



# 2015-16 Year End Report

## HIGHLIGHTS:

- The number of Oklahoma's Promise award recipients in college declined for the fifth consecutive straight year, down from a peak of 20,085 in 2010-11 to 18,216 in 2015-16. The number of recipients is projected to decline further to 18,000 in 2016-17.
- The family income limit for students to enroll in the program has remained unchanged at \$50,000 since 2000. While enrollment of 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grade students in the program has declined, the percentage of those enrolled students that complete the high school program requirements has increased for the fourth year in a row. From a high of 10,635 in high school graduating class of 2012, student enrollment dropped to 8,524 in the class of 2016. The percentage of enrolled students completing the high school requirements has steadily increased from 64.7% in 2012 to 70.8% in 2016. Each 1% increase in the completion rate equals about 70 additional college freshmen scholarship recipients.

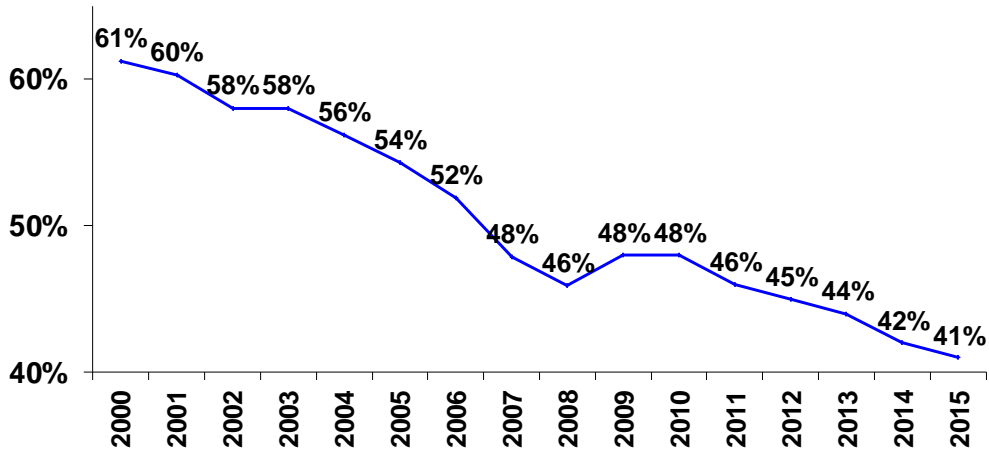

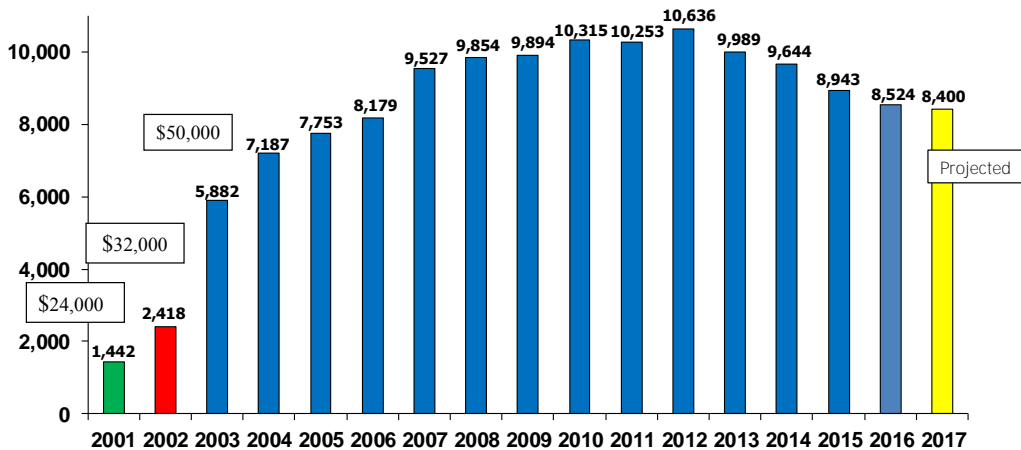

## Estimated Percent of Oklahoma Families with Total Income Under \$50,000



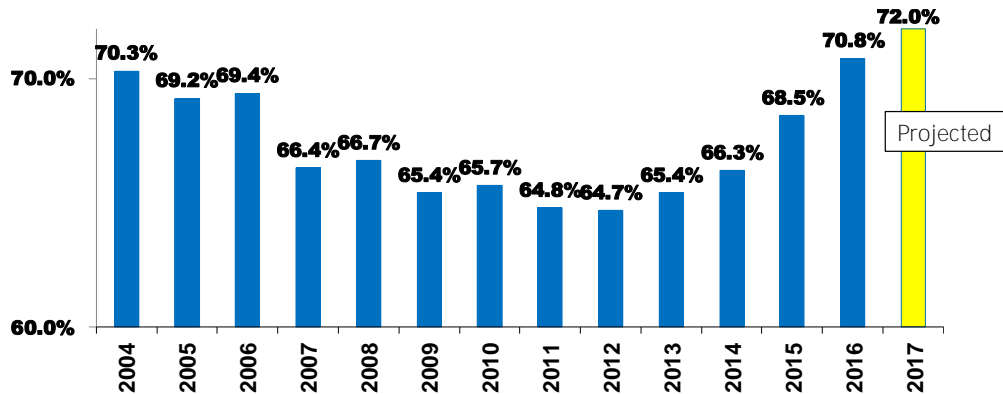

## OKPromise High School Enrollment (By High School Graduation Year)



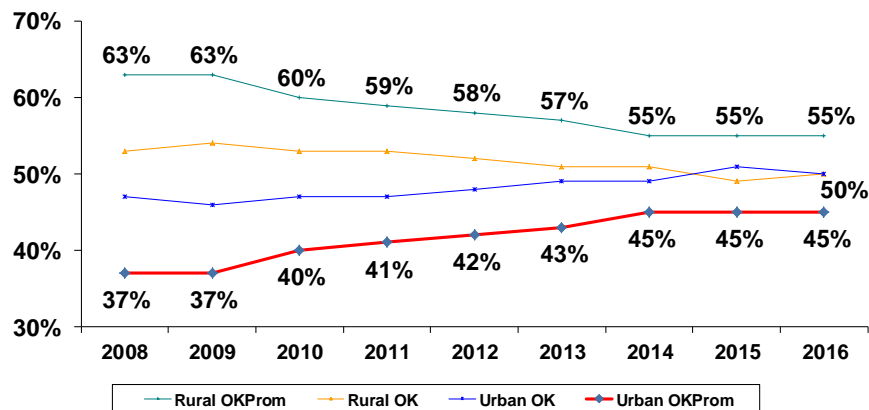

## High School Requirement Completion Rates (by grad year)



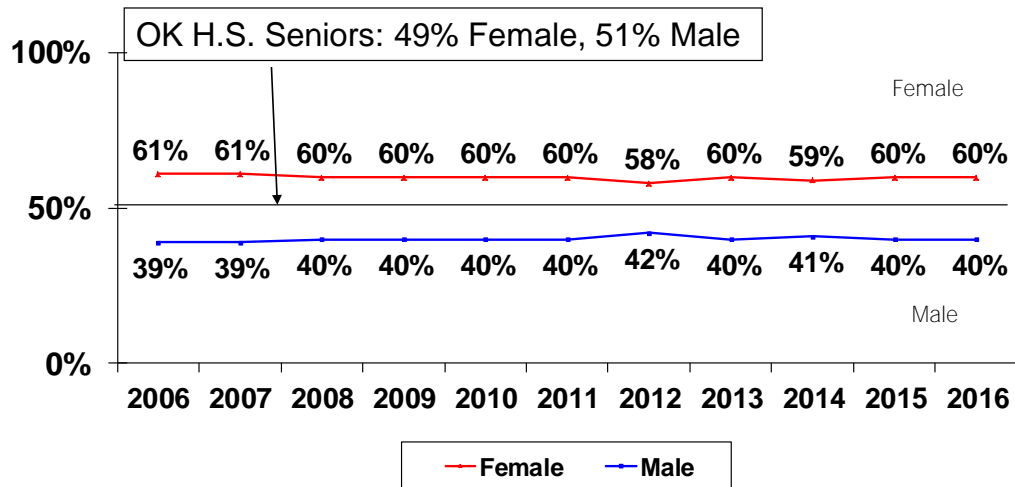

## Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2008-2016

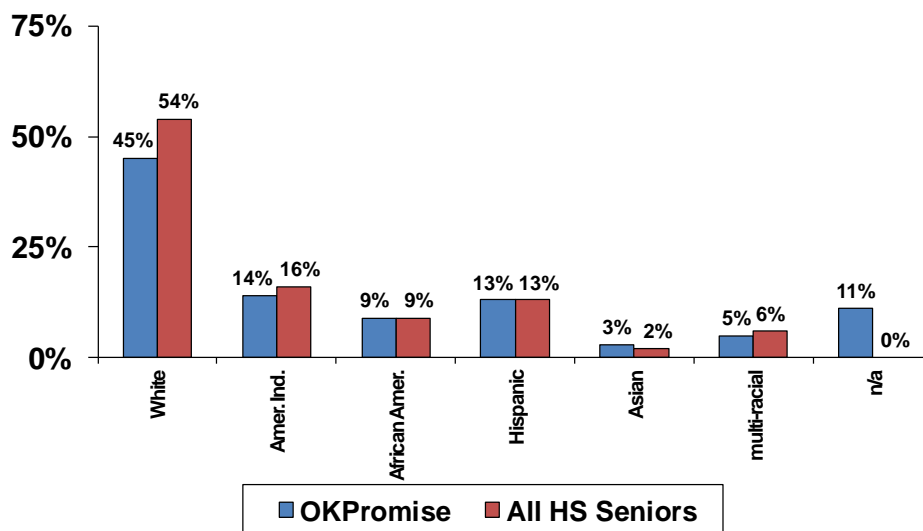

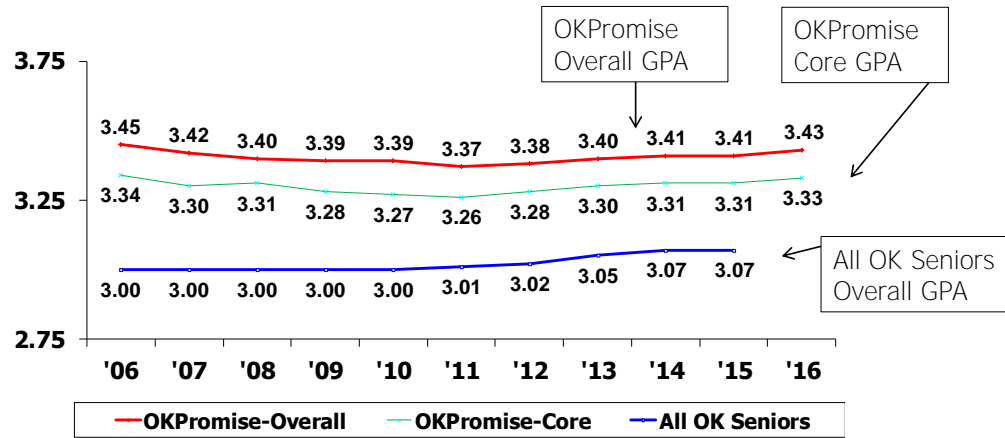
## Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2006-2016



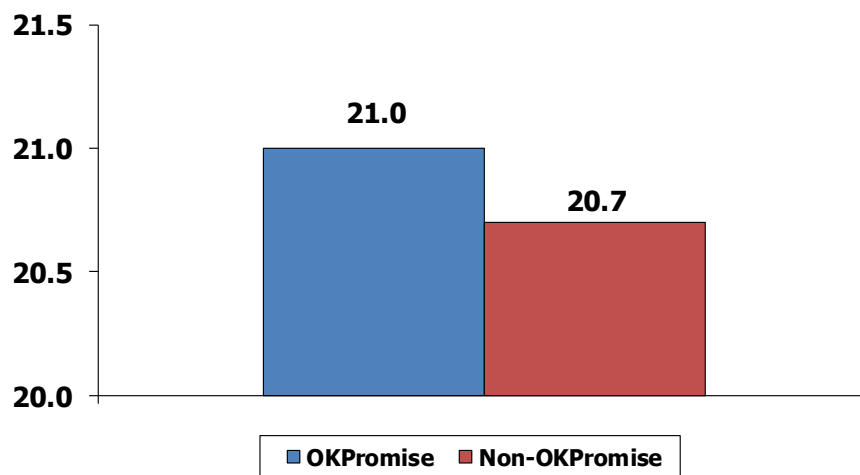
## Ethnicity – 2016 HS Completers



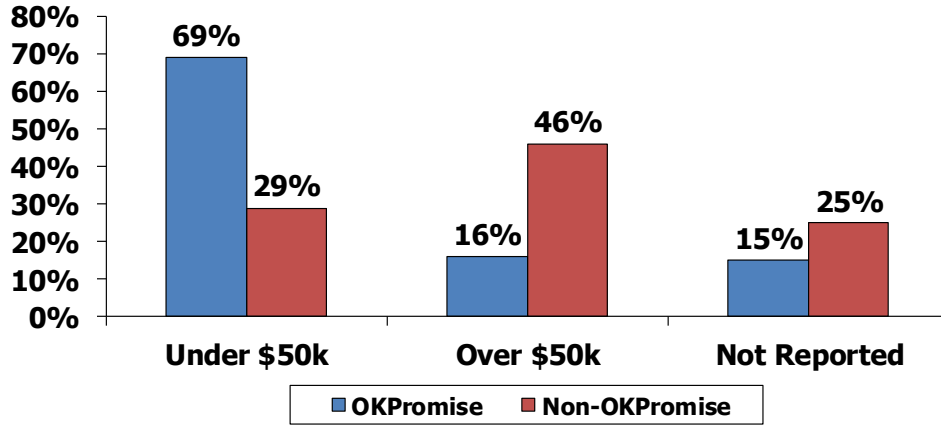

# 2016 ACT Composite Scores

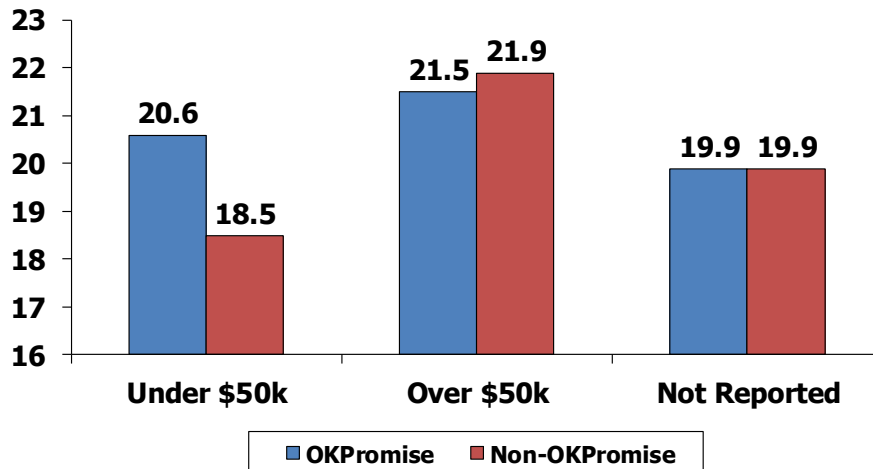


## 2016 ACT Testers By Income\*

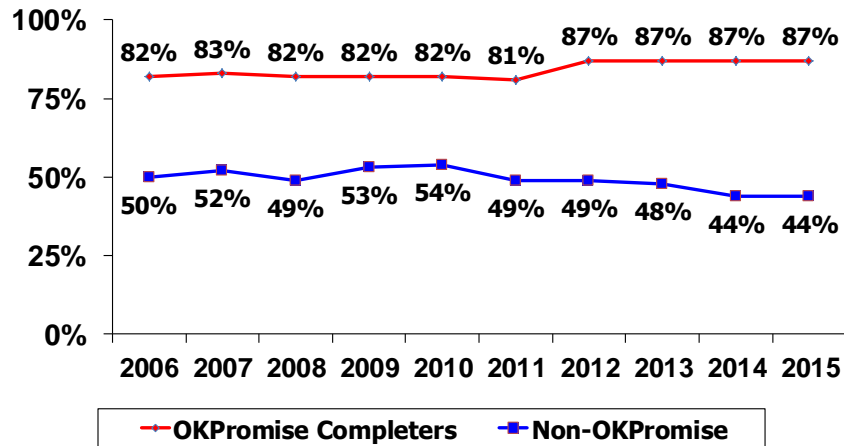
## 2016 Average ACT Scores By Income\*



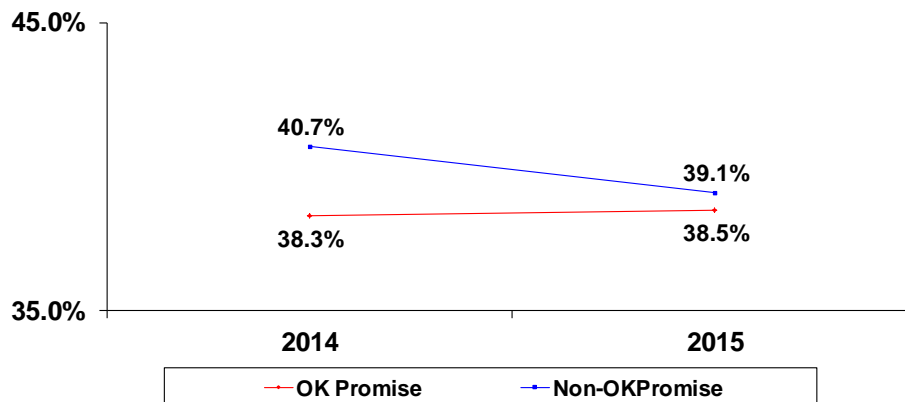

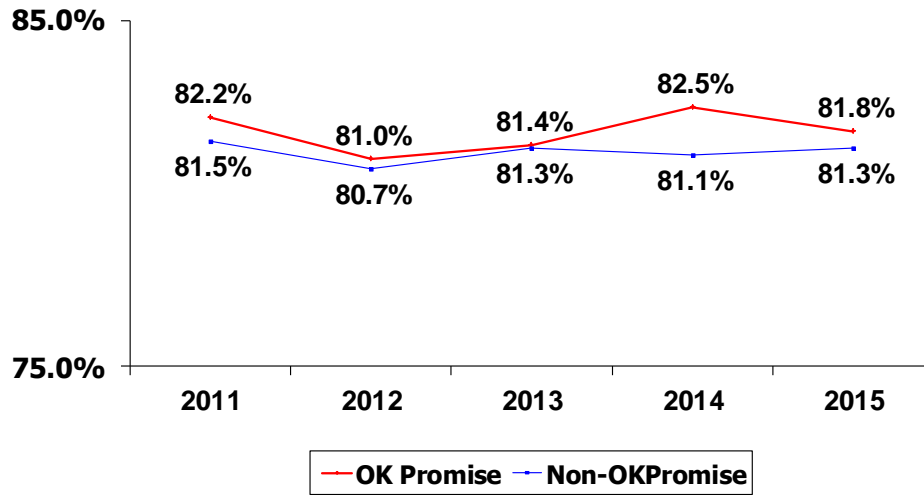

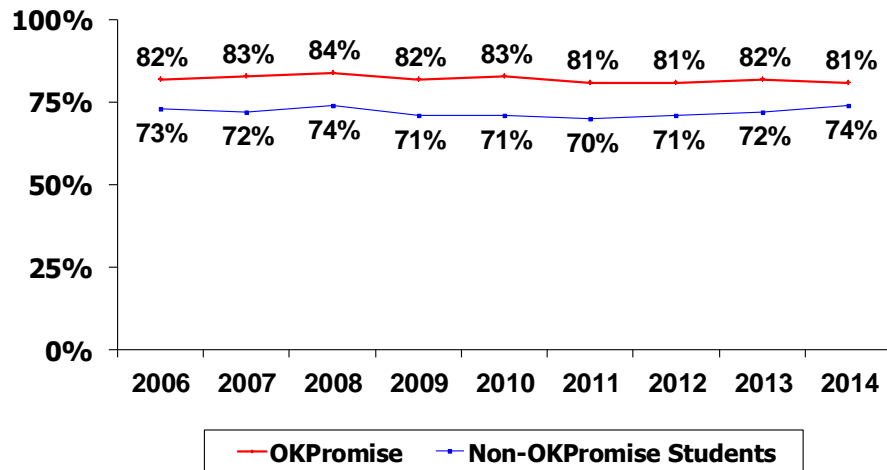


## College Freshman – GPA of at least 2.0

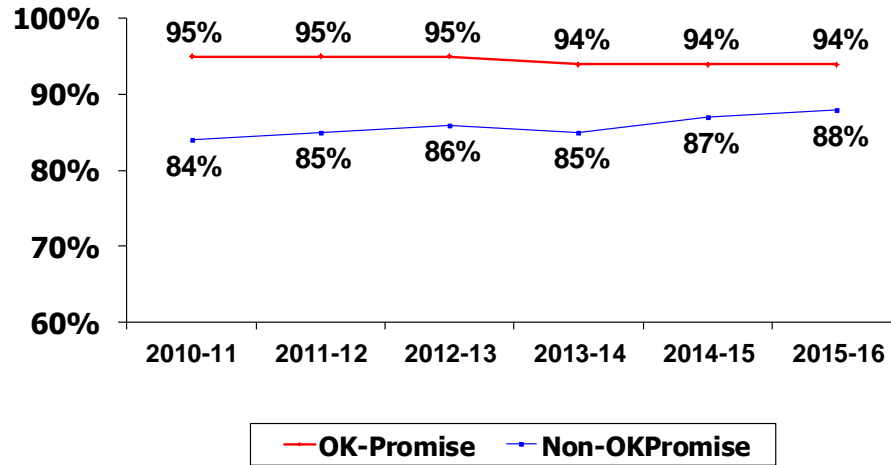

## College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



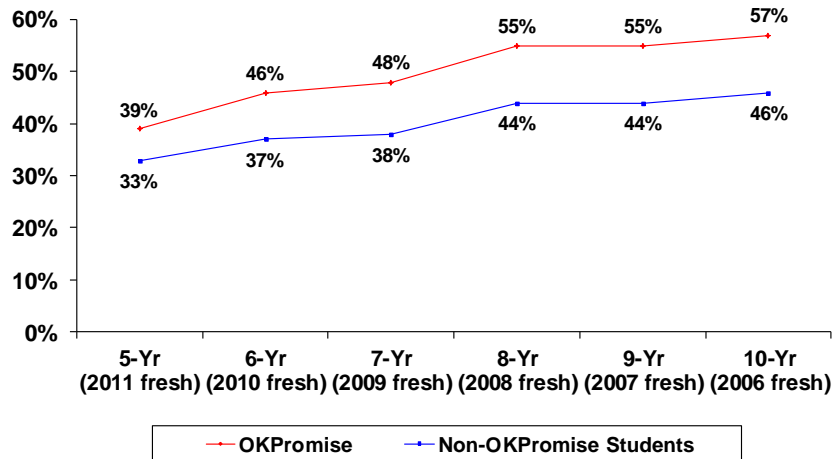
## Full-Time College Enrollment



First-time entering students enrolled full-time in fall or spring semester

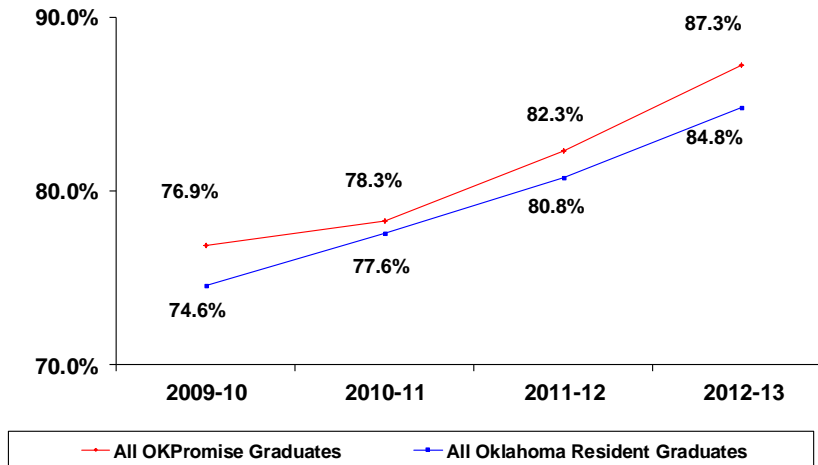
## Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2015-16)

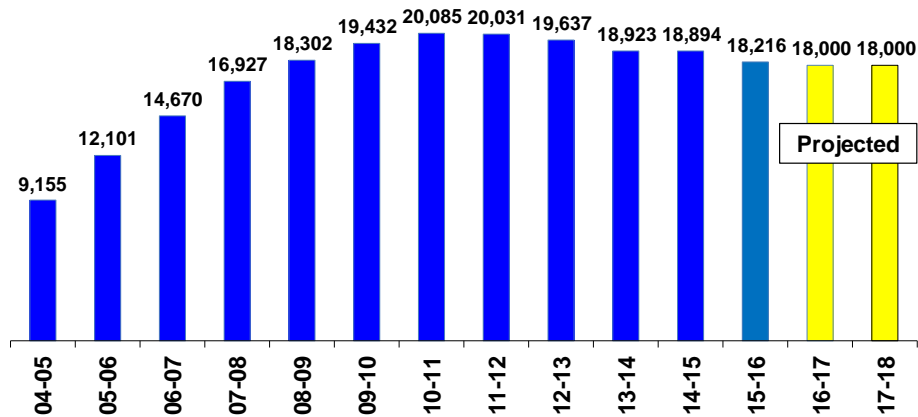


# OKPromise Graduates Employment

(Employed in Oklahoma between April 2013 and June 2014)



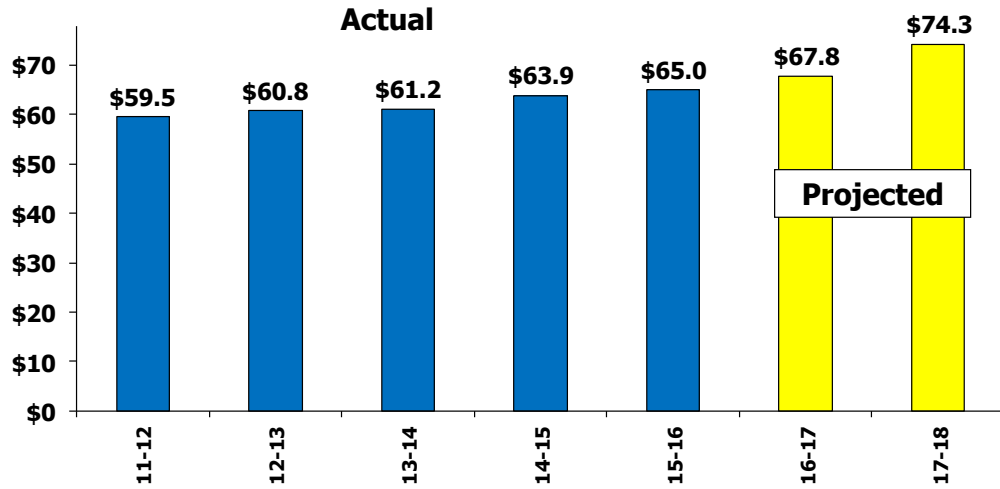

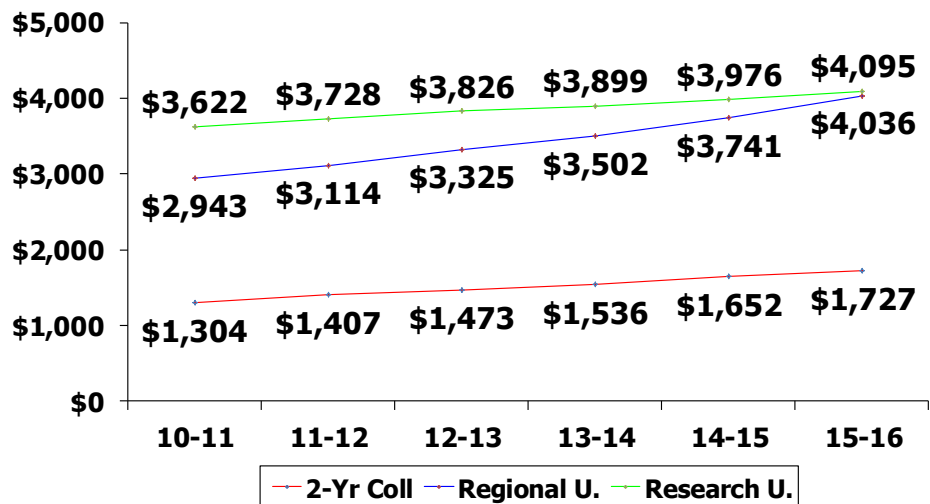
# Scholarship Expenditures
