

# Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP)

# 1996-97 Year-End Report

### First OHLAP Scholarships Awarded

OHLAP students graduating from high school in 1996 were the first students to receive the OHLAP scholarship. A total of 637 students completed the OHLAP program requirements in high school and were eligible for the scholarship in 1996-97. Of these, 469, or 74% actually received scholarships.

#### Highlights of 1996-97 Scholarship Recipients

- ➤ Of the 1,610 students originally enrolled in OHLAP from the high school graduating class of 1996, 637, or 40%, completed the program and were eligible for the OHLAP scholarship.
- ➤ Of the 637 students eligible for the OHLAP scholarship in 1996-97, 469, or 74% actually received the scholarship. [The 168 students eligible but not receiving scholarships included those delaying their entry into college, students enrolled but having sufficient other financial aid to cover their full cost of education, and those going to college out of state.]
- ➤ OHLAP students enrolled at all twenty-five public colleges and universities, nine private institutions, and two area vocational-technical schools.
- > Total cost of the OHLAP scholarships was \$518,574.
- > 92% of OHLAP scholarship recipients attended public higher education institutions.
- ➤ Nearly two-thirds of OHLAP scholarship recipients were female.
- The annual value of the OHLAP scholarship averaged \$1,460 at the comprehensive universities, \$1,200 at the regional universities, and \$800 at the two-year colleges.
- A remarkable 96% of OHLAP scholarship recipients enrolled full-time (12 hours or more per semester).


#### **Enrollment, Success Rate Increase**

Since a significant drop in enrollment the second year of the program, participation in OHLAP has risen steadily. As of July 1997, a total of 4,407 students have entered the OHLAP program.

The success rate of students in the program also improved. About 40% of the first class of OHLAP students (1996) successfully completed the program and qualified for the scholarship. That rate increased to over 50% for the second class in 1997.
