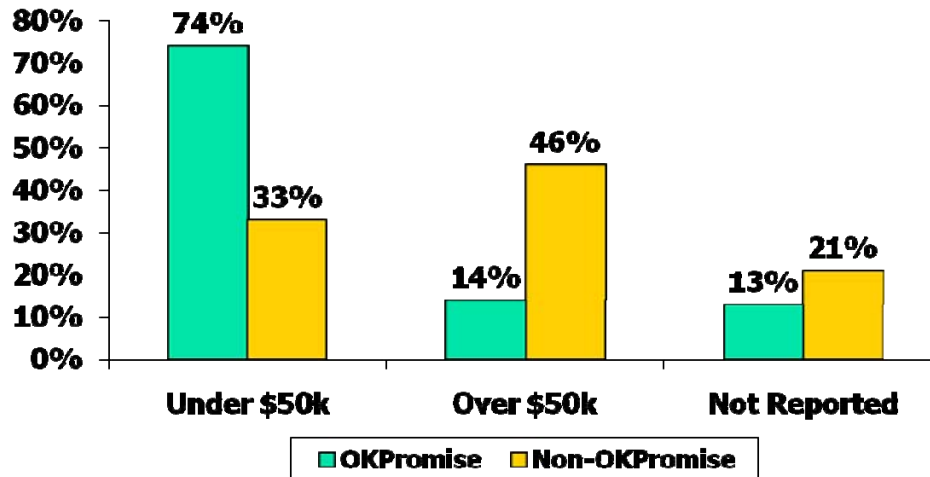


2010 ACT Composite Scores

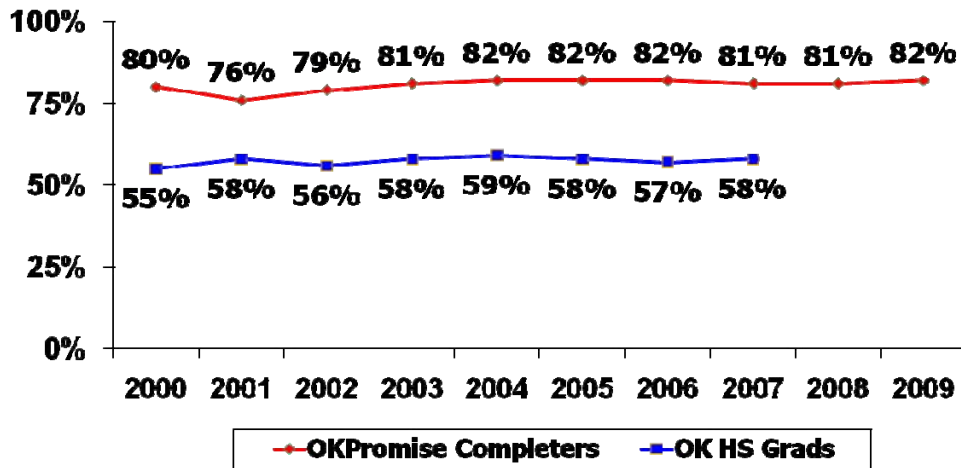
2010 ACT Testers By Income

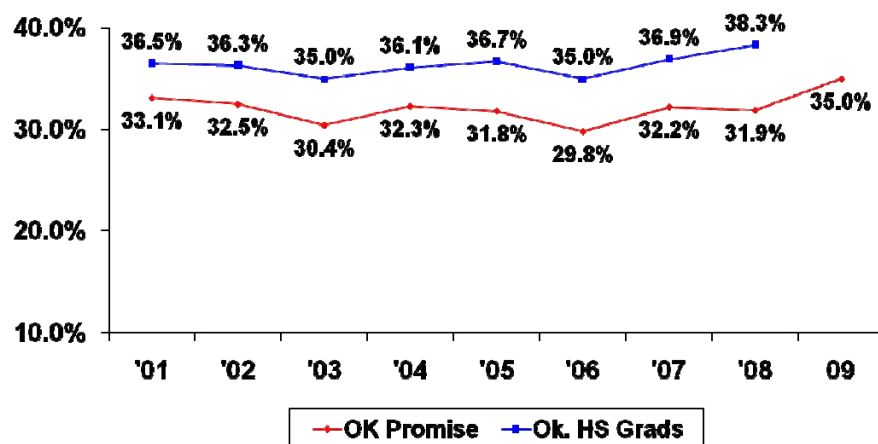

College-Going Rates Compared to All Oklahoma HS Graduates



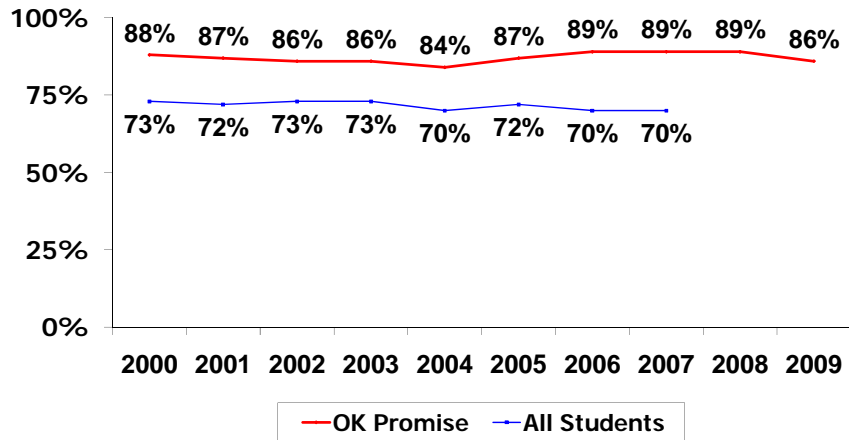

College Remediation Rates

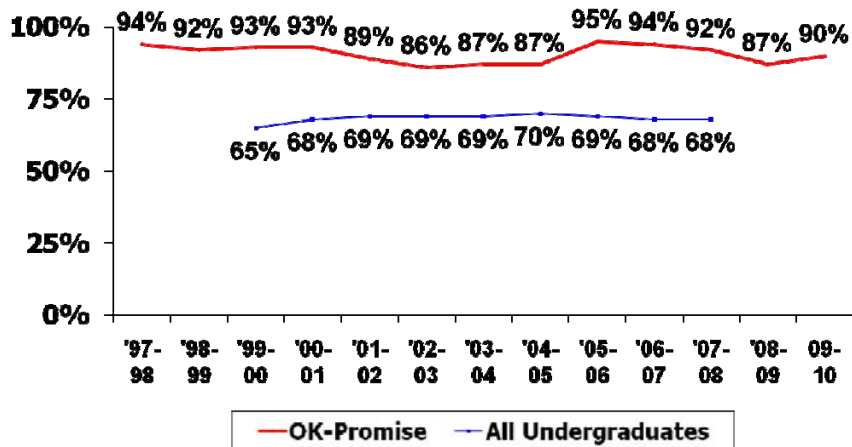

Full-Time College Enrollment*

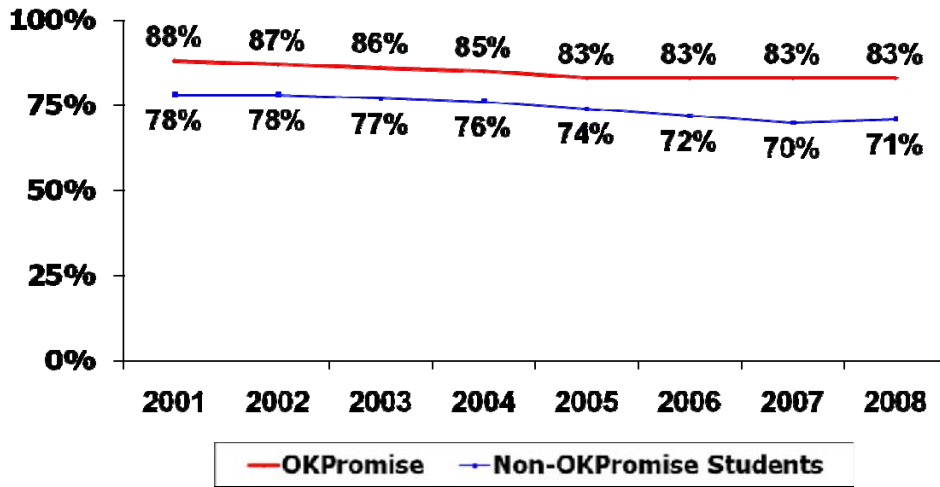

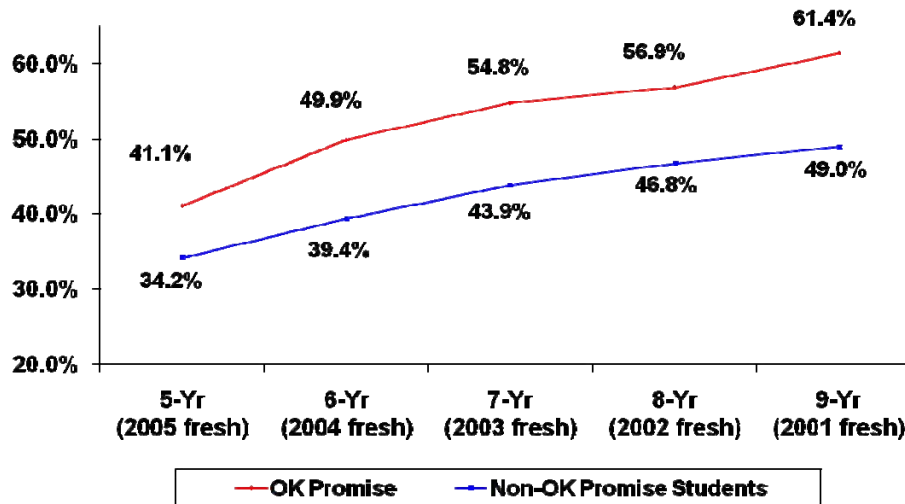

College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates

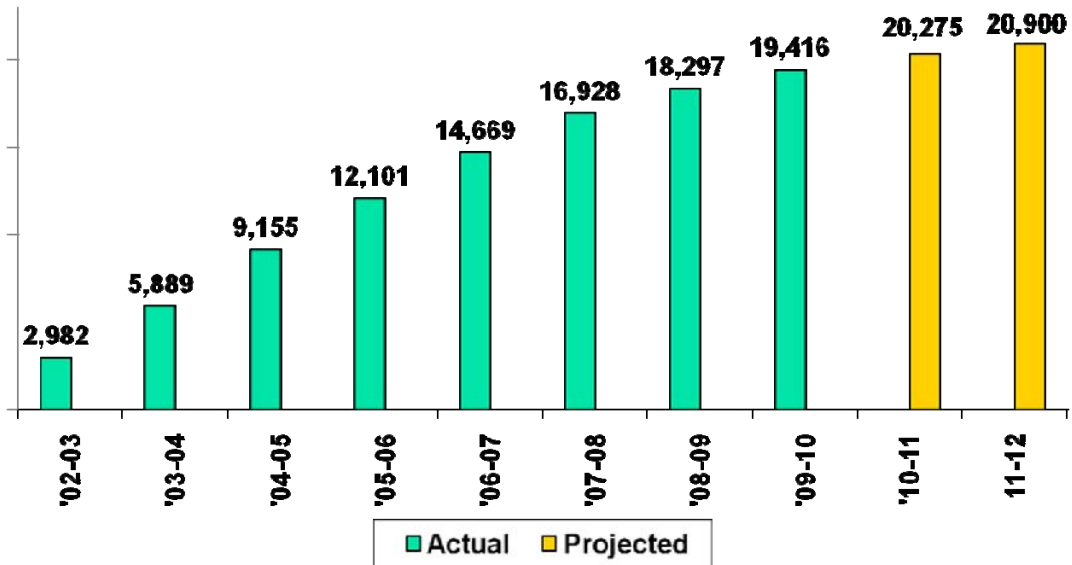


Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2009-10)

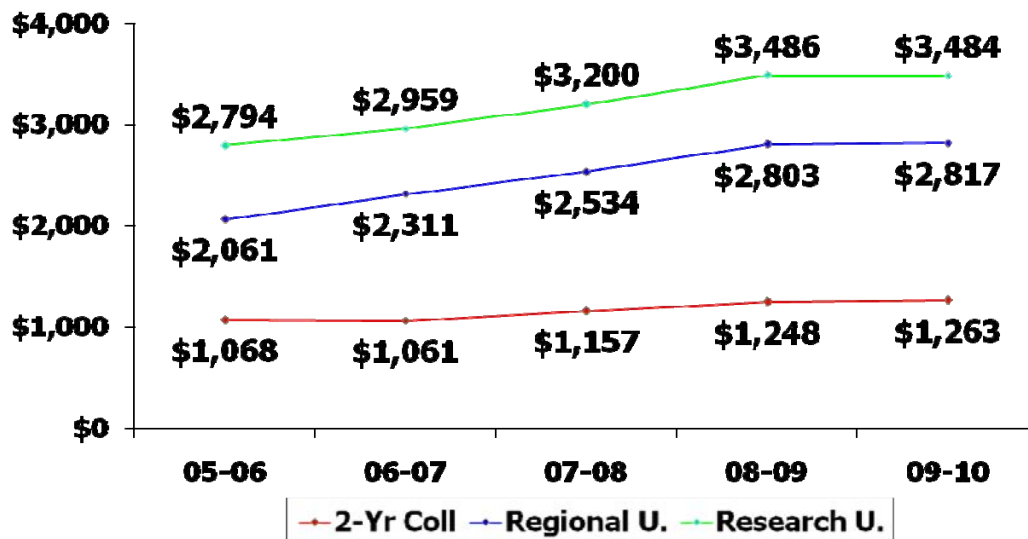

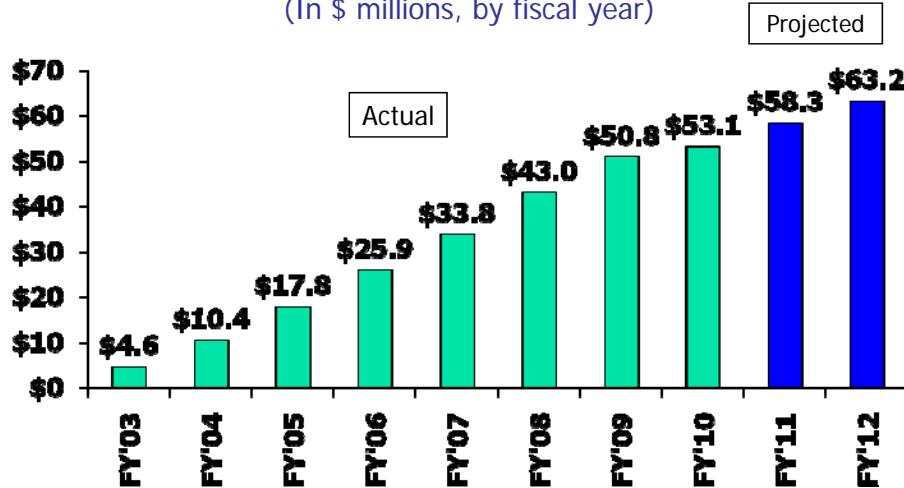

Average Scholarship by Tier



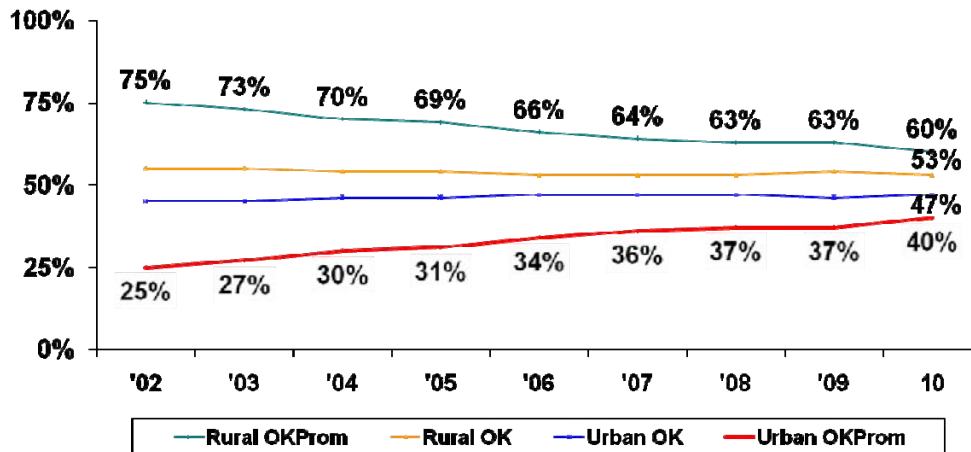
Scholarship Expenditures

(In \$ millions, by fiscal year)



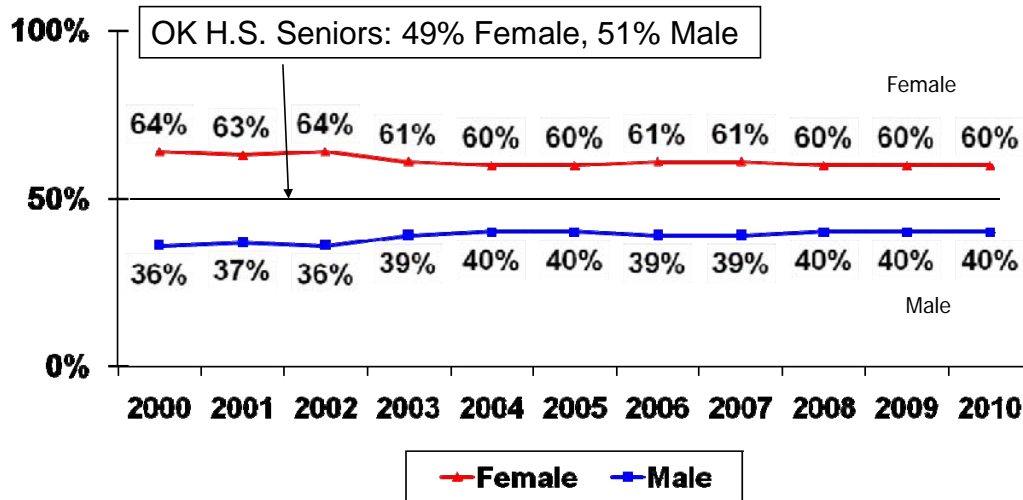

Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2002-2010

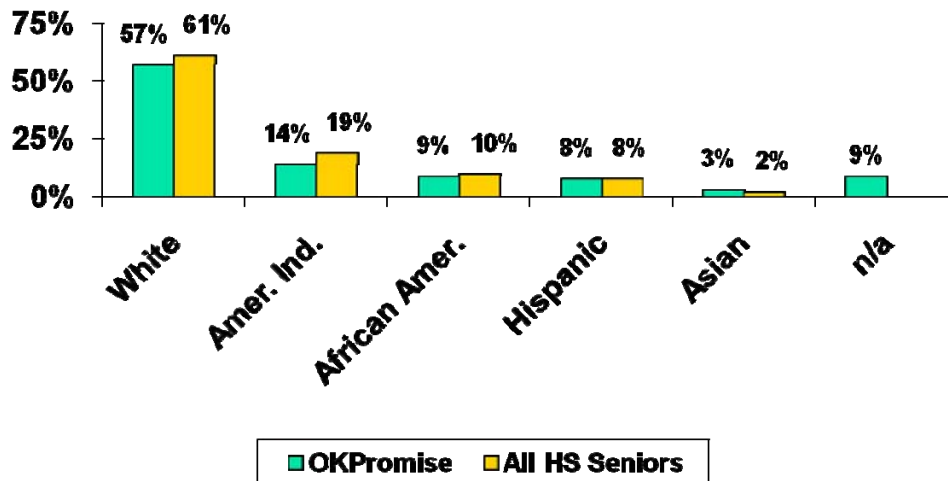

Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2000-2010

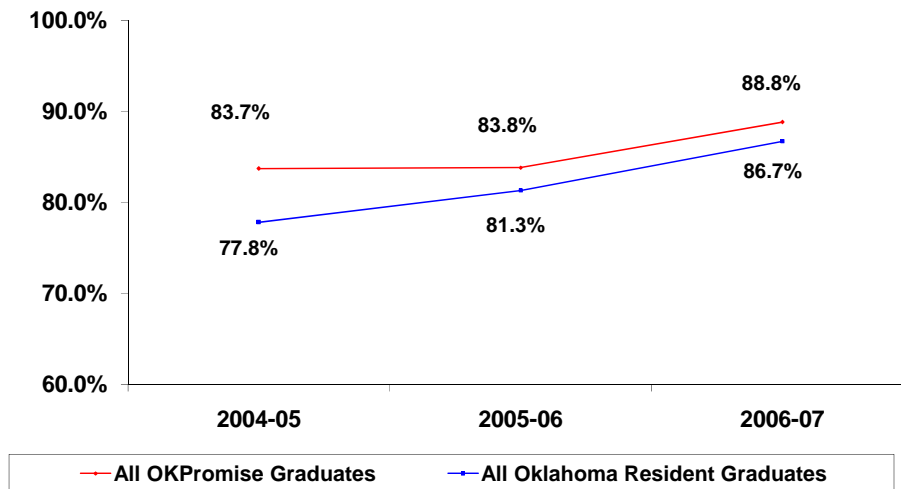


Ethnicity – 2010 HS Completers
