



2007-08 Year-End Report

HIGHLIGHTS:

2008 Legislative Changes: The 2008 Oklahoma Legislature approved several changes to the program including the following:

- Delaying implementation of a new second income limit for one year until 2010-11. For first time award recipients in 2010-11, the income of the student's parents may not exceed \$100,000 at the time the student goes to college.
- Delaying new college GPA requirements for one year and slightly modifying the requirements. Based on the new law, students receiving the award for the first time in 2010-11 will be subject to a minimum college GPA of 2.0 for courses taken through the sophomore year and a minimum 2.5 GPA for courses taken during the junior year and thereafter.
- Expanding income eligibility for certain students adopted from permanent state custody or other specified custody circumstances.
- Increasing the flexibility for students in the military to begin using the program award after high school graduation.
- The Legislature also created a task force to examine the program's income requirements and college award-retention requirements to make recommendations to the Legislature for consideration in 2009.



OKPromise High School Enrollment (By Graduation Year)






High School Requirement Completion Rates



High School GPA's for All Courses




ACT Scores 2001-2008


2008 ACT Testers By Income



College-Going Rates Compared to All Oklahoma HS Graduates





College Remediation Rates



College Freshman – GPA of at least 2.0




Full-Time College Enrollment*


College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates



Degree Completion (includes baccalaureate and associate degrees):






Average Scholarship Amount by Type of Institution



Scholarships Paid (In \$ millions)




Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 1999-2008


