



2010-11 Year End Report

HIGHLIGHTS:

- In 2010-11, for the first time in the history of the program, the number of Oklahoma's Promise award recipients in college exceeded 20,000.
- The proportion of students from urban schools completing the program's high school requirements continued to increase. In 2003, only 27% of qualifying students attended urban high schools; by 2011 that increased to 41%.
- The enrollment of high school students in the program appears to be leveling off. For the first time since 1997, the number of high school students enrolled in Oklahoma's Promise in the 2011 graduating class was slightly less than the previous year's graduating class.




OKPromise High School Enrollment

(By Graduation Year)





High School Requirement Completion Rates





Geographic Distribution Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2003-2011





Gender Trends OKPromise High School Grads, 2001-2011







Ethnicity – 2011 HS Completers



High School GPA's




2011 ACT Testers By Income*


2011 Average ACT Scores By Income*


2011 ACT Composite Scores


College-Going Rates Compared to All Oklahoma HS Graduates



(OKPromise freshmen scholarship recipients requiring at least one remedial course as a percentage of all OKPromise freshmen students.)


College Freshman – GPA of at least 2.0





College Freshman to Sophomore Persistence Rates




Full-Time College Enrollment



First-time entering students enrolled in 12 hours or more per fall or spring semester


Degree Completion Rates

(Degrees earned through 2010-11)




OKPromise Graduates Employment



Scholarship Expenditures


